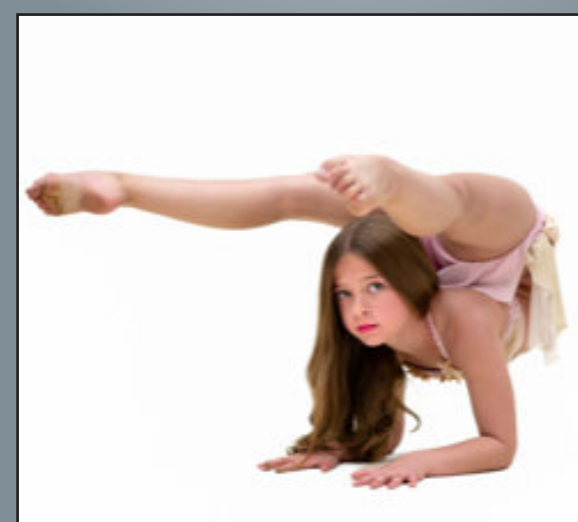
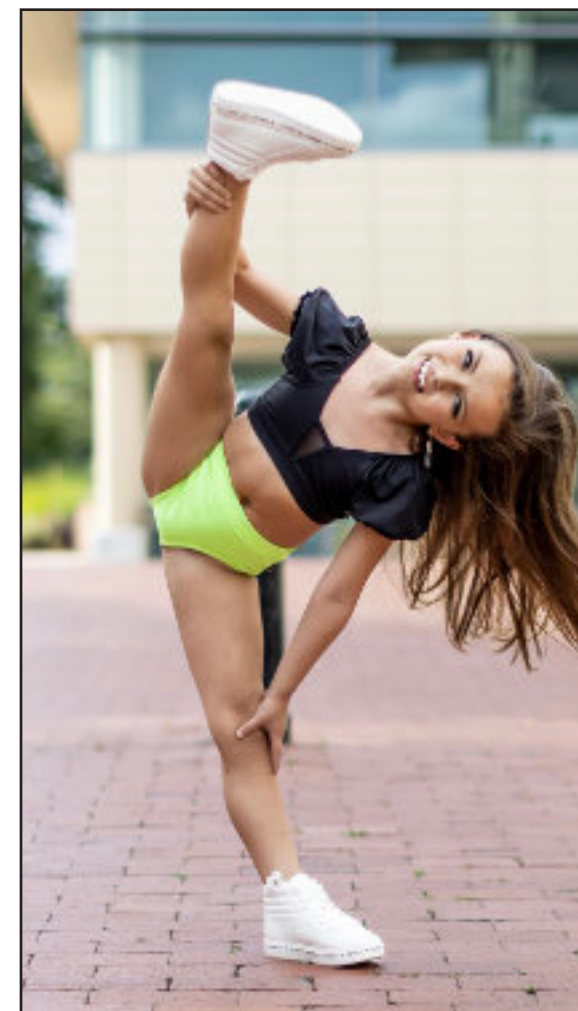

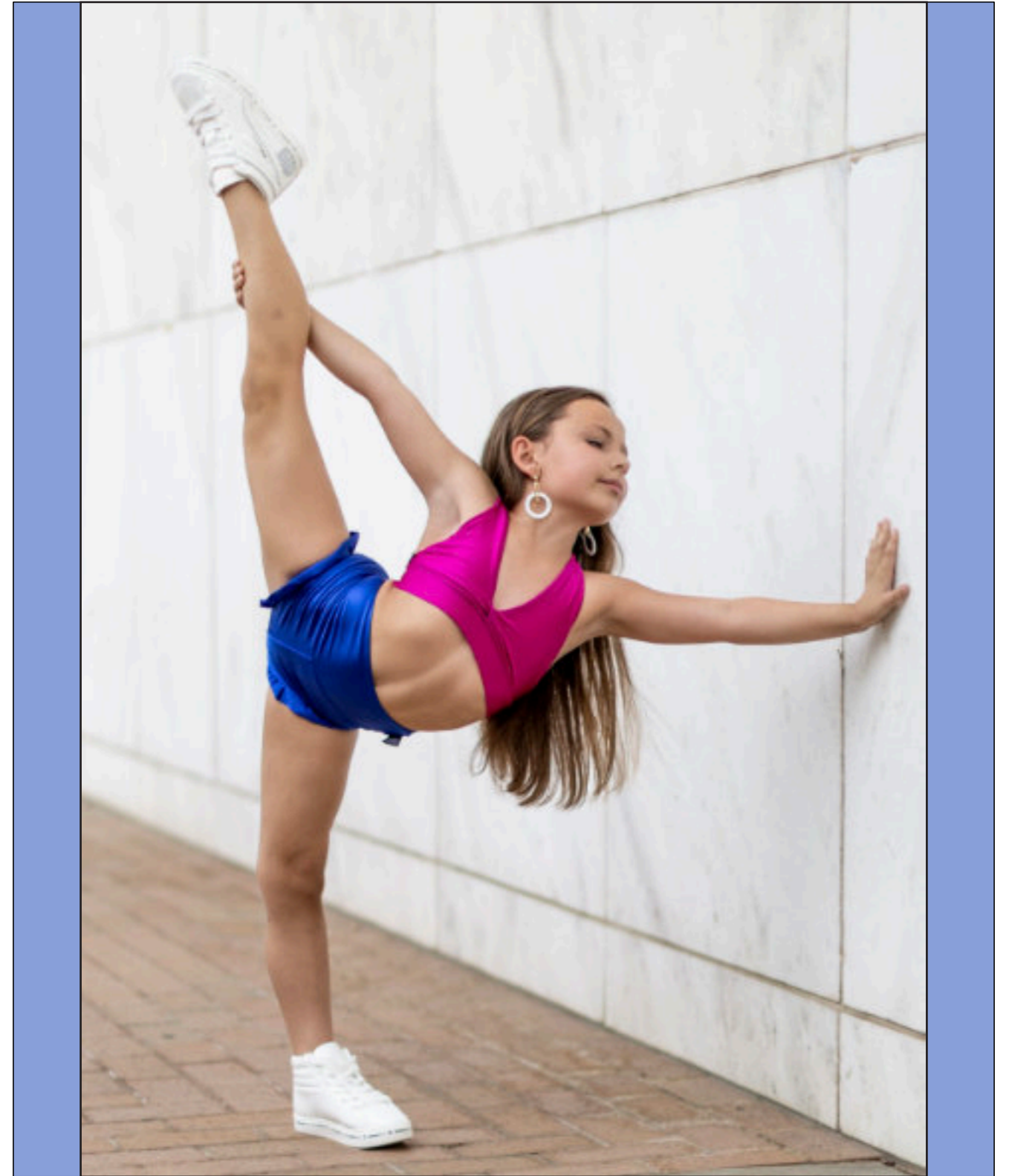
