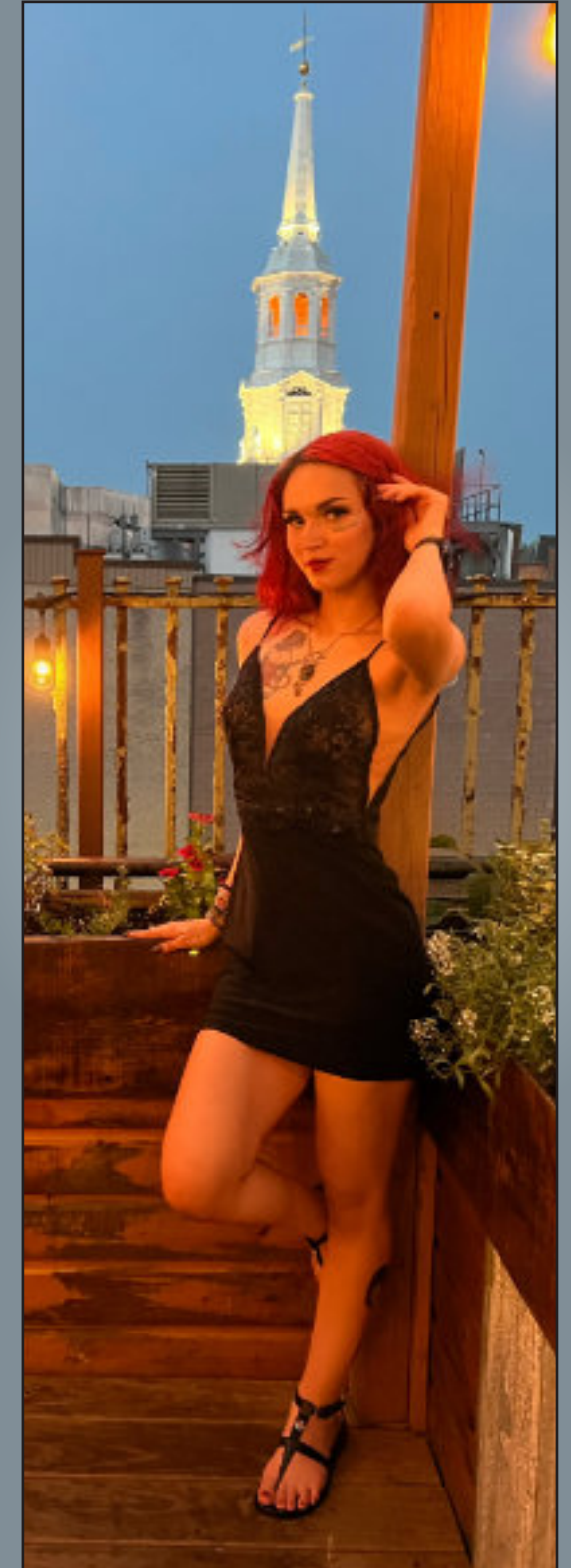

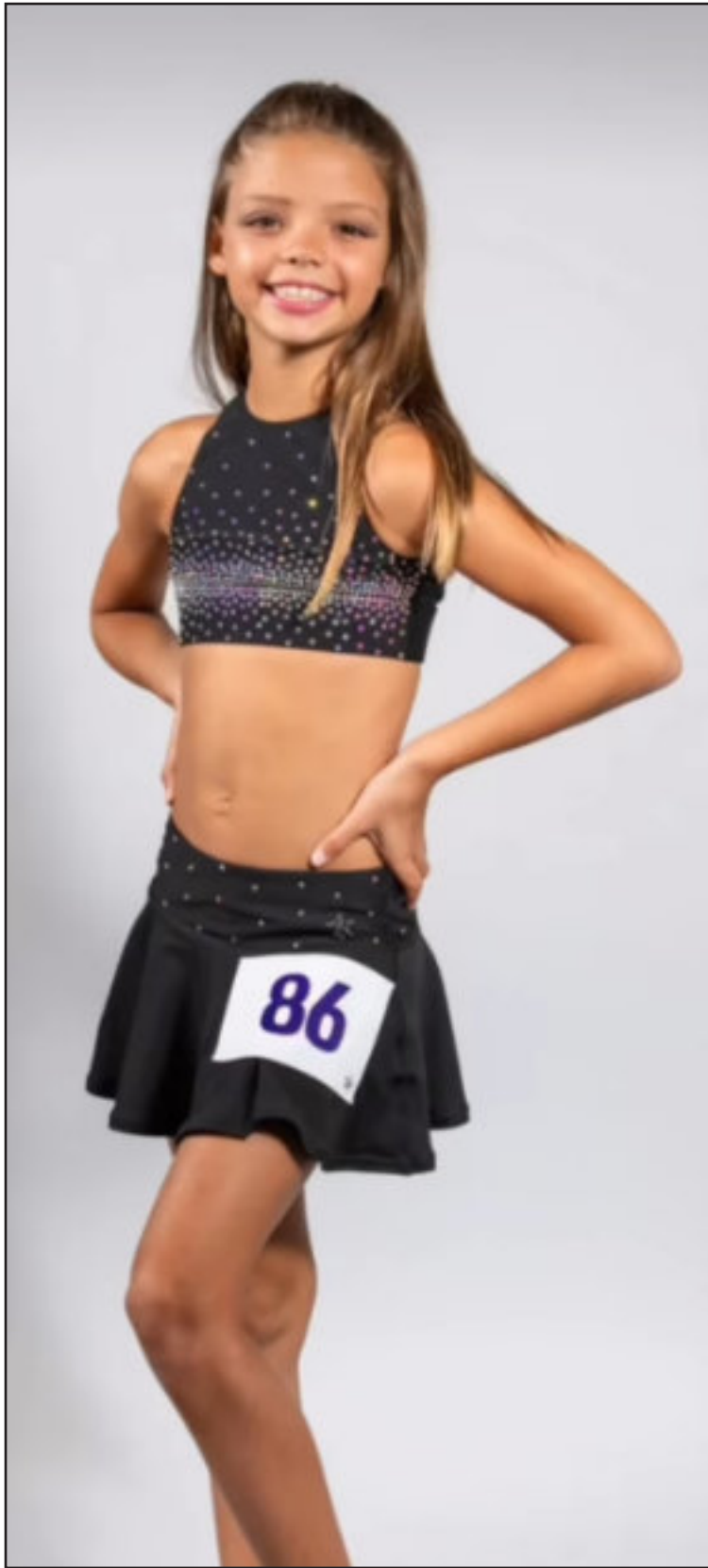

