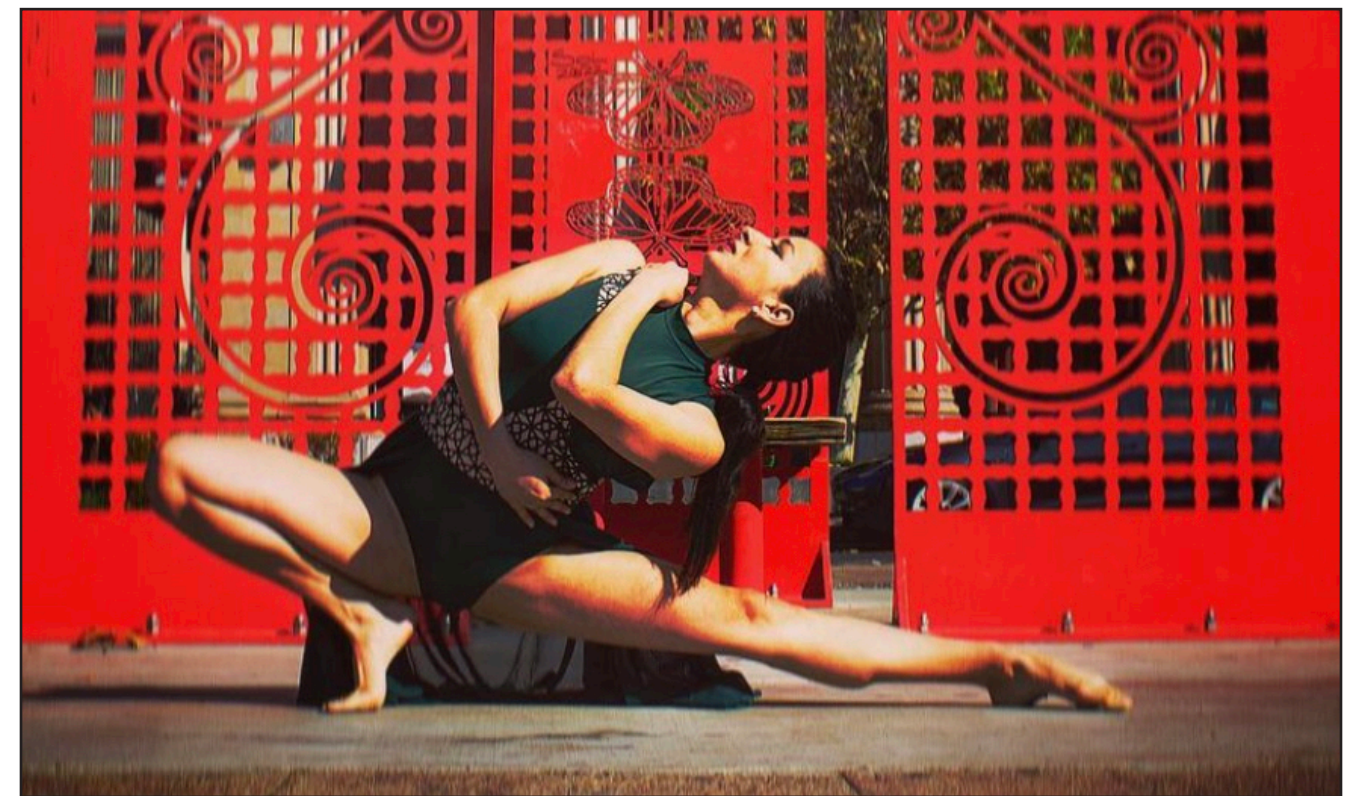

Someday I want to become a ballet instructor and teach with the same passion that I have been dancing through the years.