AnnaCameron Mcglohorn

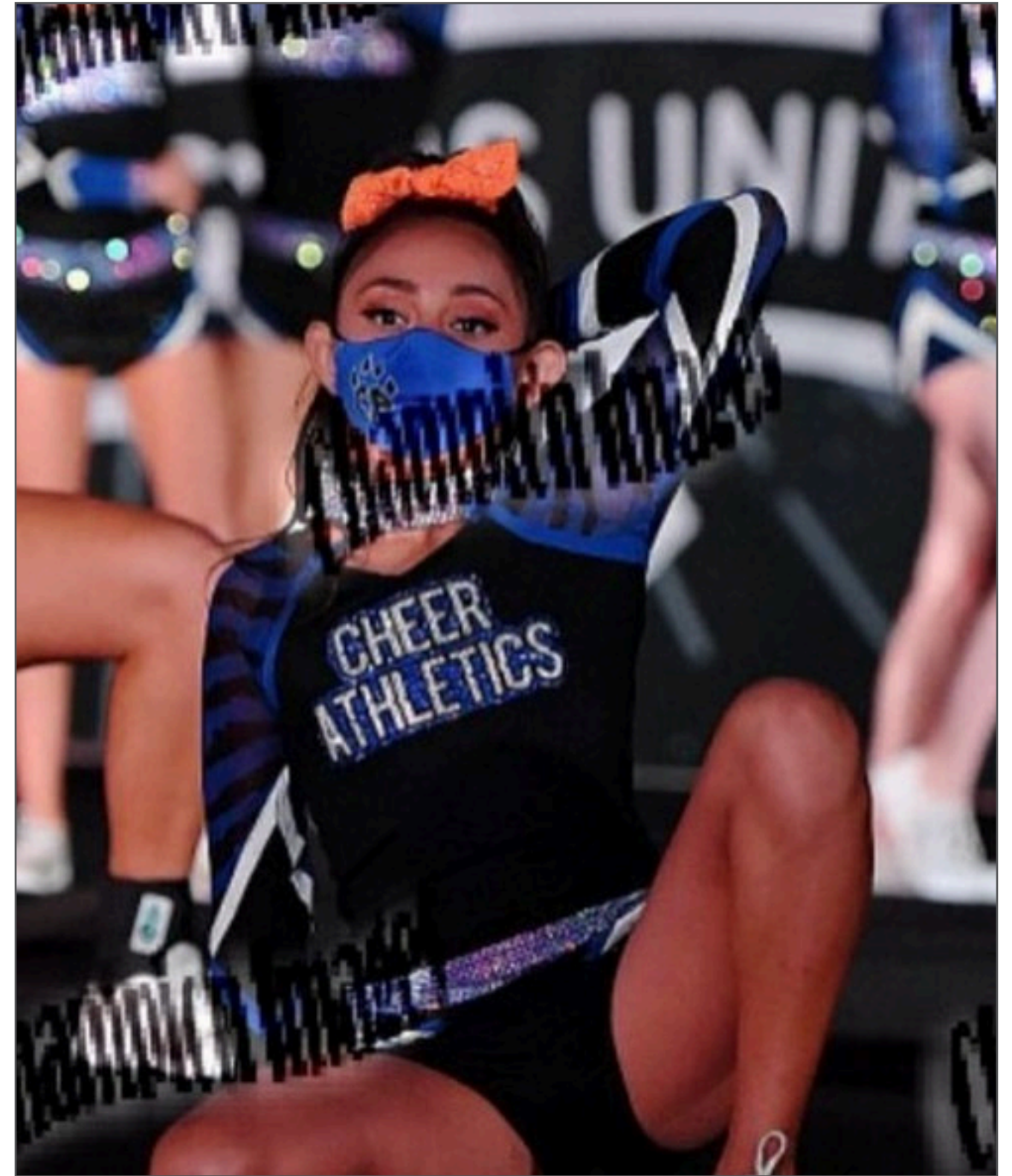


Bella Grace

