color guard program at Tarpon springs high school's conservatory for the arts. I have grown so much since when I started at 6 years old and I hope to only grow more as a dancer.

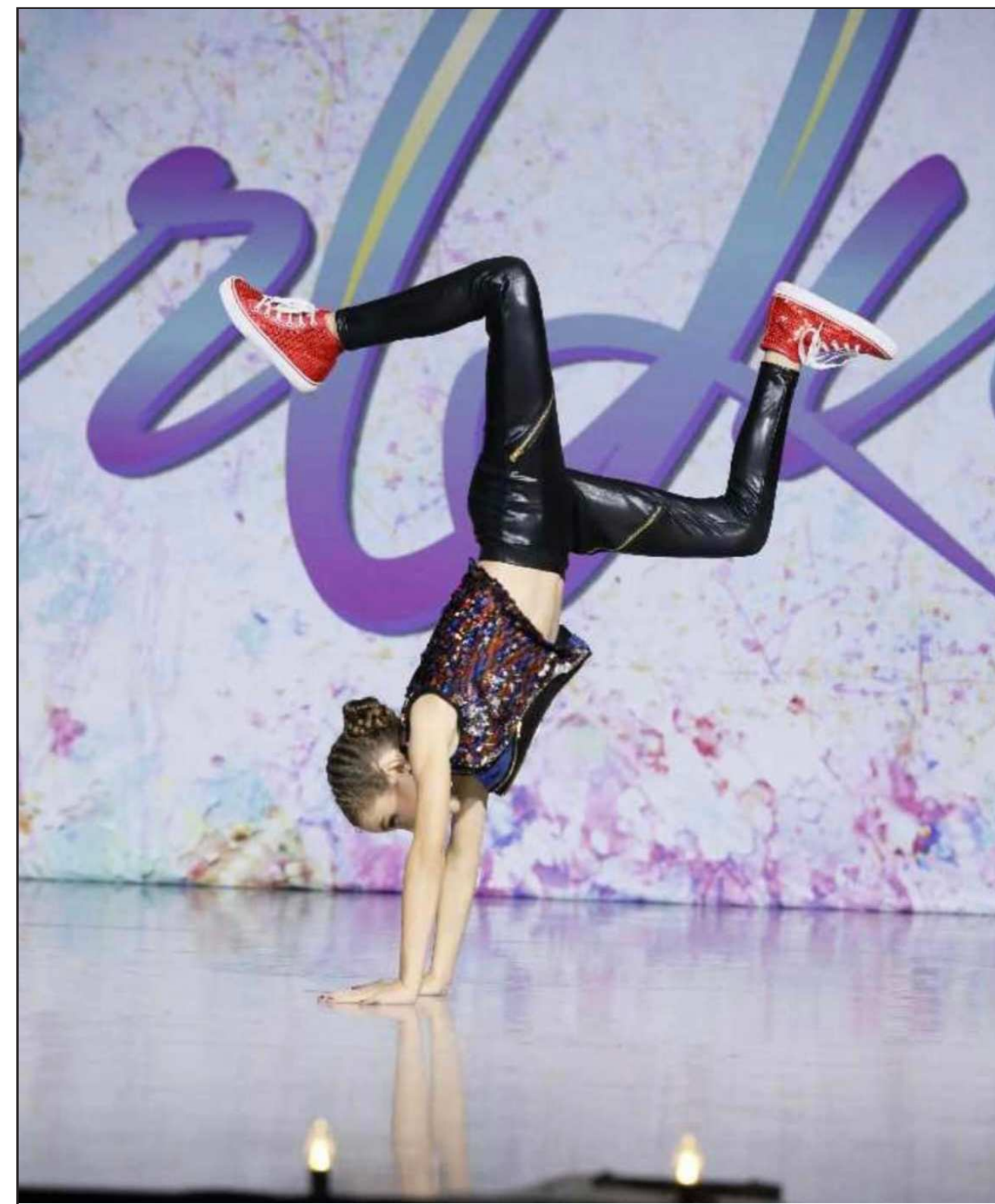

