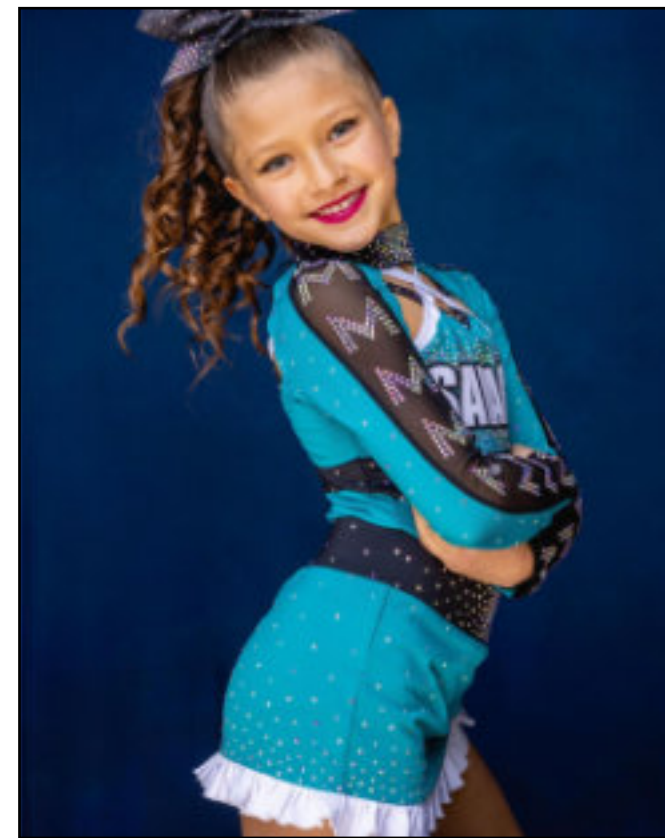
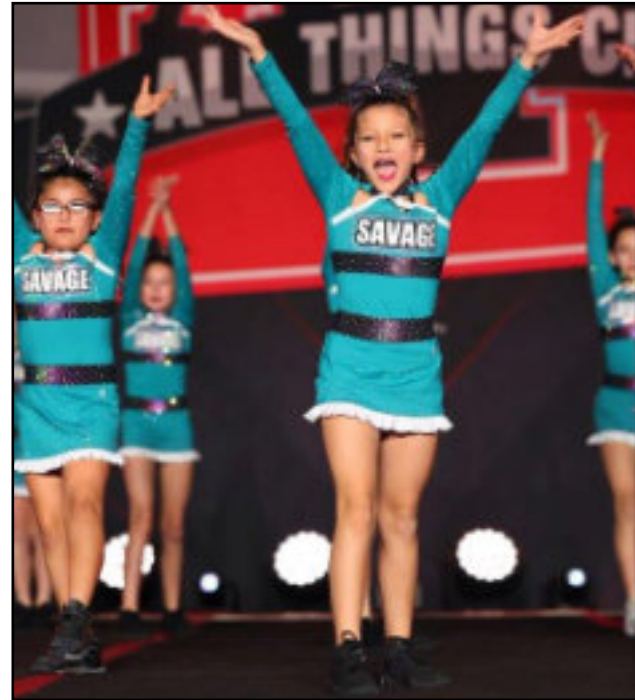
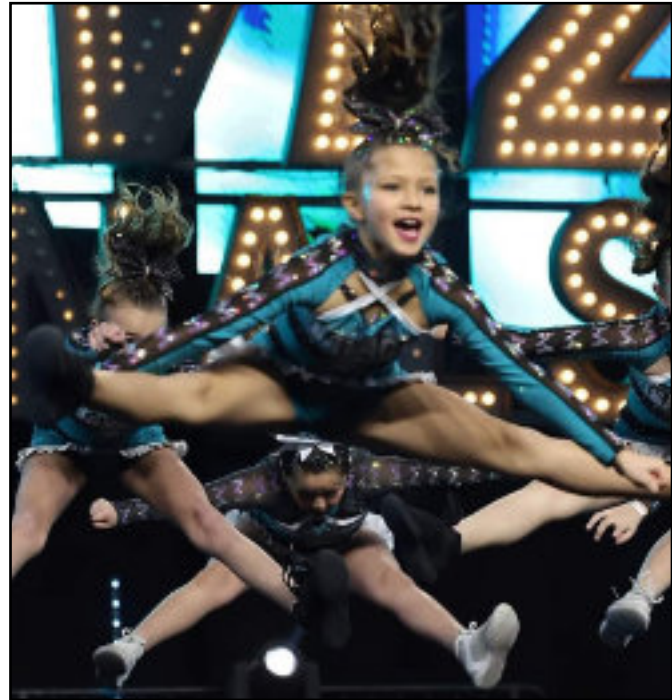
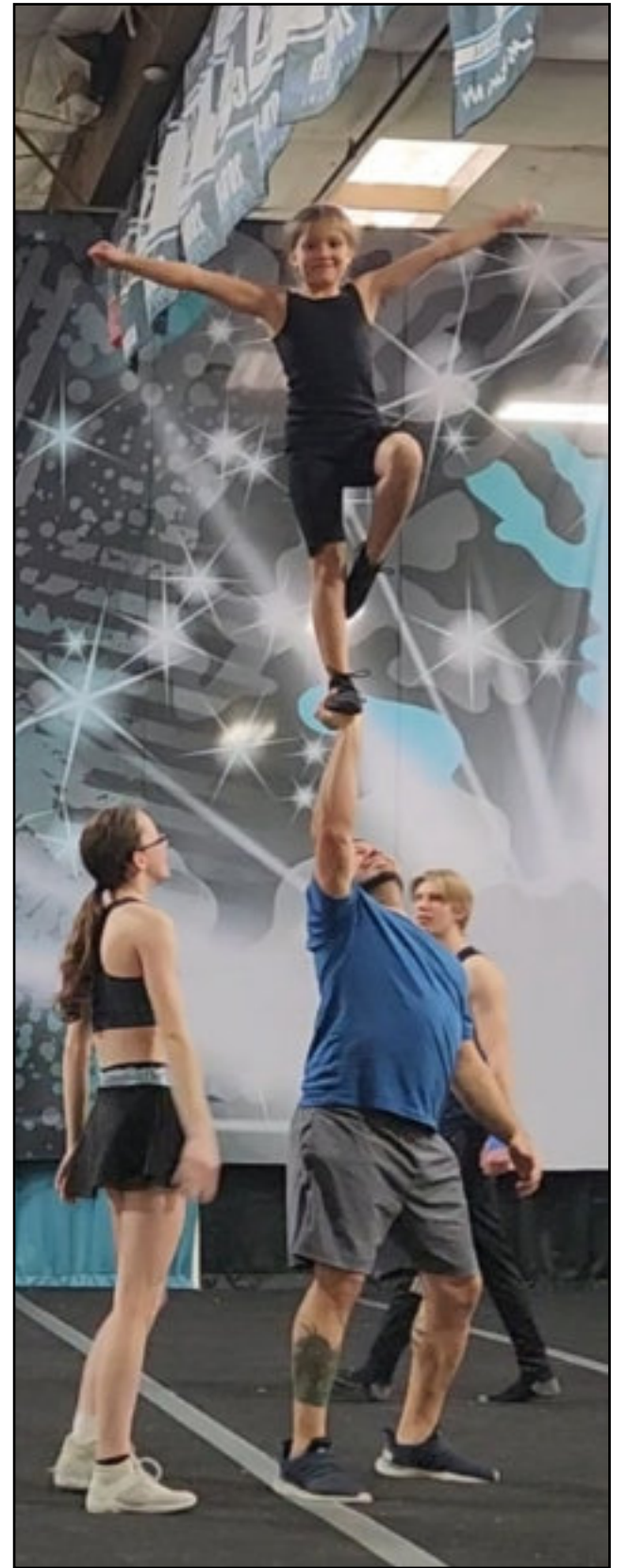