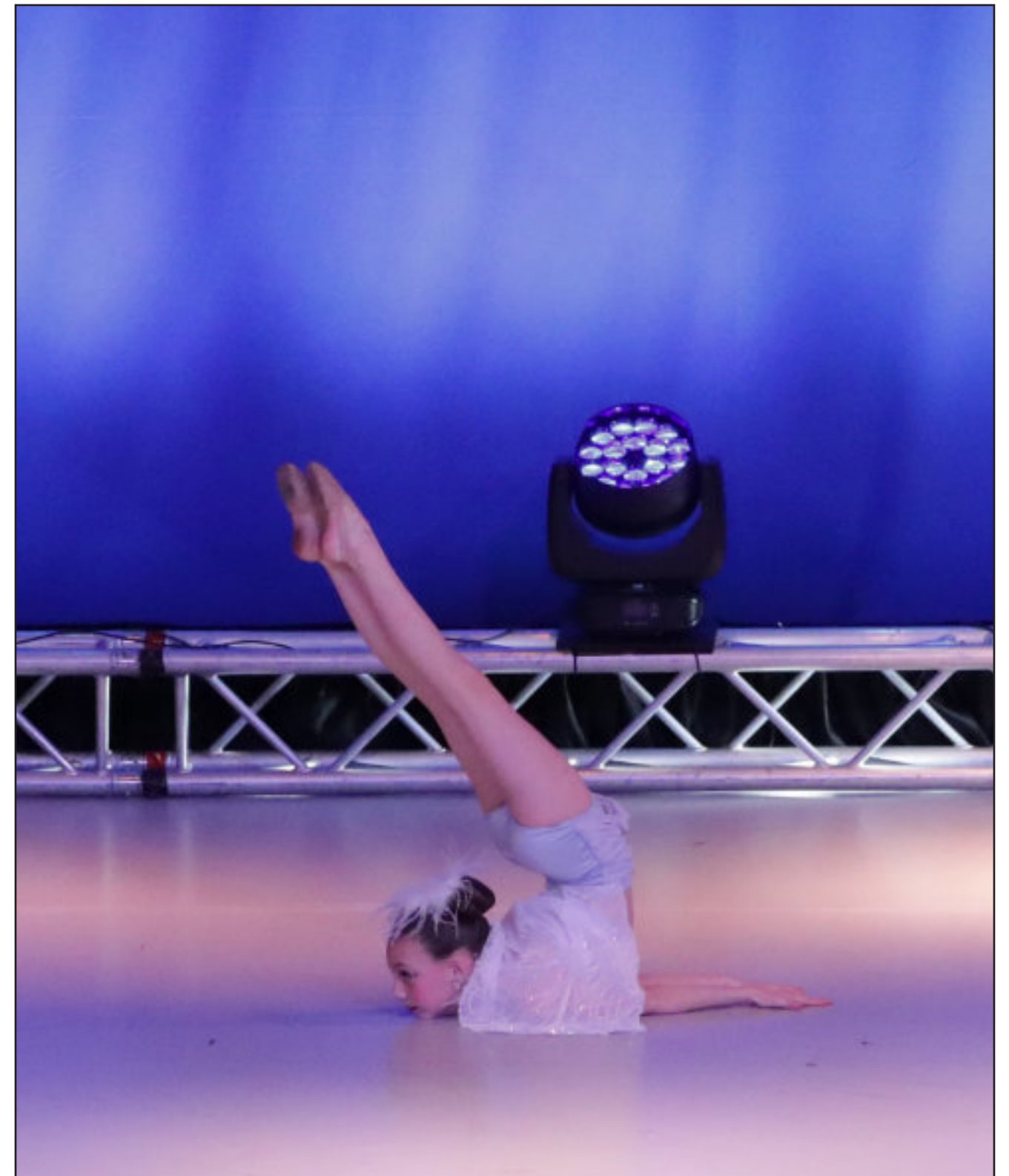
for my competitions. I am motivated to have a great year ahead and to work