competition I got the highest achievement I could get, a Double Platinum Award! It was a very exciting end to the season and I can't wait to practice hard for next year ❤️

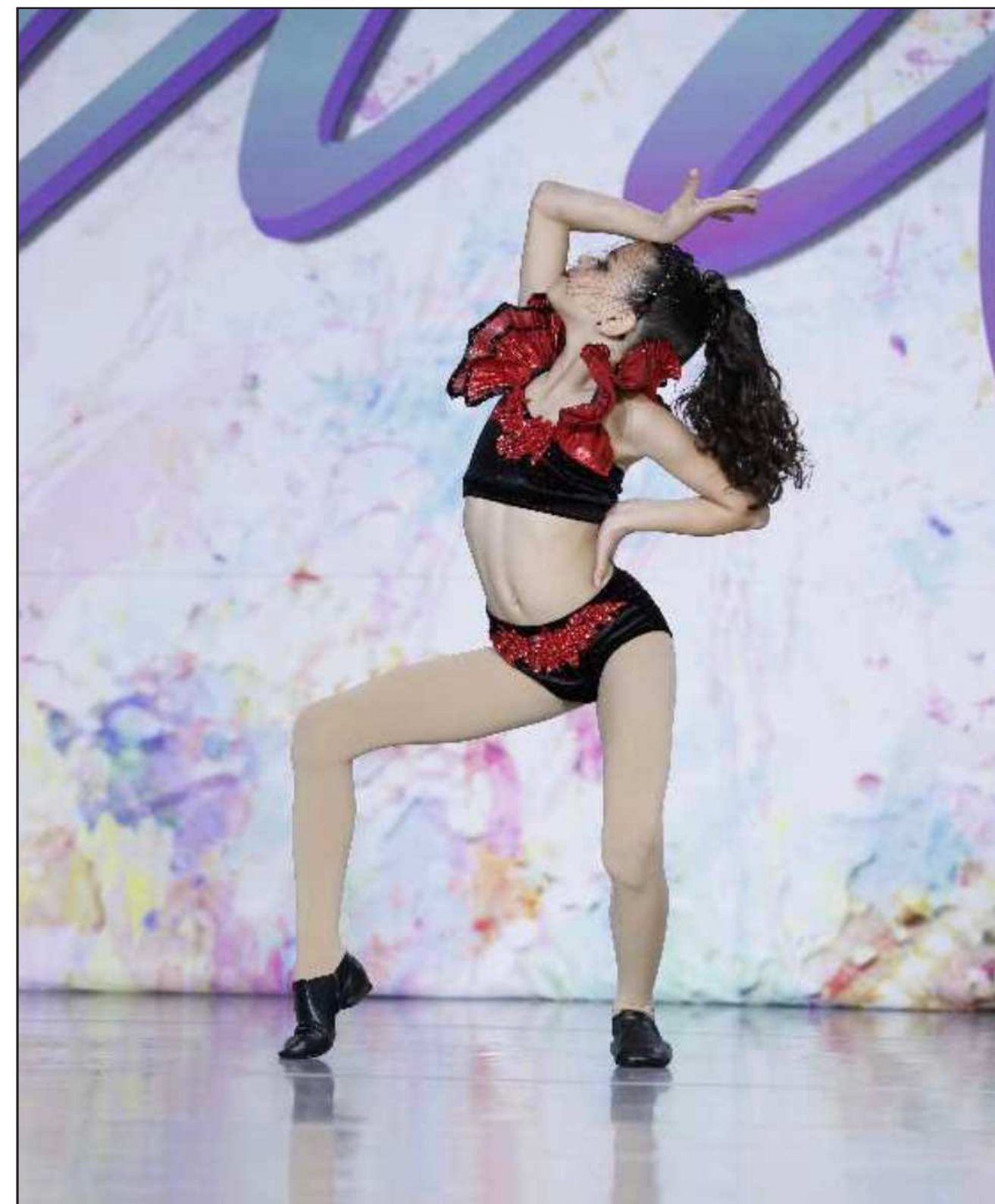

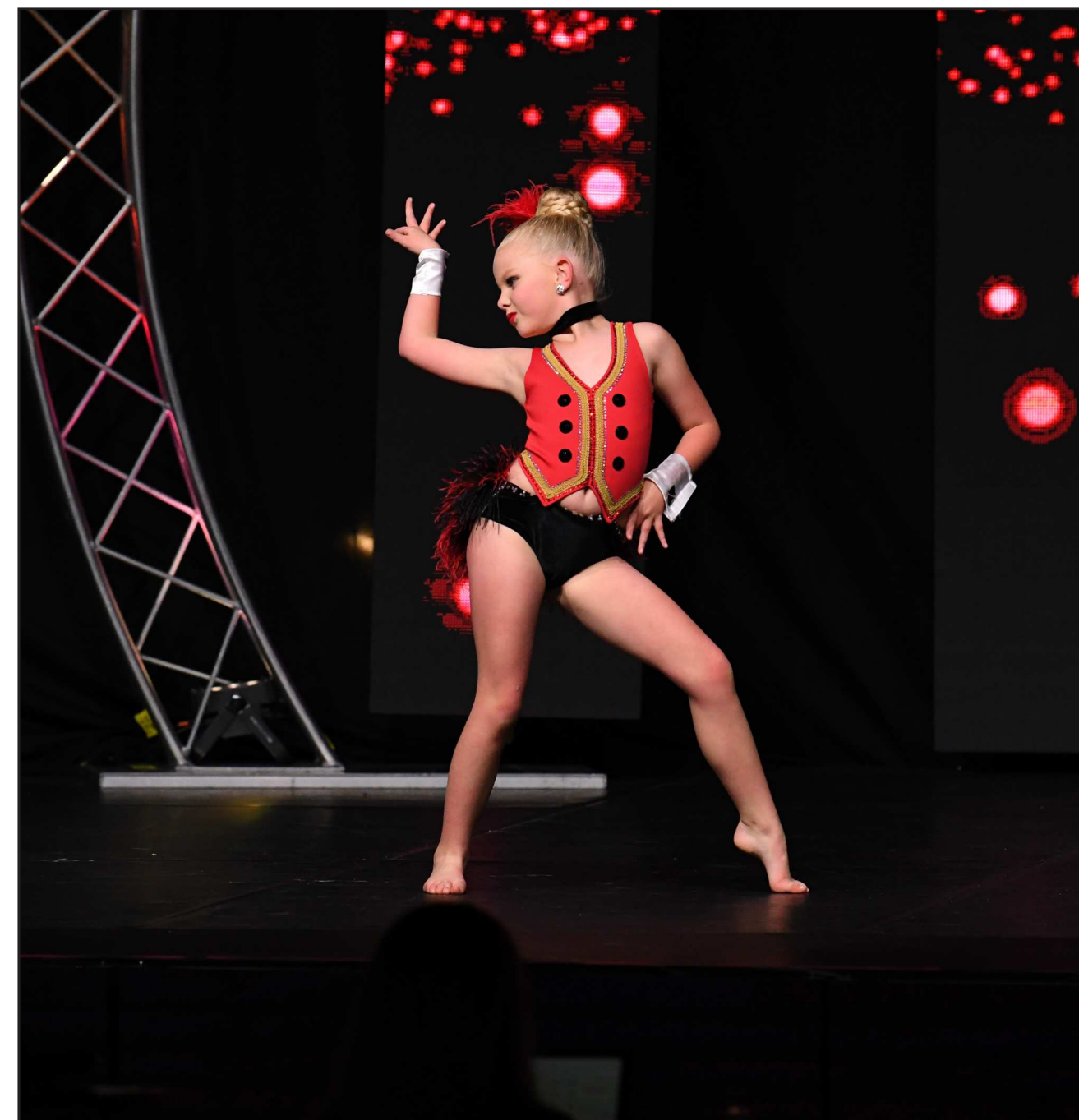

myself and learning new skills and tricks! When I grow up I want to be a dance teacher so that I can share my love of dance with others.