# Angel Bazemore

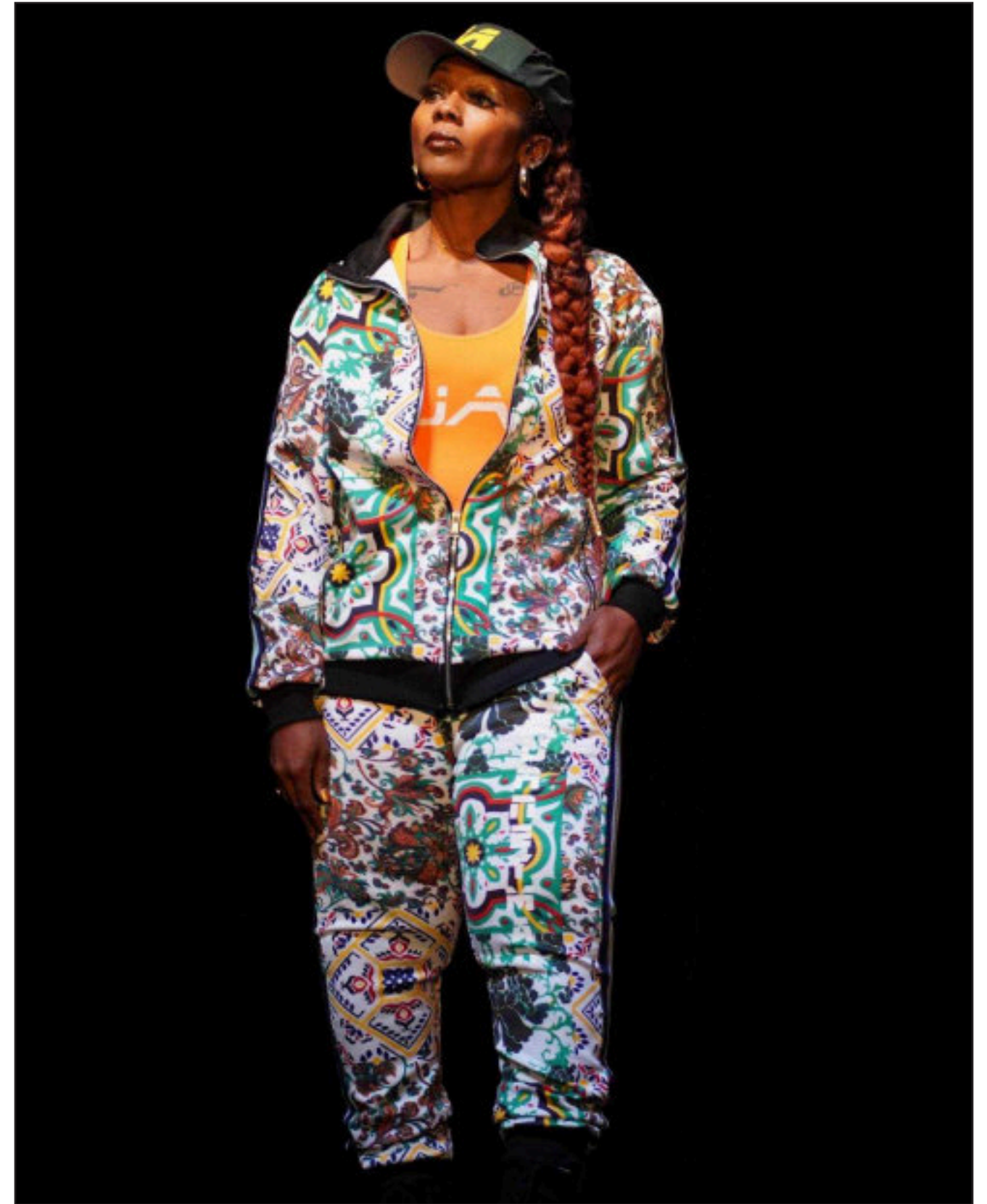
My name is Angel Bazemore, and