hard to realise my dreams. I want to do so with the help of my family friends and dance club.

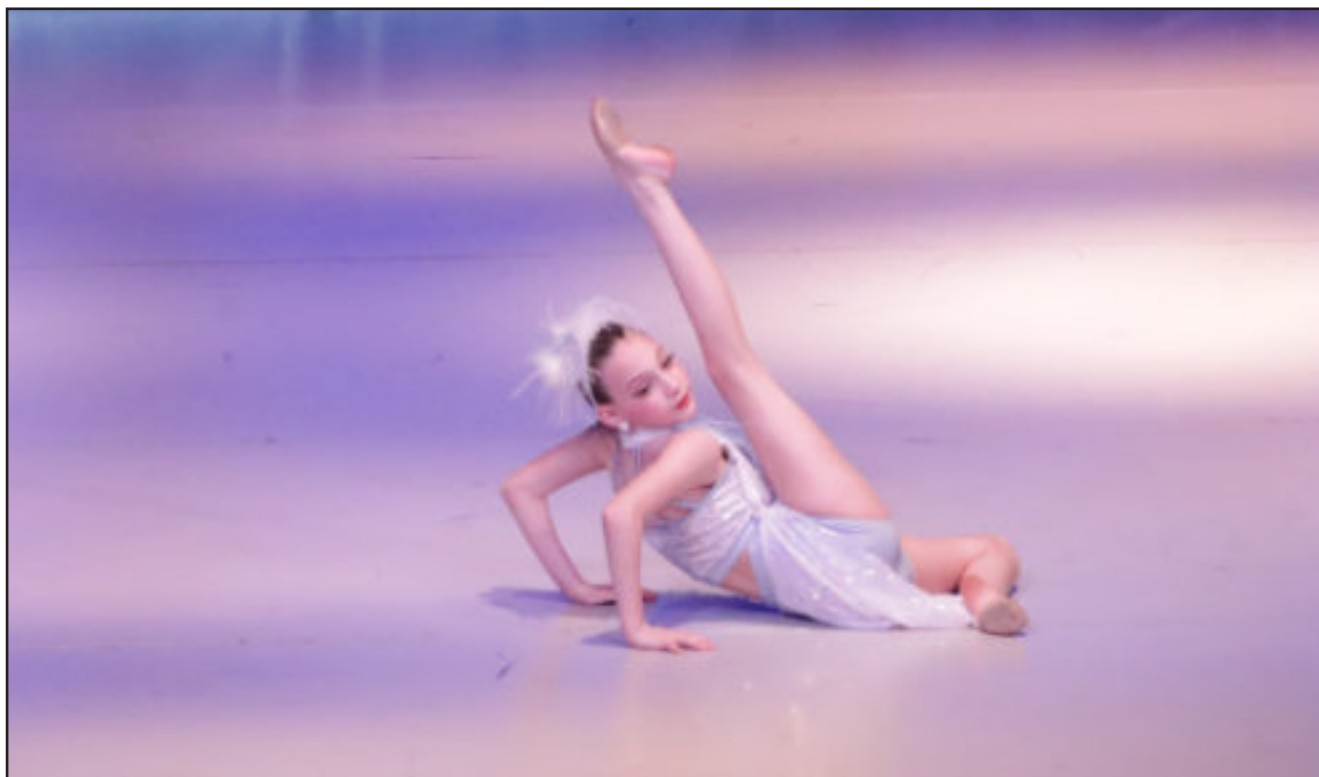

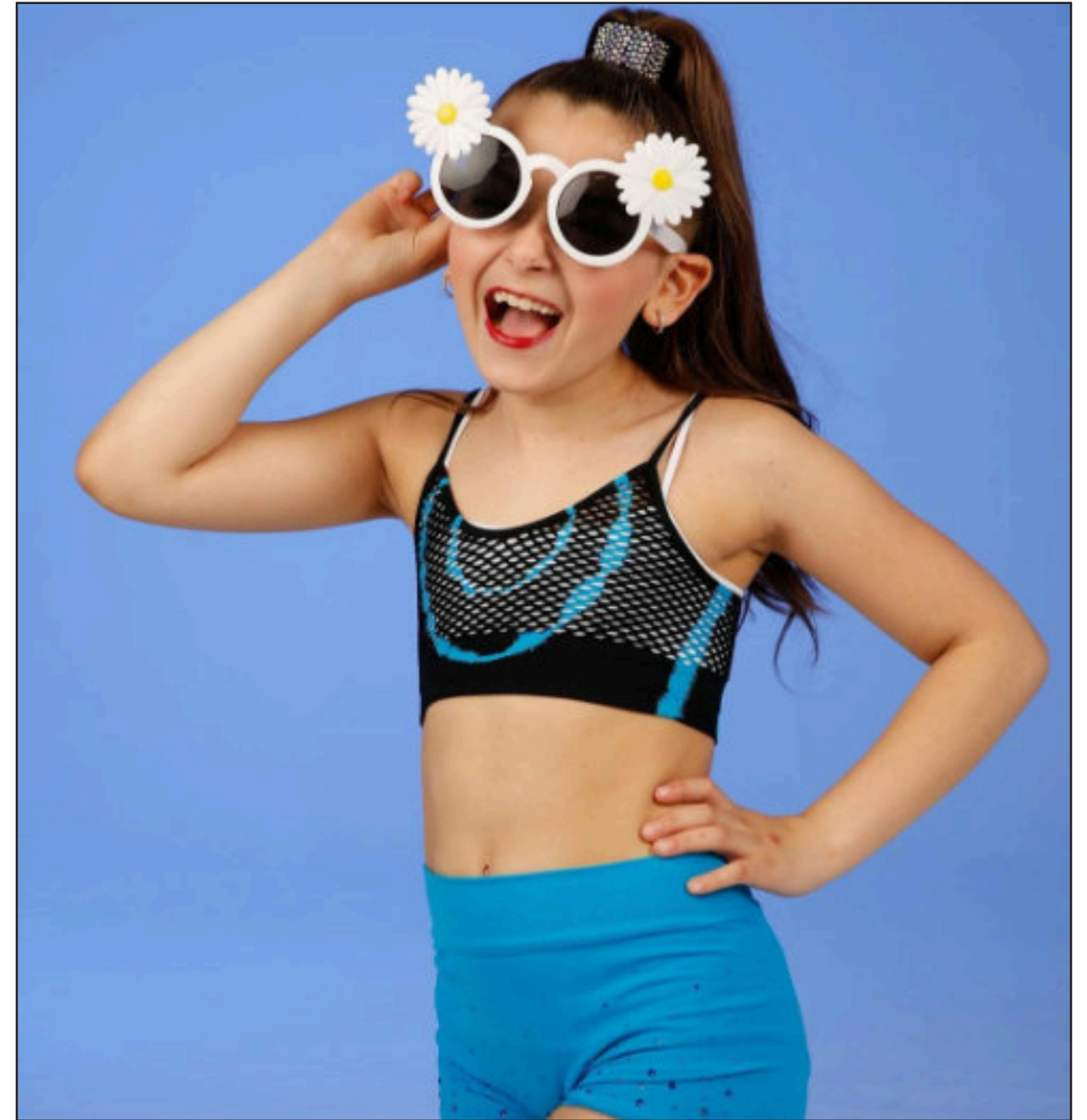


Kennedy Bowen