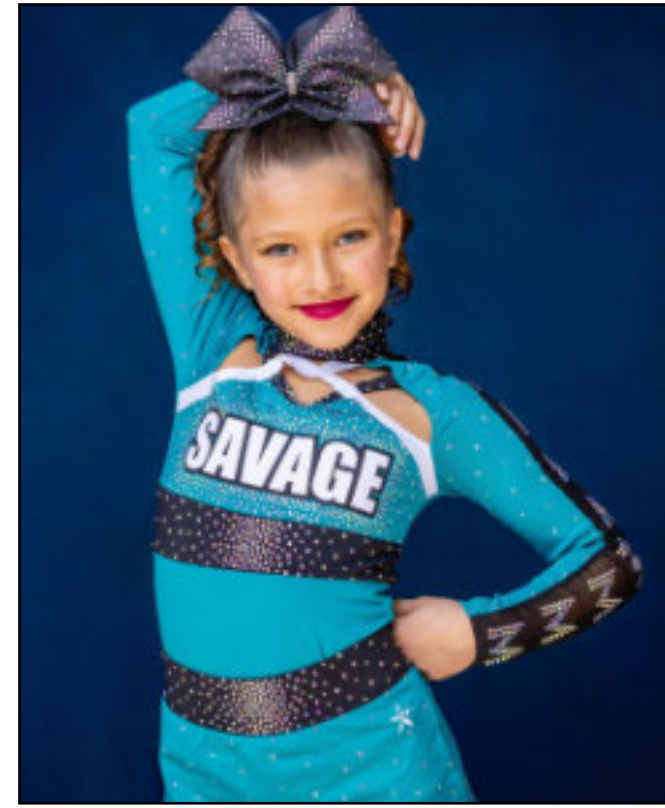
My favorite place to be is in the gym with my friends/teammates/coaches and I look forward to making it to collegiate level and then worlds.

