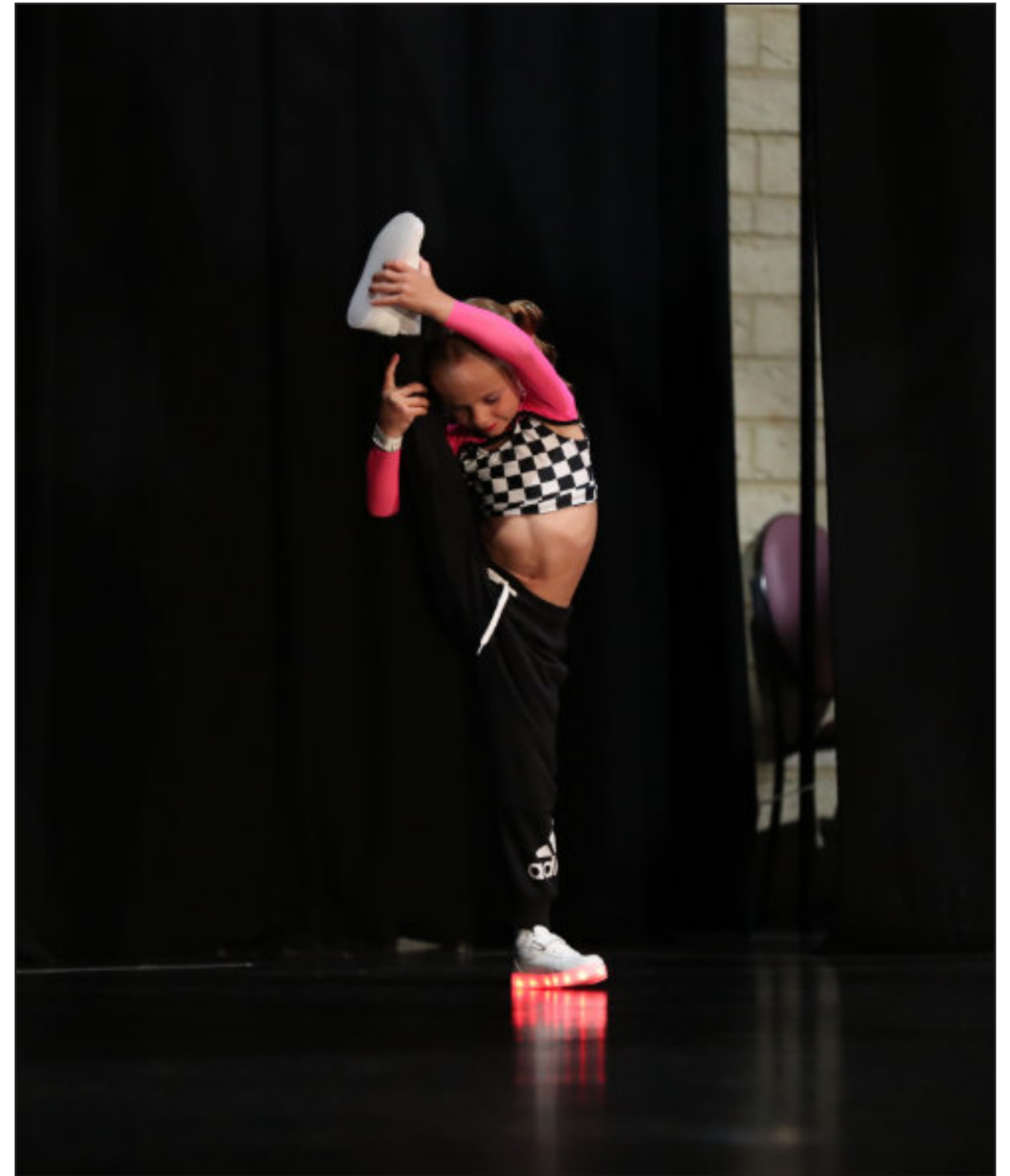


Stella Humphries

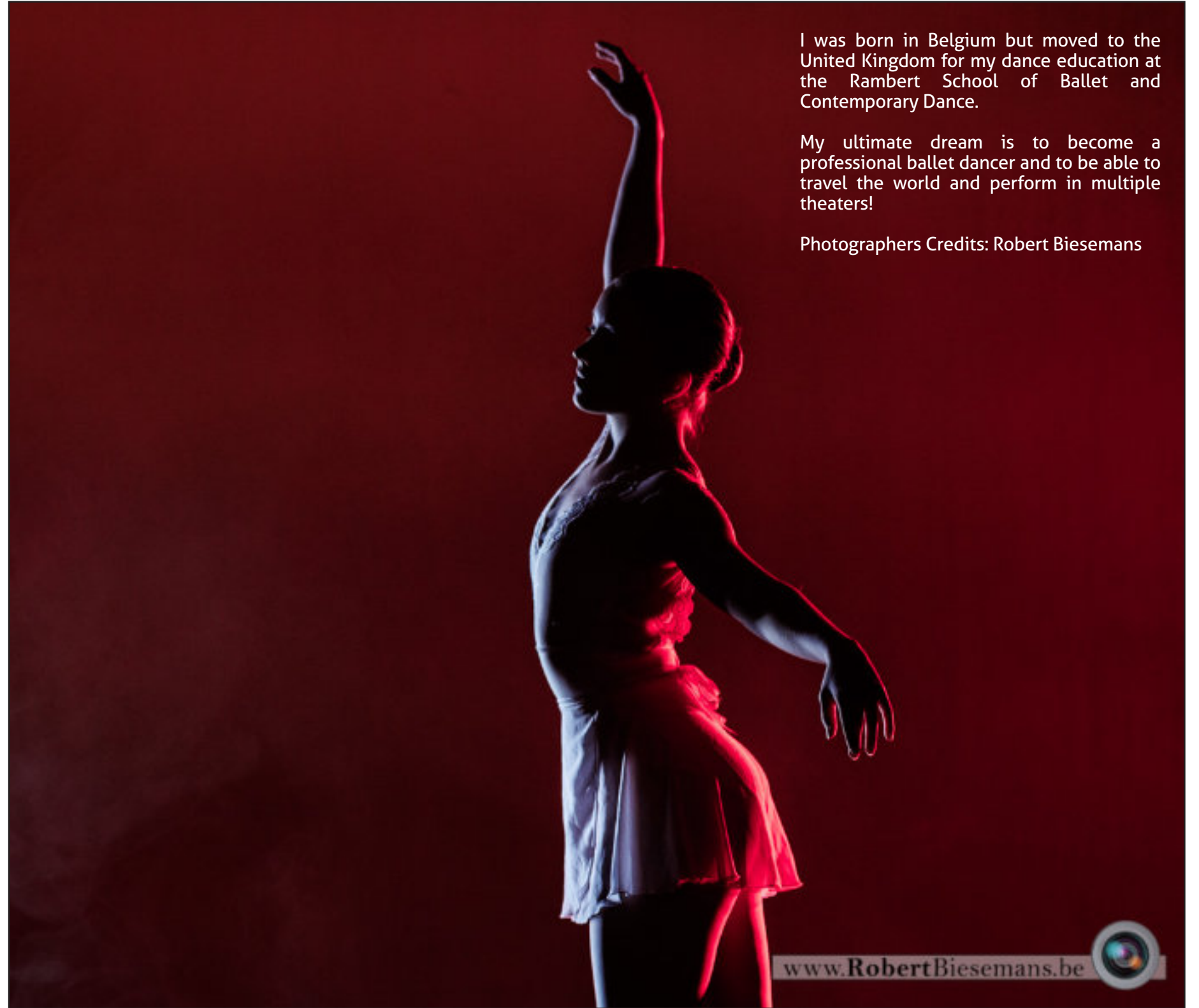