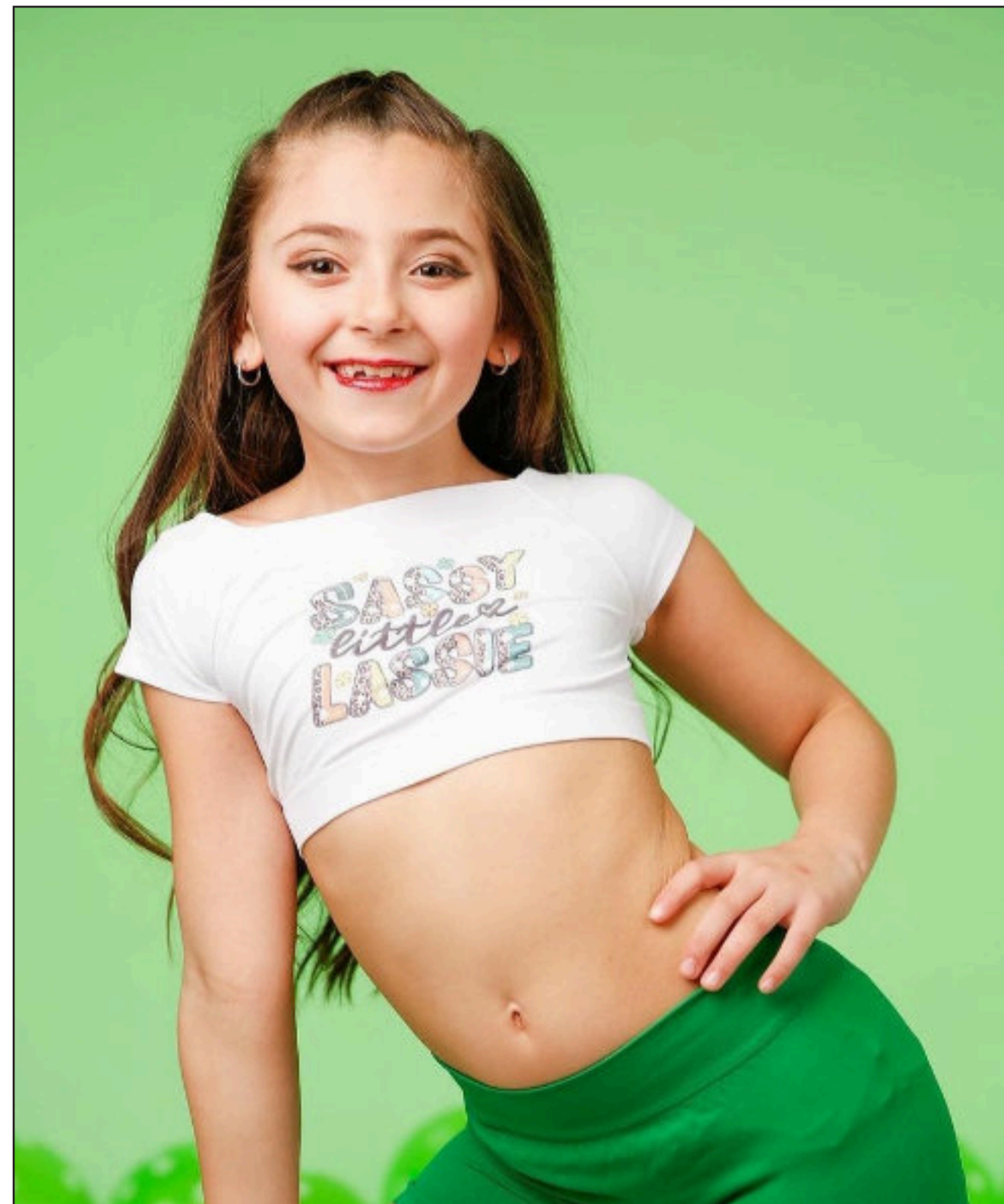

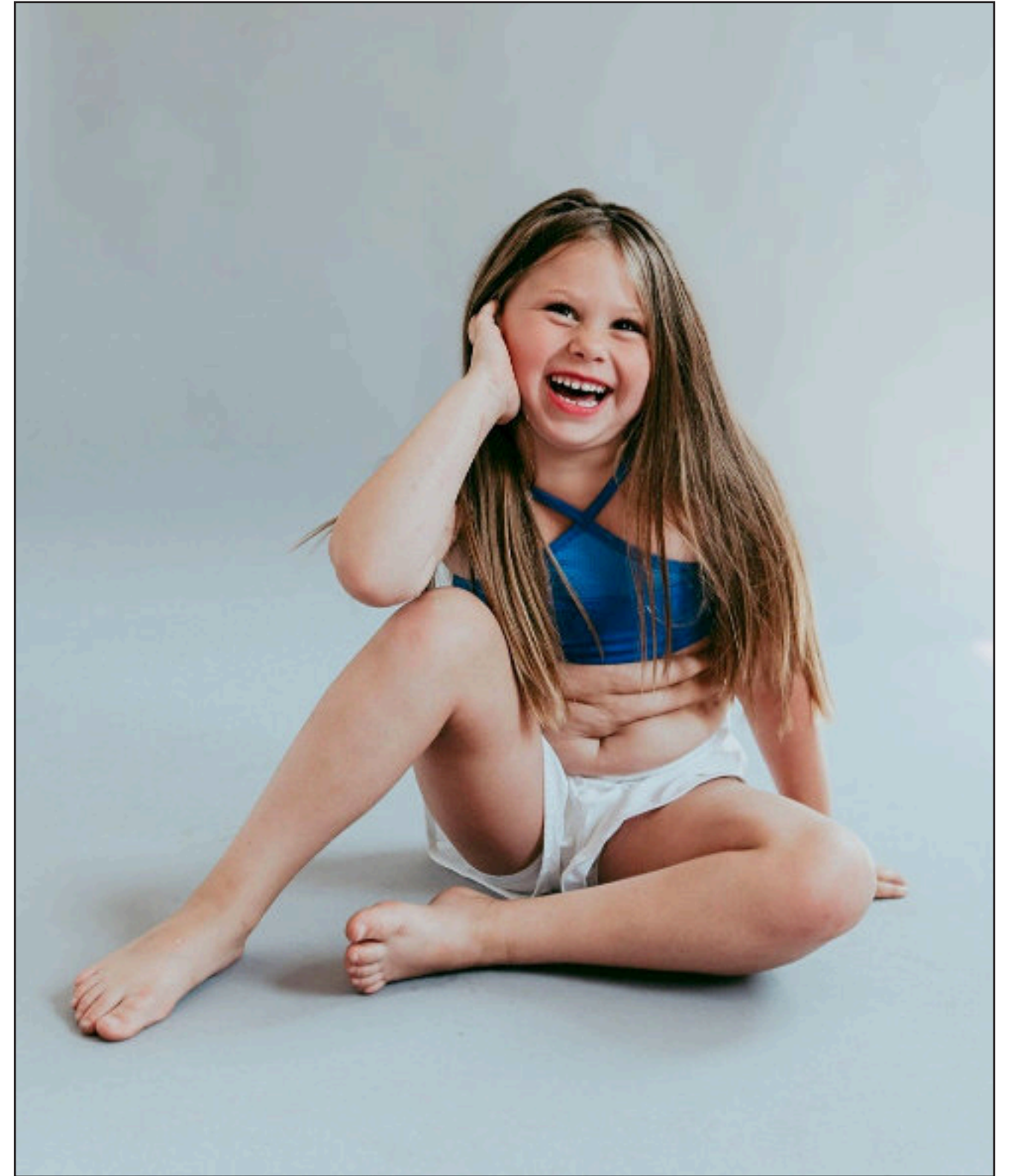


Madison Hope Eaton