I am currently playing a spring football league, legacy ducks

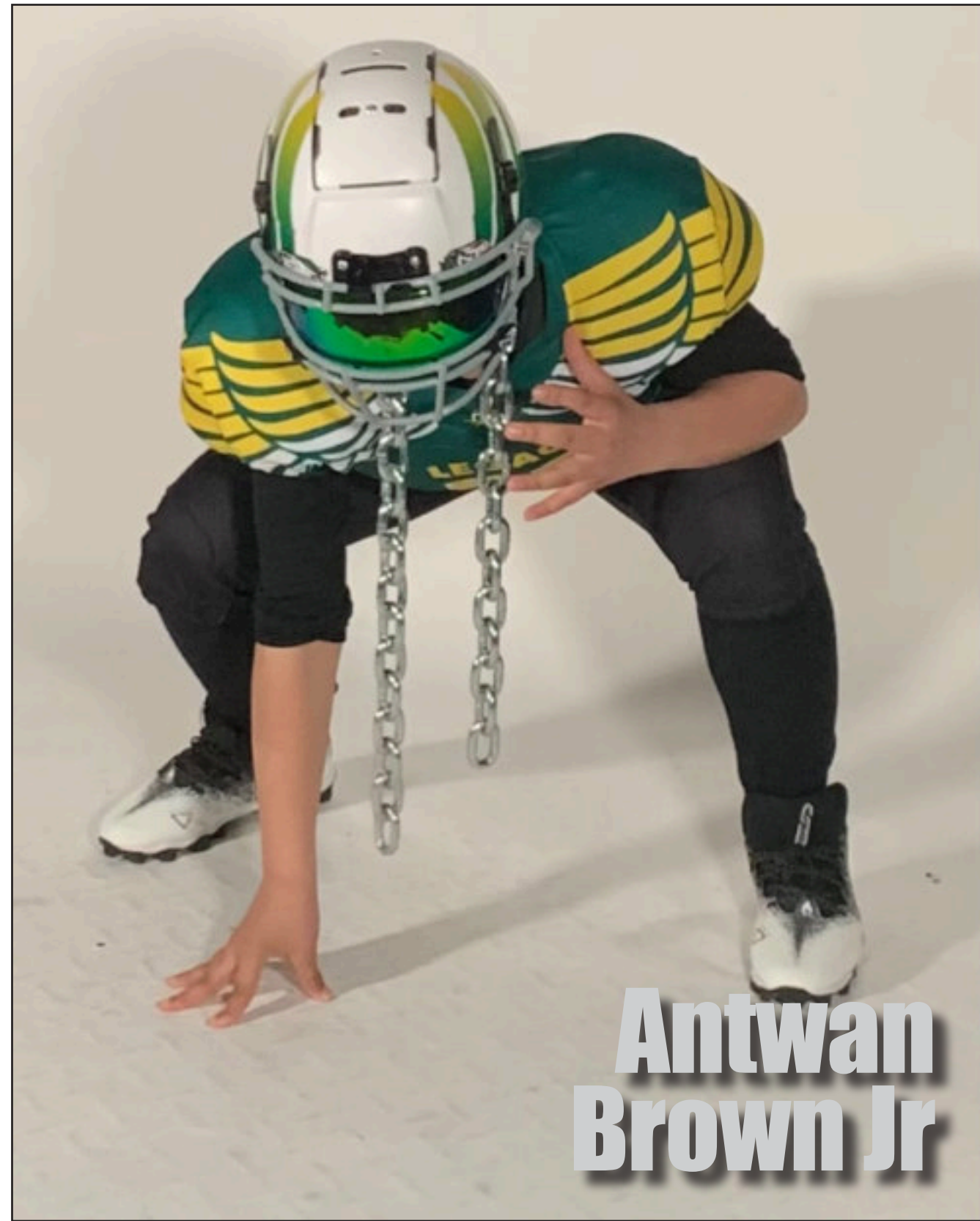