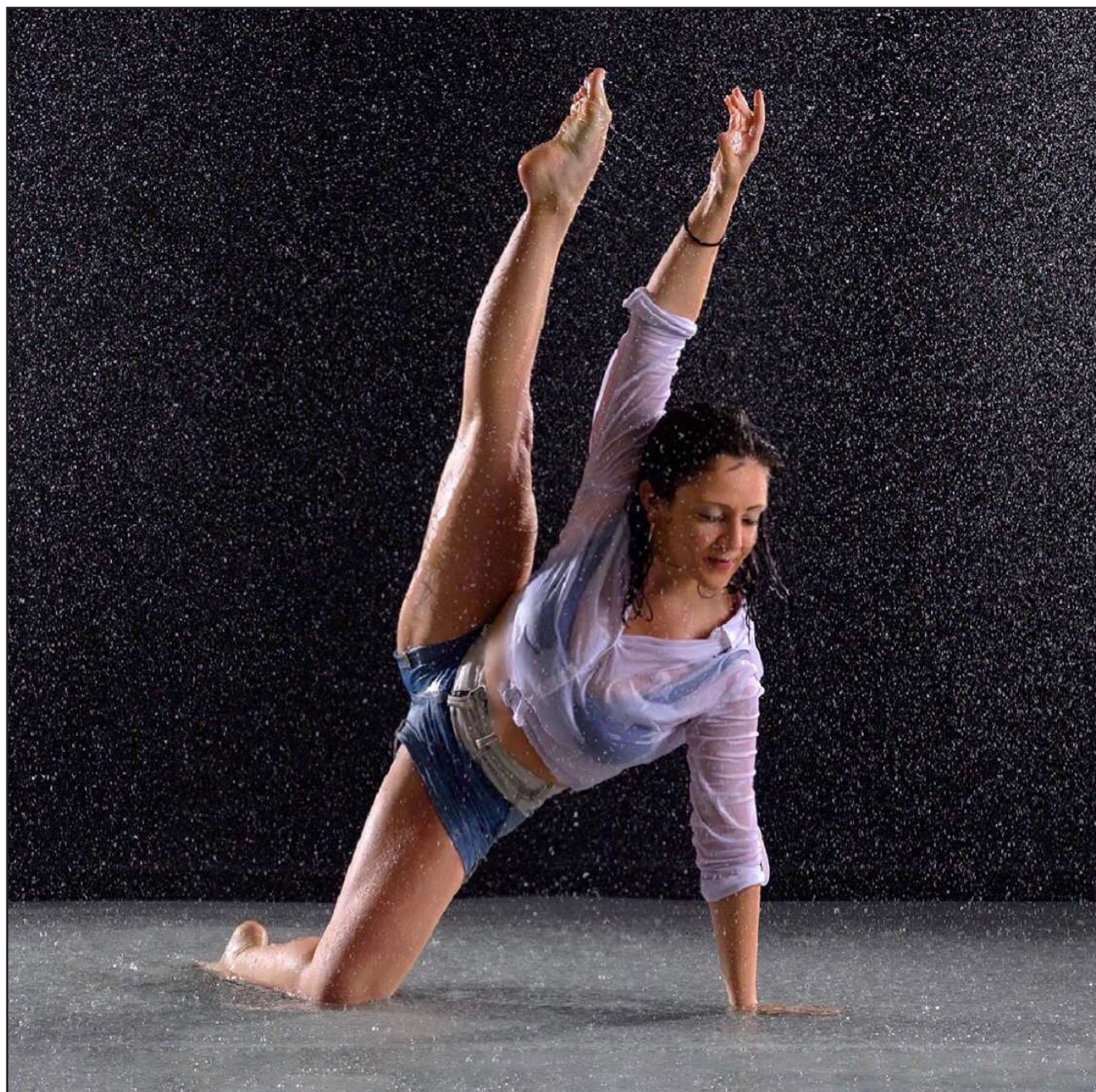