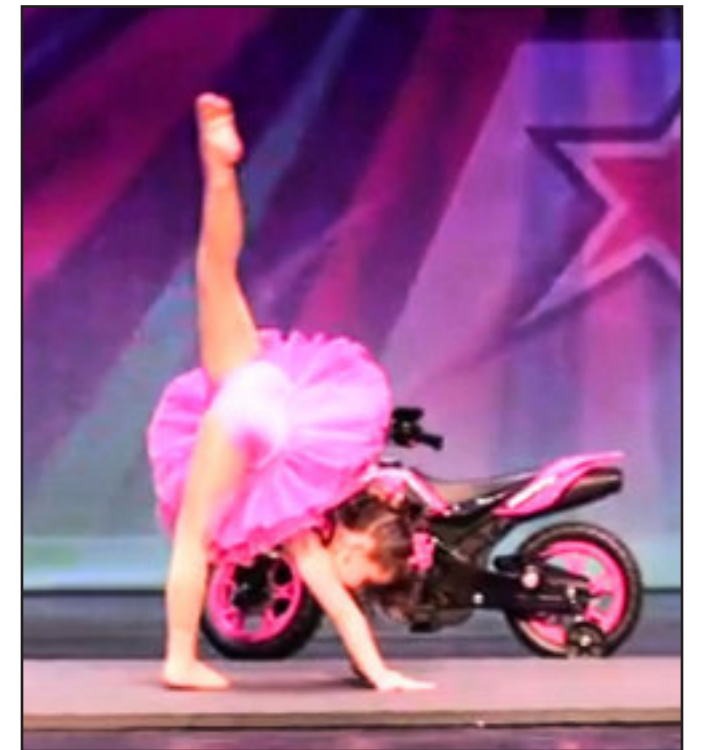
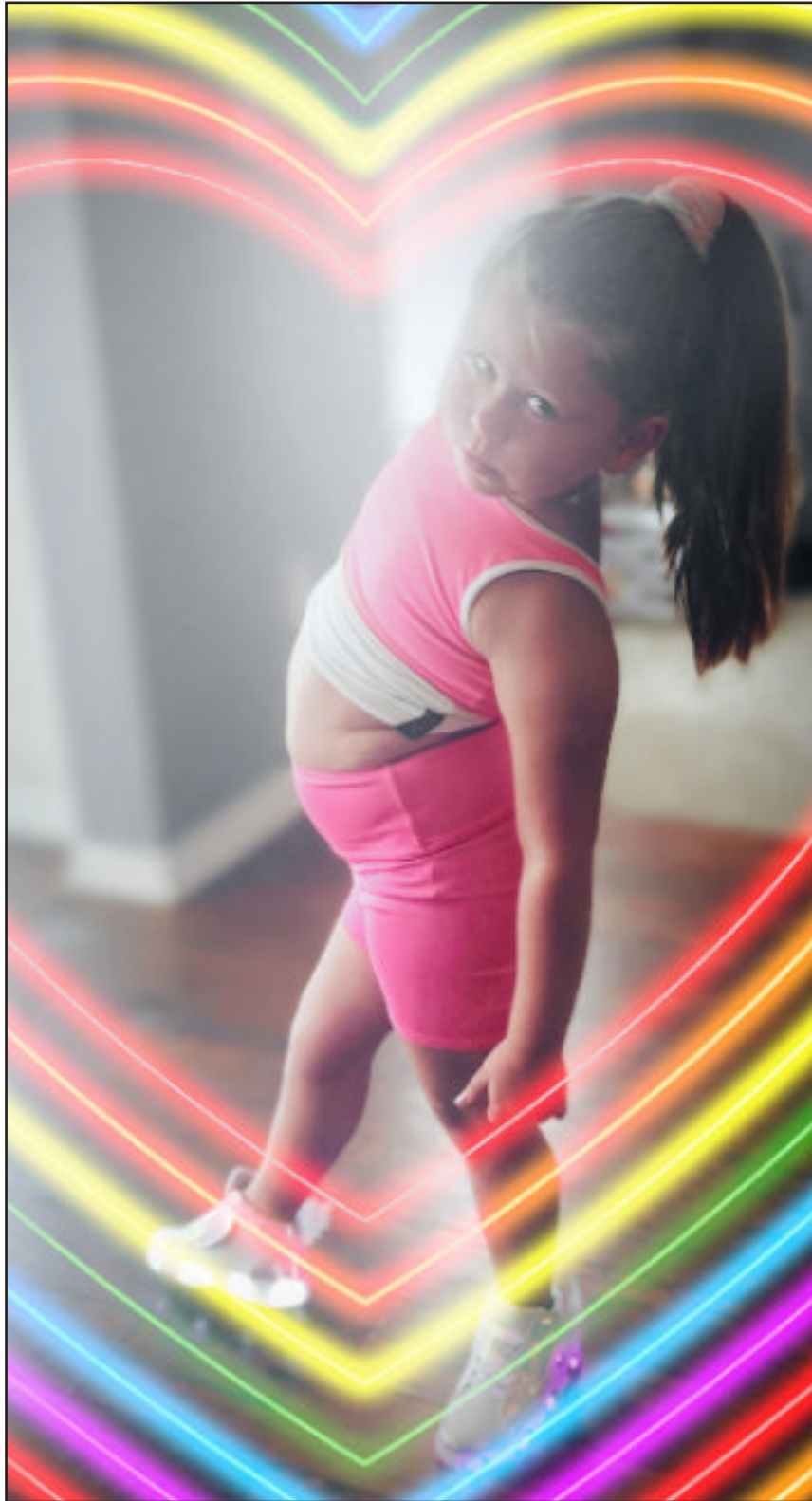
Eager to expand her skills and connect with fellow dancers, Maddie is looking forward to attending two dance conventions in the fall, WILD and DECA.