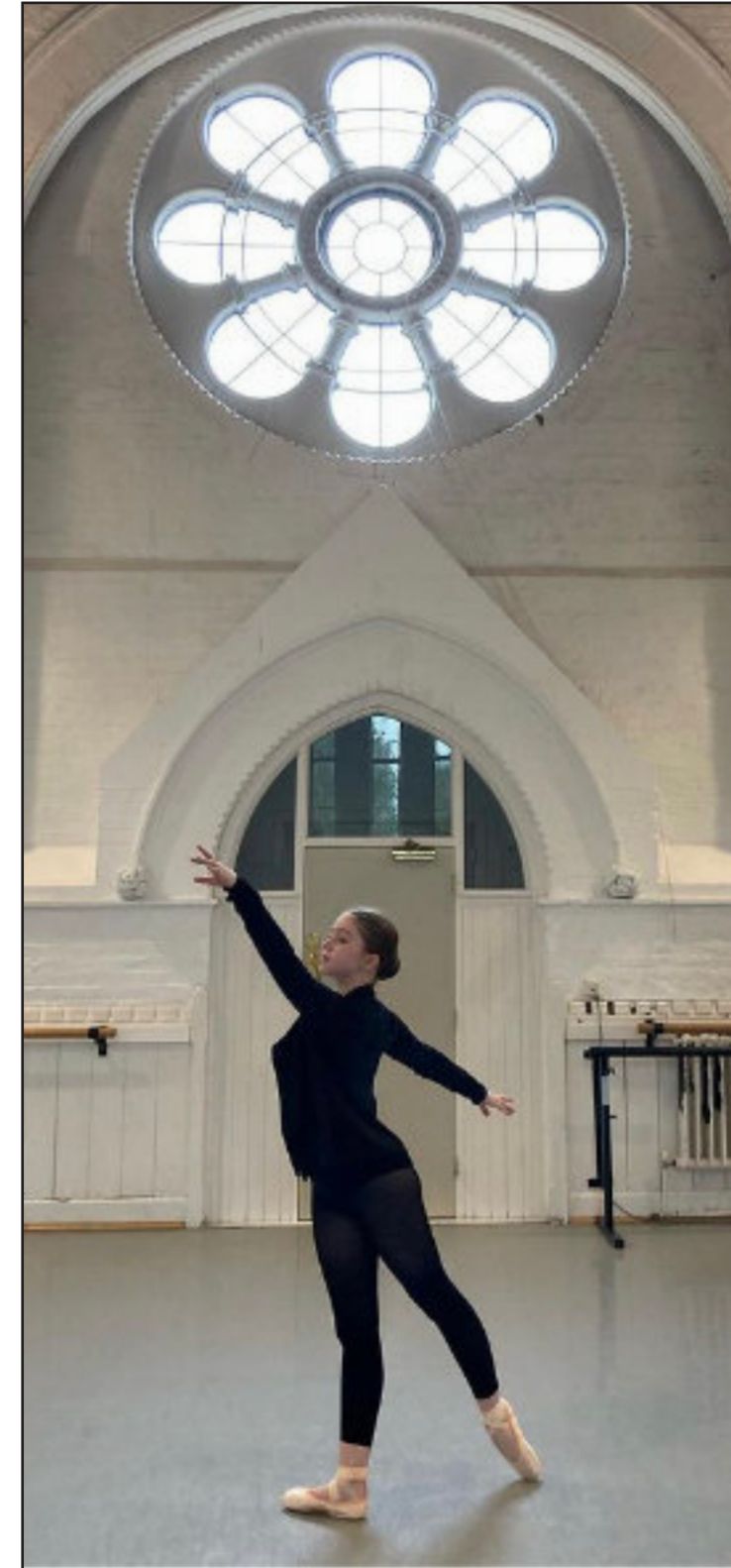


I was born in Belgium but moved to the United Kingdom for my dance education at the Rambert School of Ballet and Contemporary Dance.

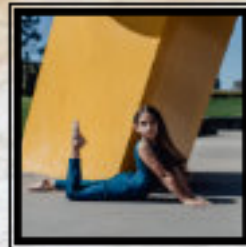