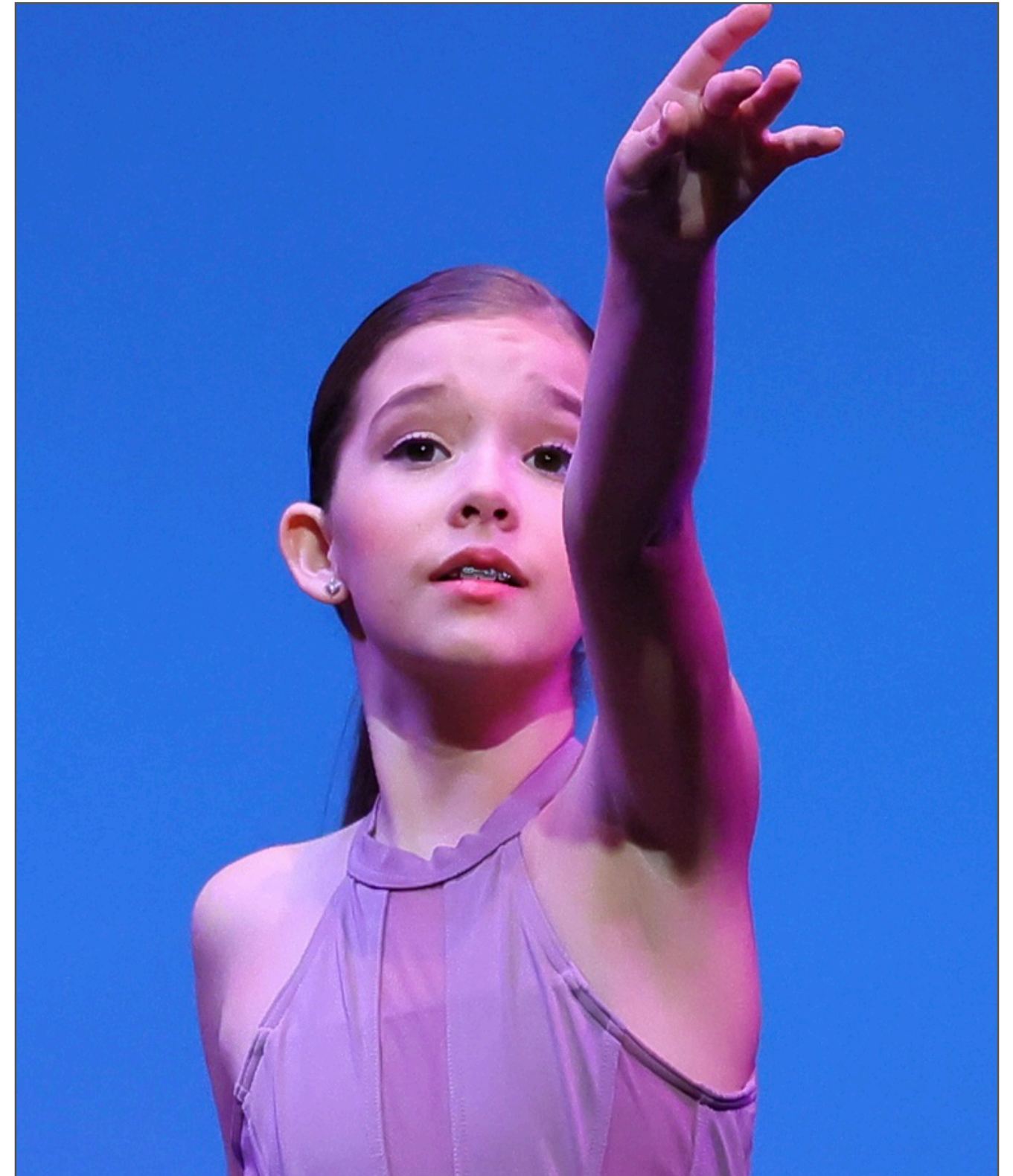

