farther in life with whatever I'm doing at that time! If new opportunities arise I will go as far as my dreams will let me.




several activities such as Student-body President, Cheer Captain, Choir and Safety Patrol. I also enjoy playing sports and on my free time I love practicing my stage makeup

Fashion Week, September 9th, 2023. That experience has ignited a love for modeling and runway that I hope to pursue further.


It takes a lot of strength to maneuver yourself into tangled positions in the long fabrics but I find it to be so relaxing.


Not only do I dance and model but I'm also training in Silks at Northside Gymnastics Academy.


Dance has opened so many doors of opportunity for me. I will forever be grateful for the dance community and all that it