would like to express my gratitude for this beautiful opportunity. To lose my father, and have so health changes has

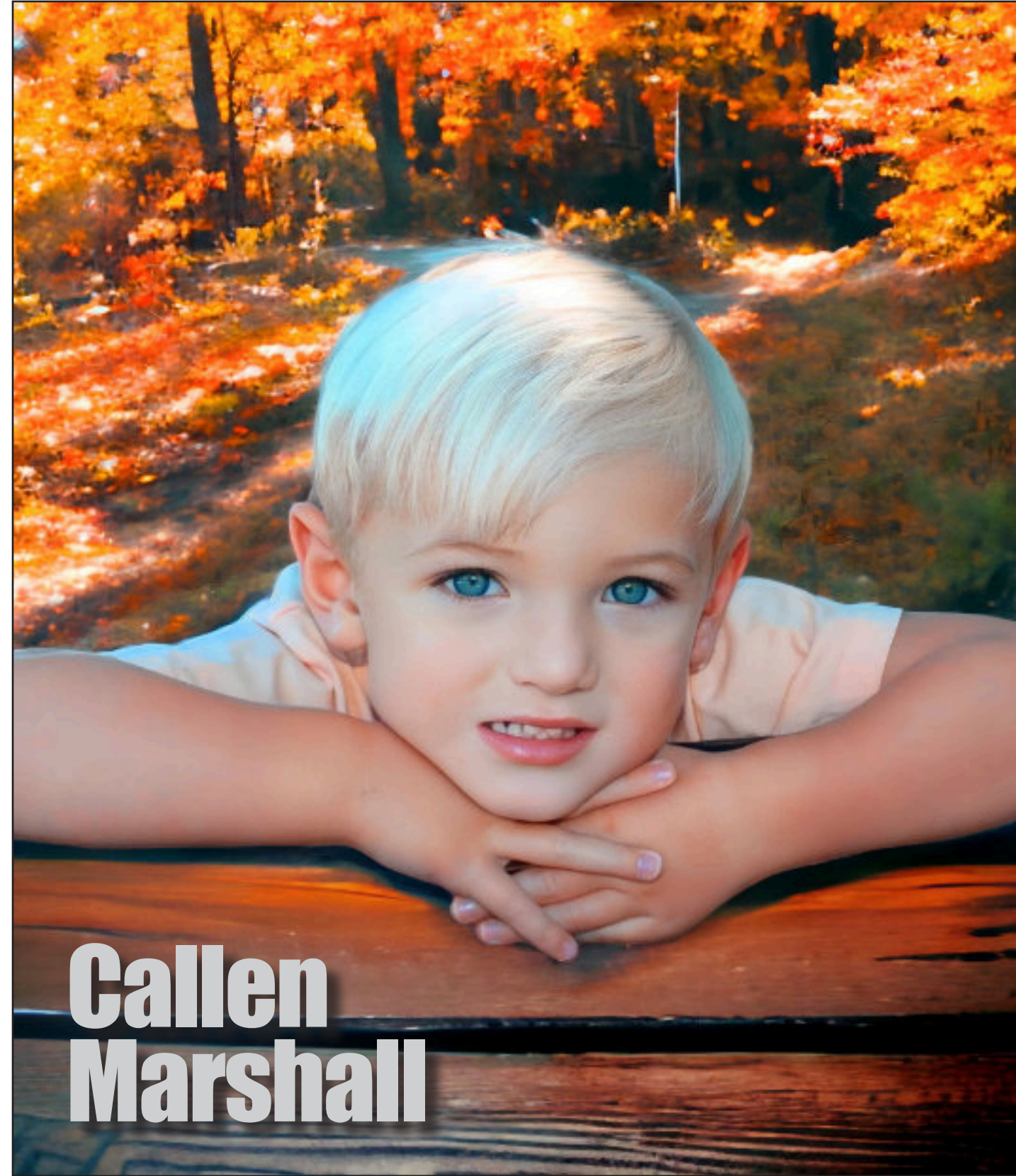
