Since then all I've wanted to do is dance, and

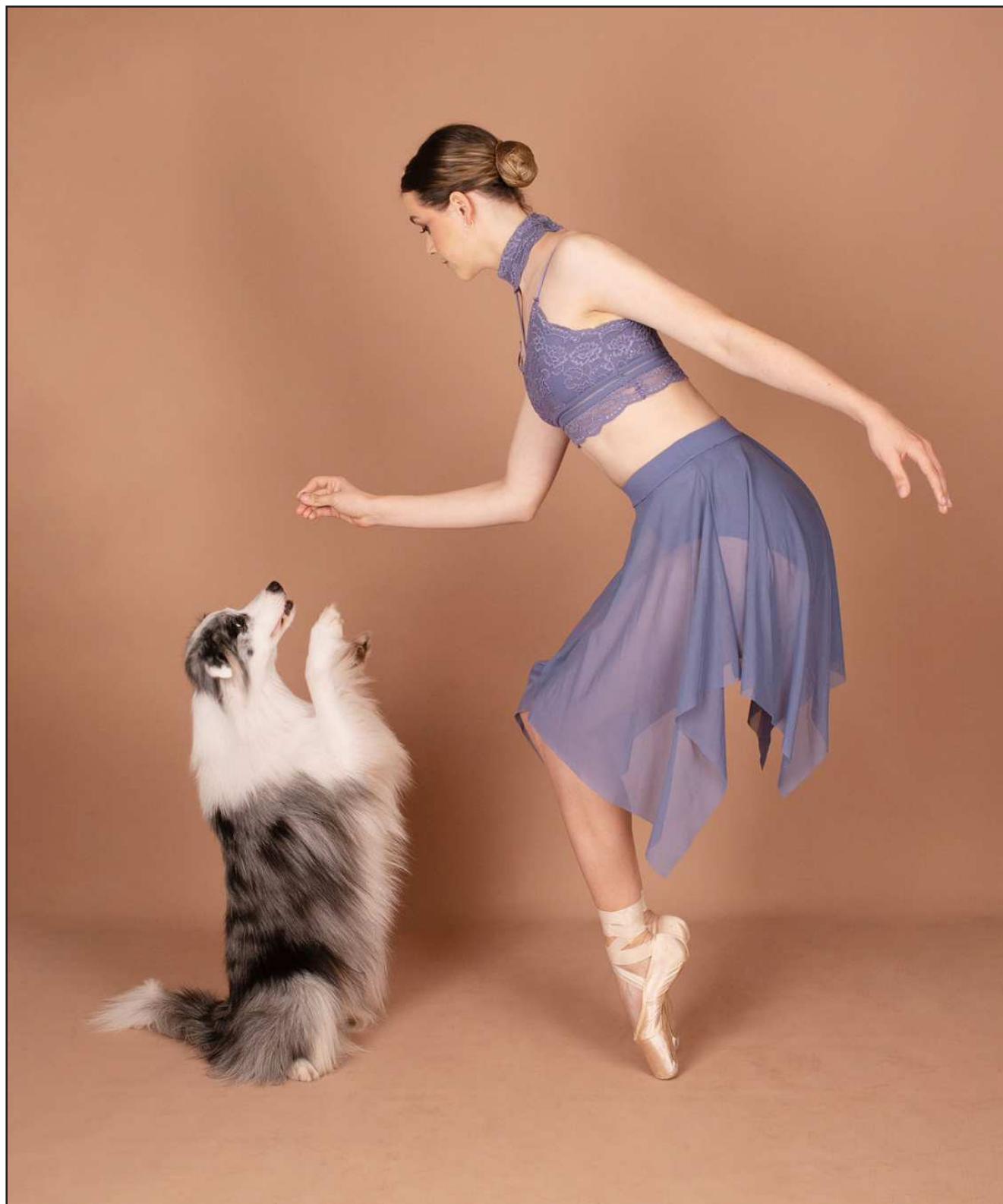