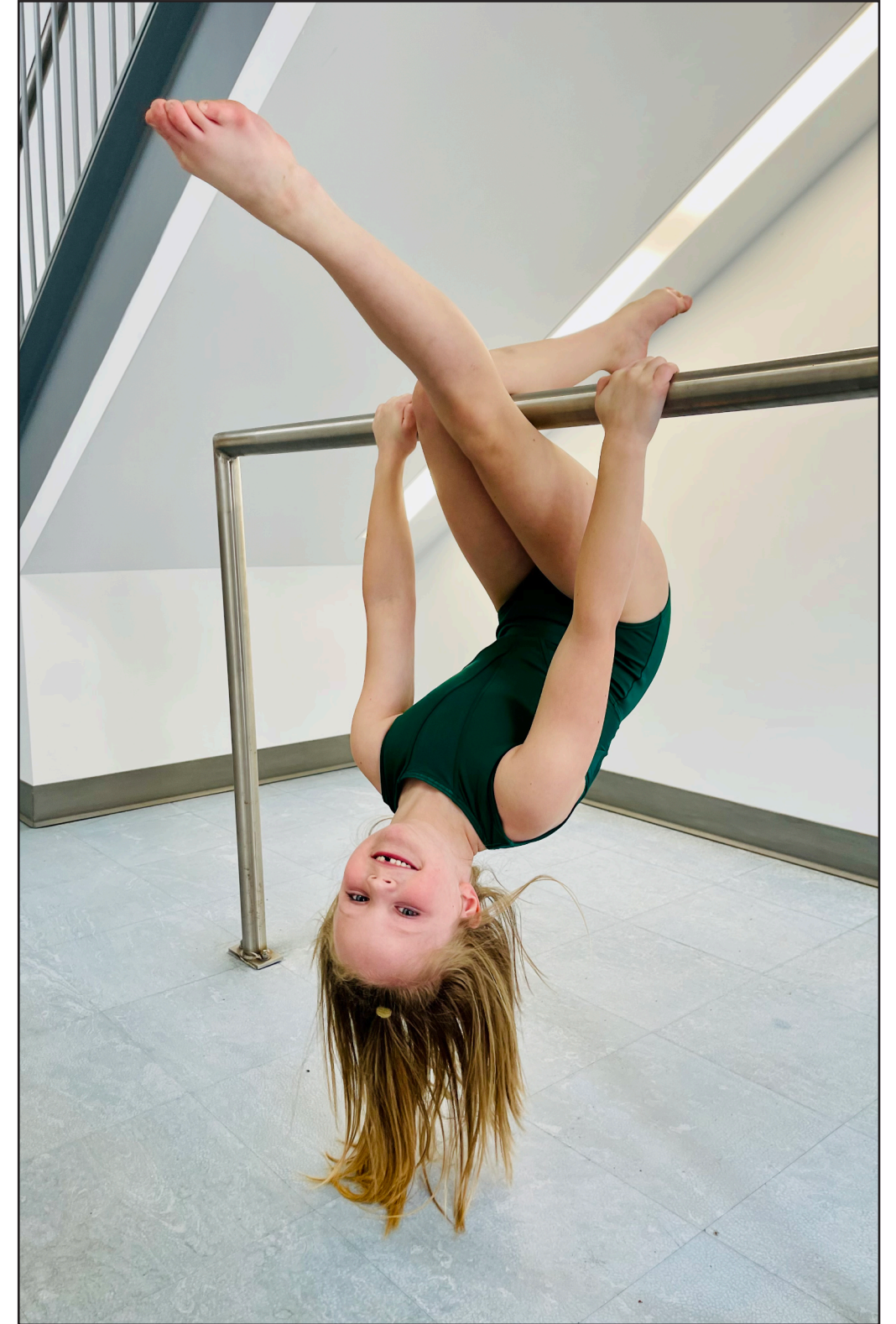




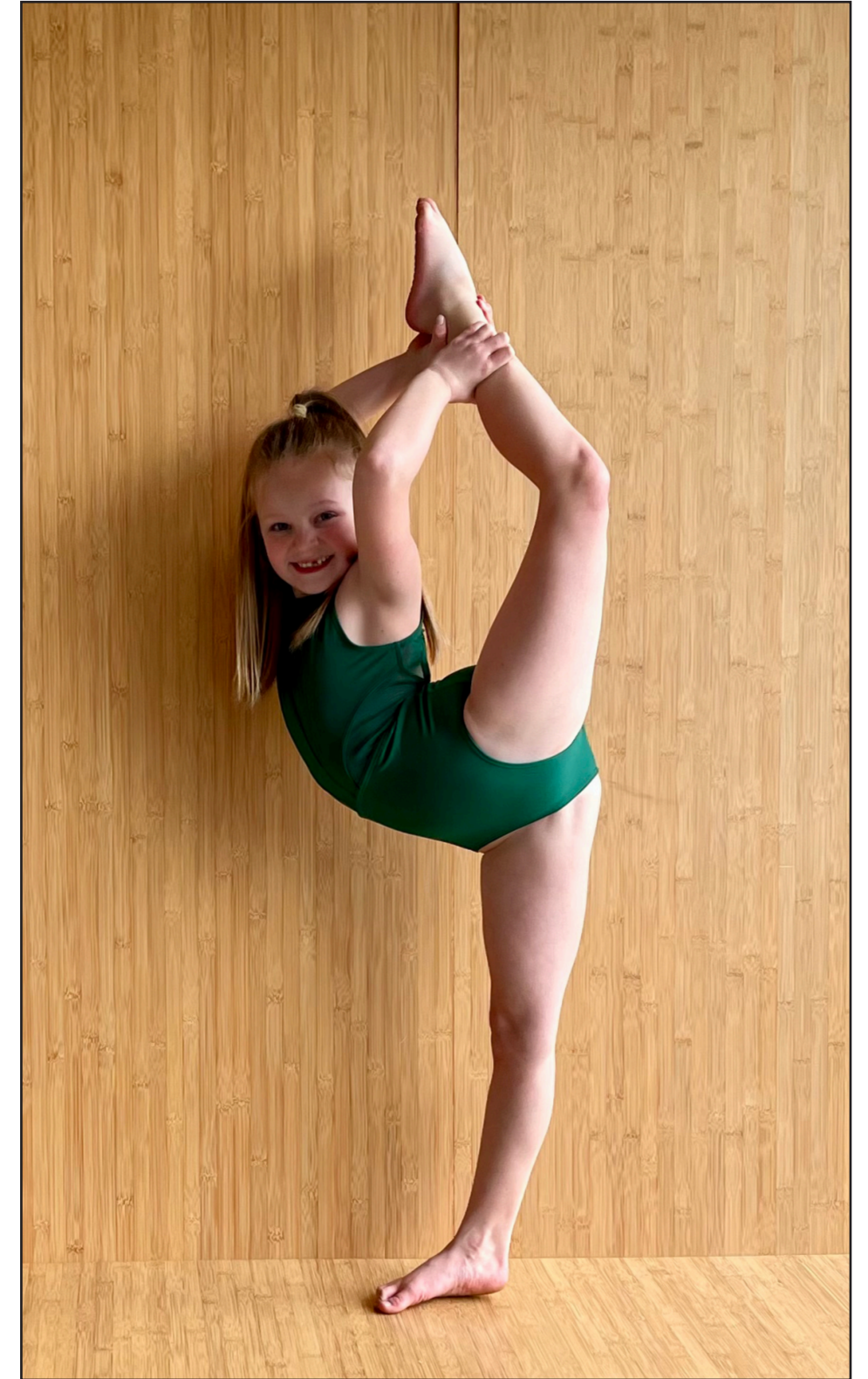