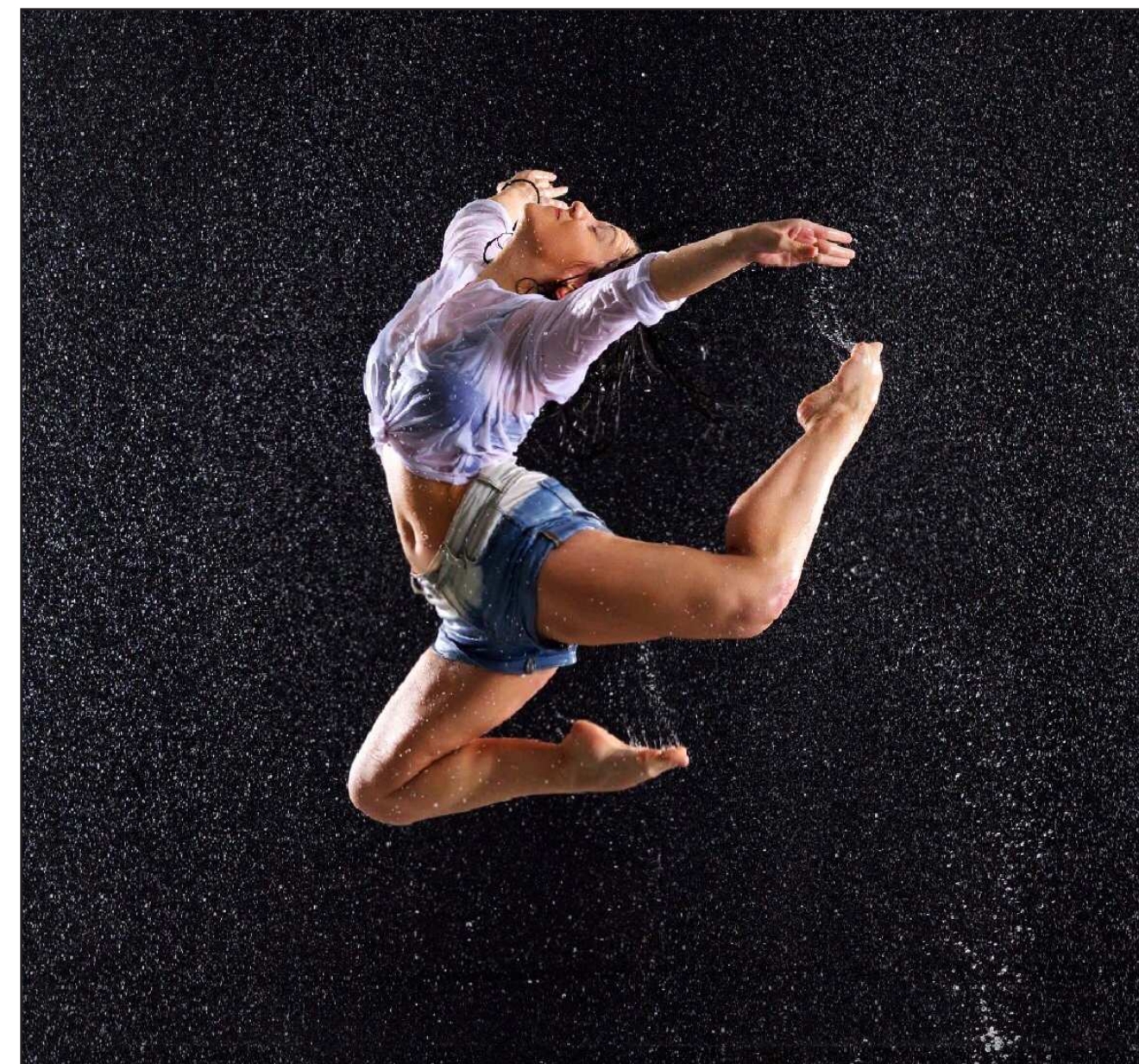