farther in life with whatever I'm doing at that time! If new opportunities arise I will go as far as my dreams will let me.

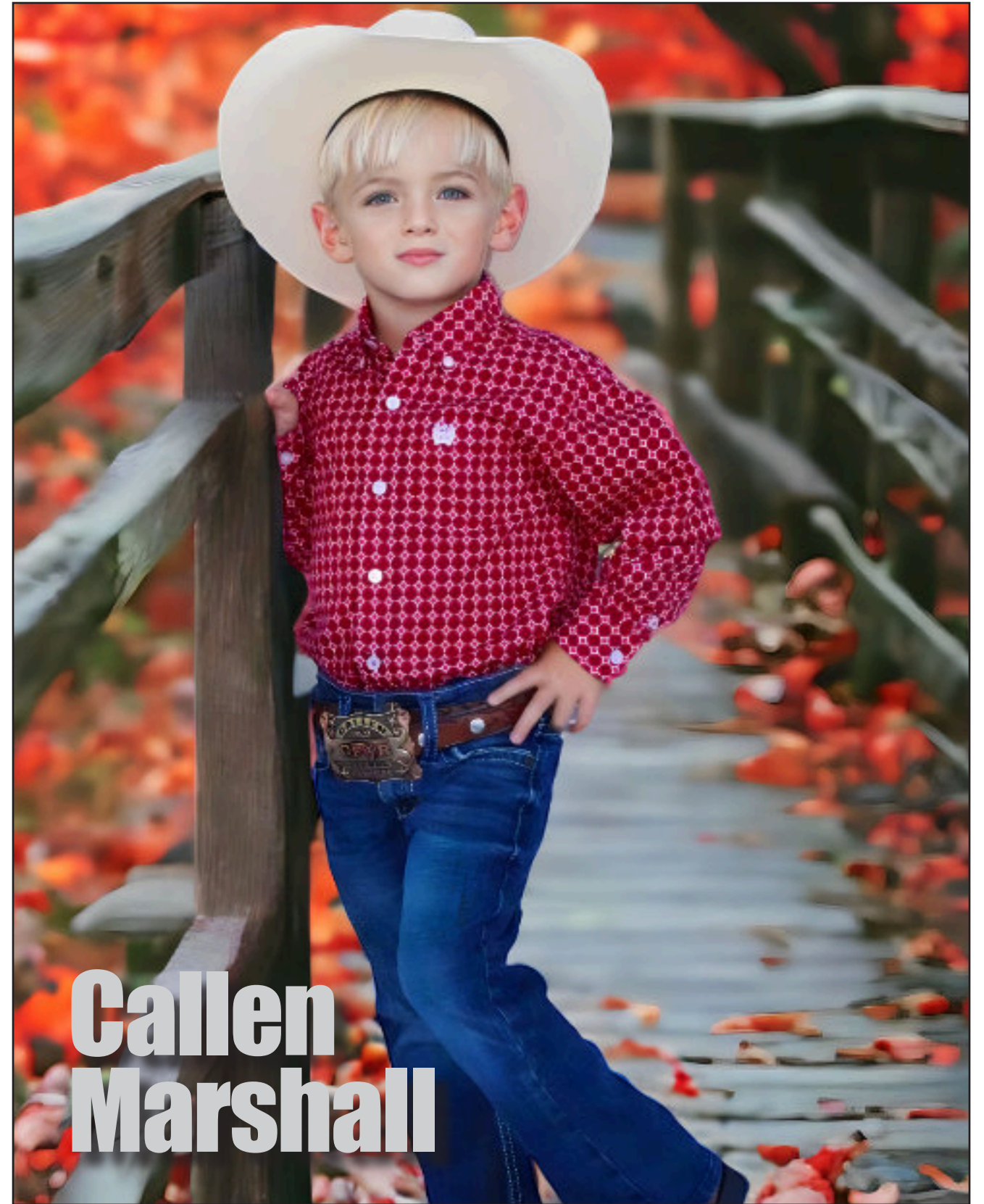