Eliot Catherine

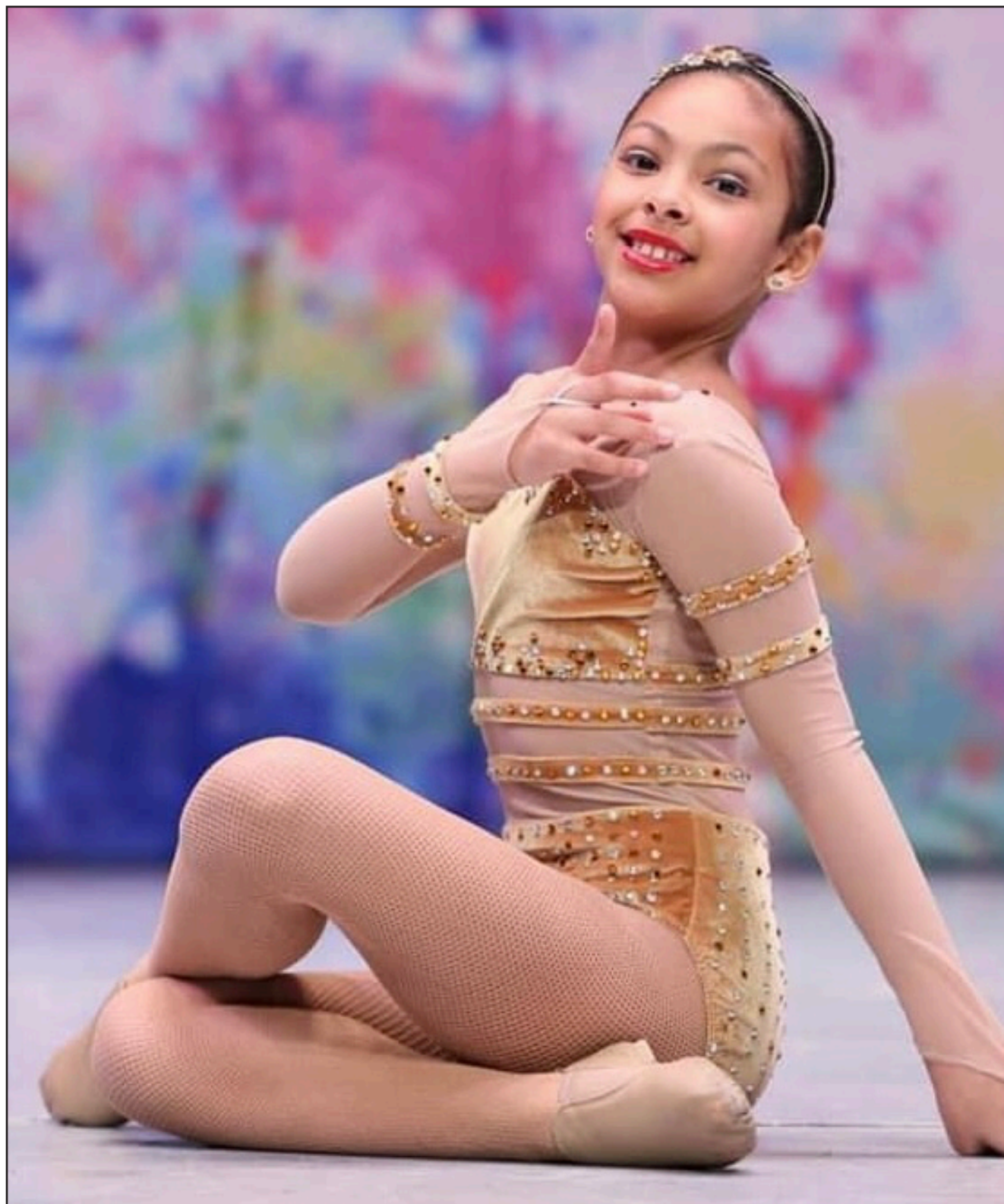
Melody Bencosme

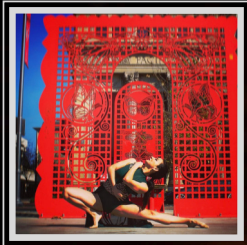
