You can achieve any of your dreams as long as you are willing to work hard enough.








My name is Antonella Amoroso and I am a dancer who loves fashion!

I love being able to express myself through my style. My style is a mix of hip hop, with a lot of sass!











served his time and was honorably discharged. I have kept it exactly stock the way he had ordered it.

Through my work, I strive to bring out the beauty of diversity and use my platforms to make something positive for others to see and follow as an example..