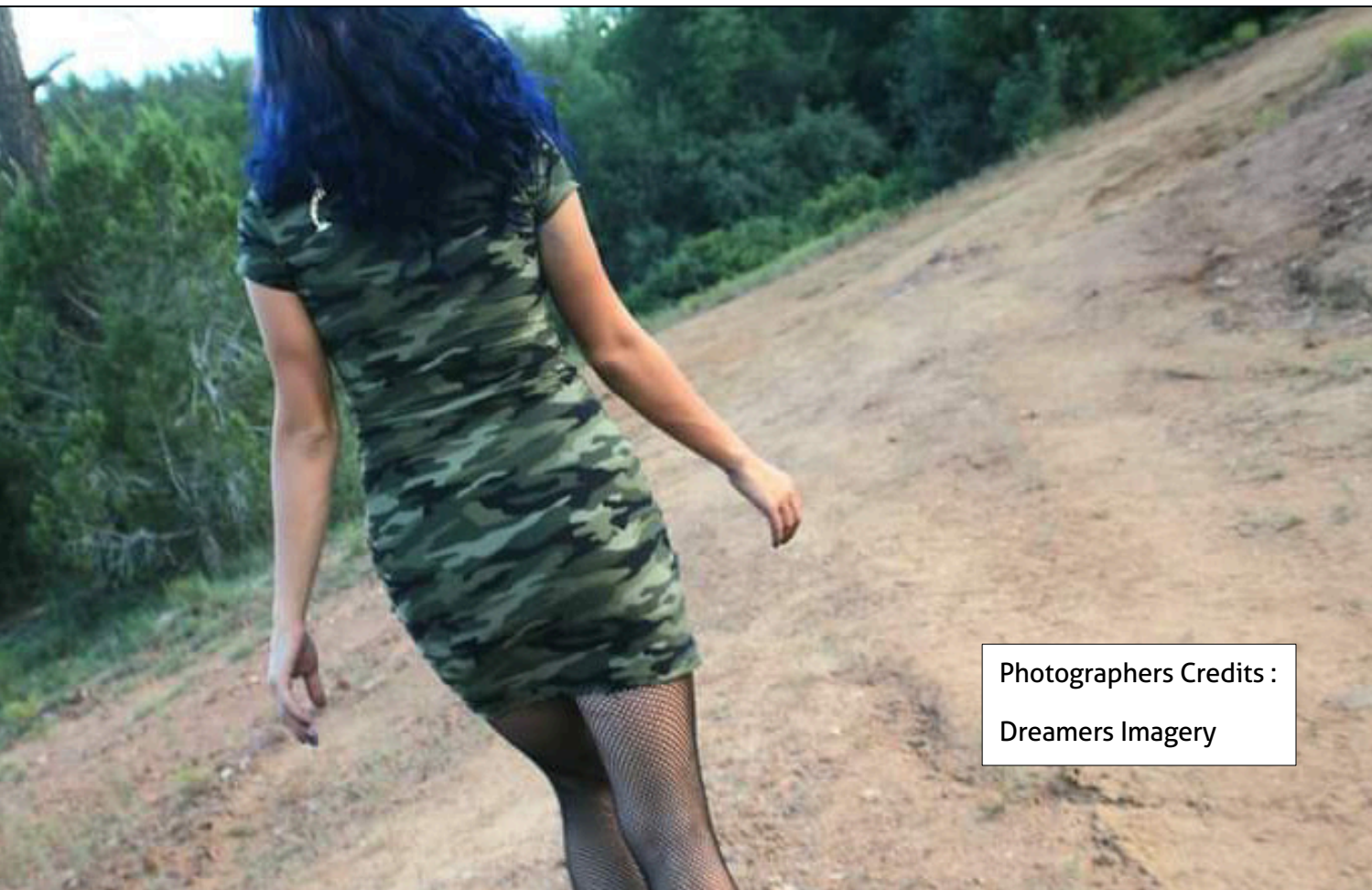

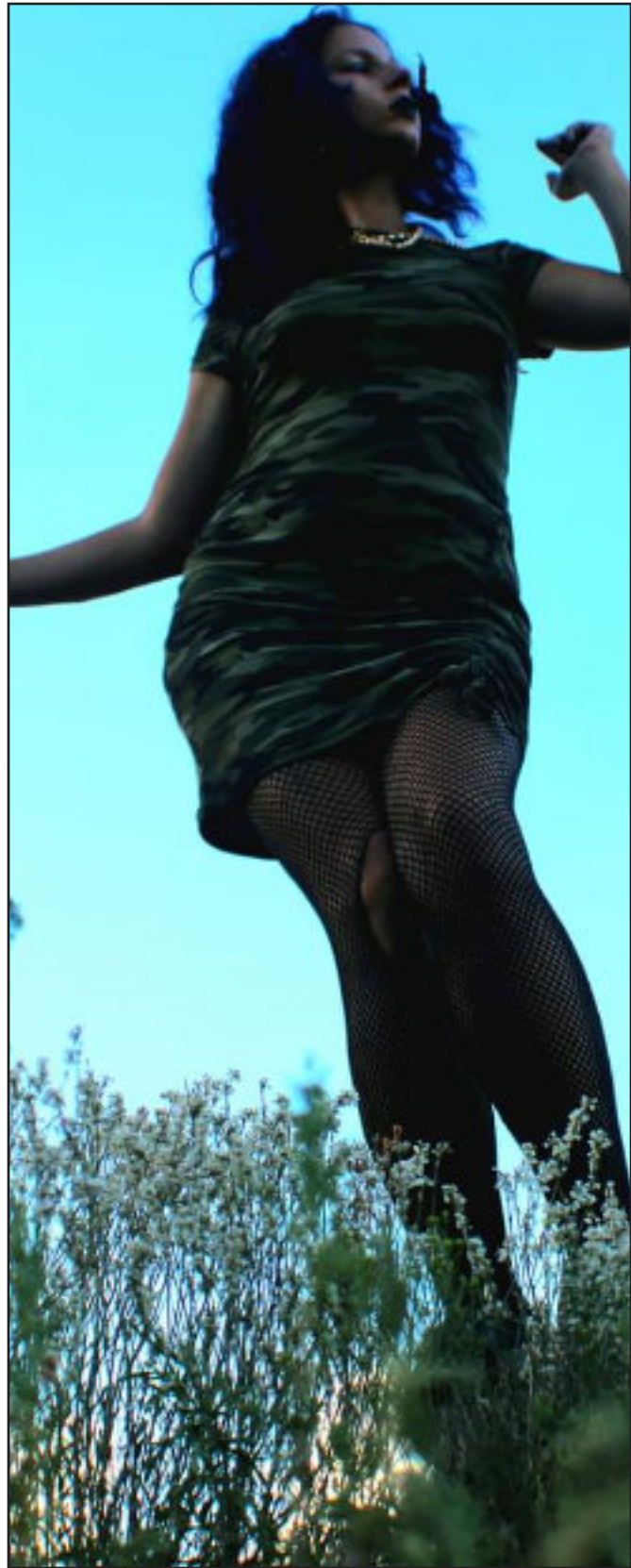

# Lil Cherry



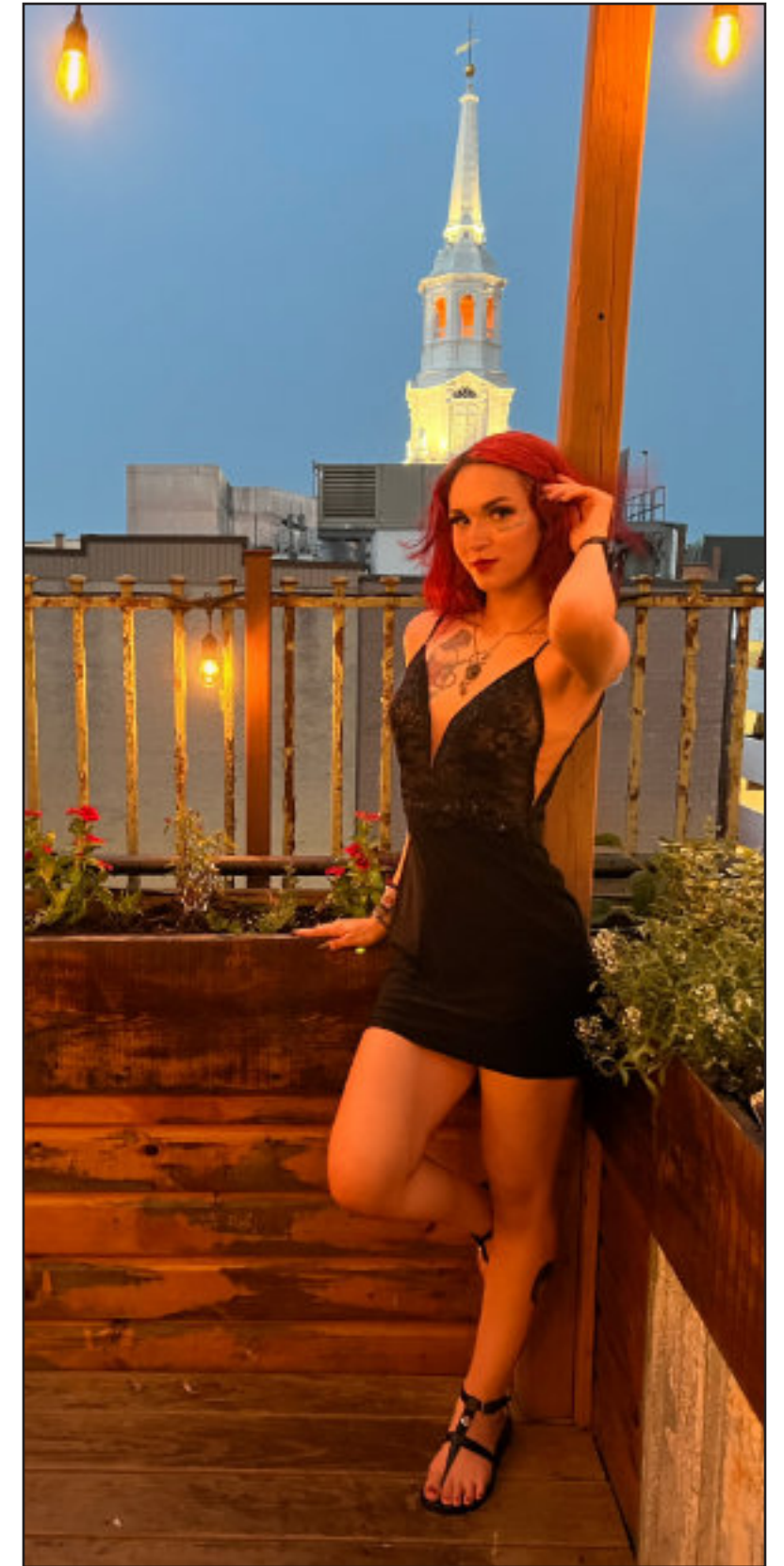

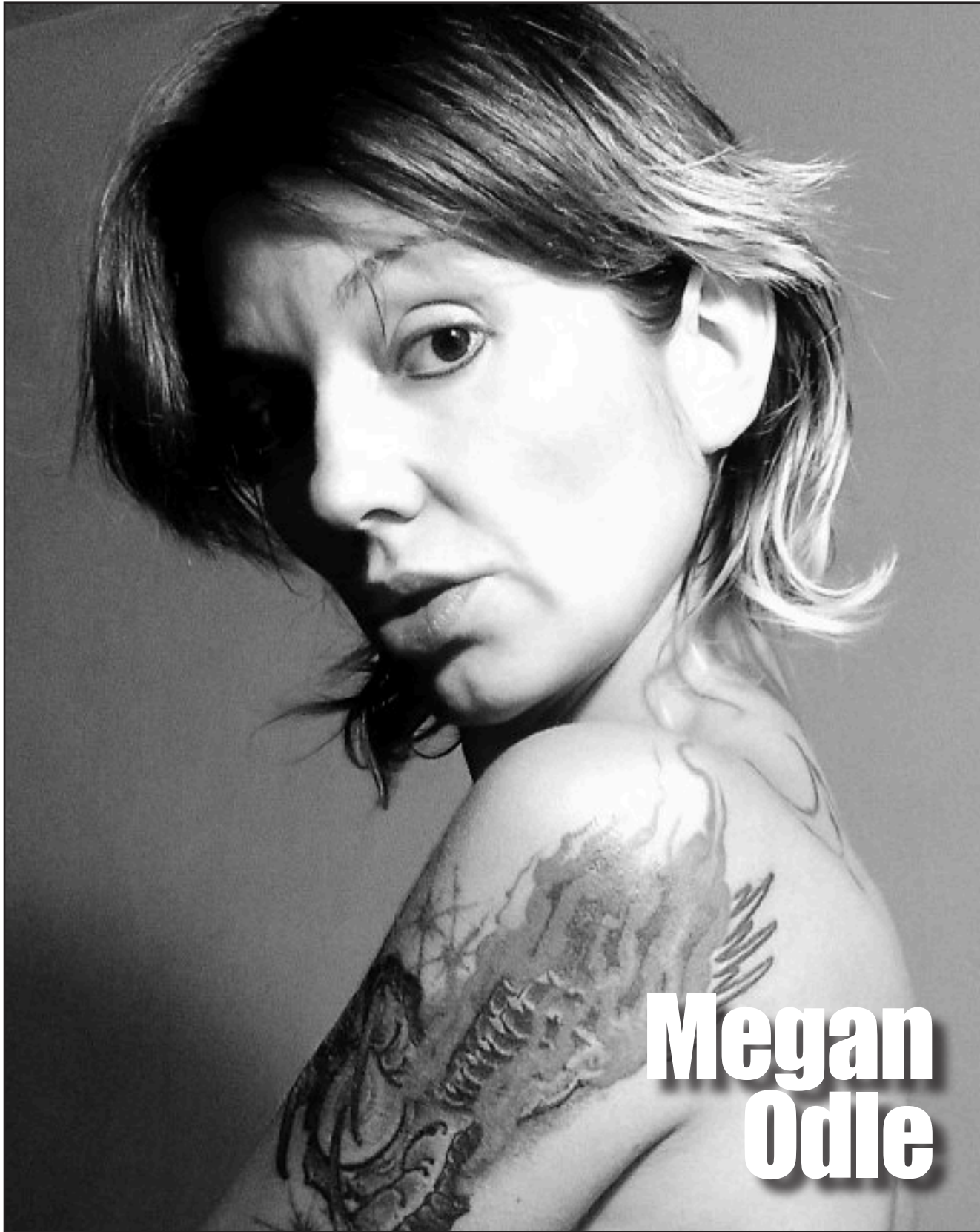
