Hailey Rafferty

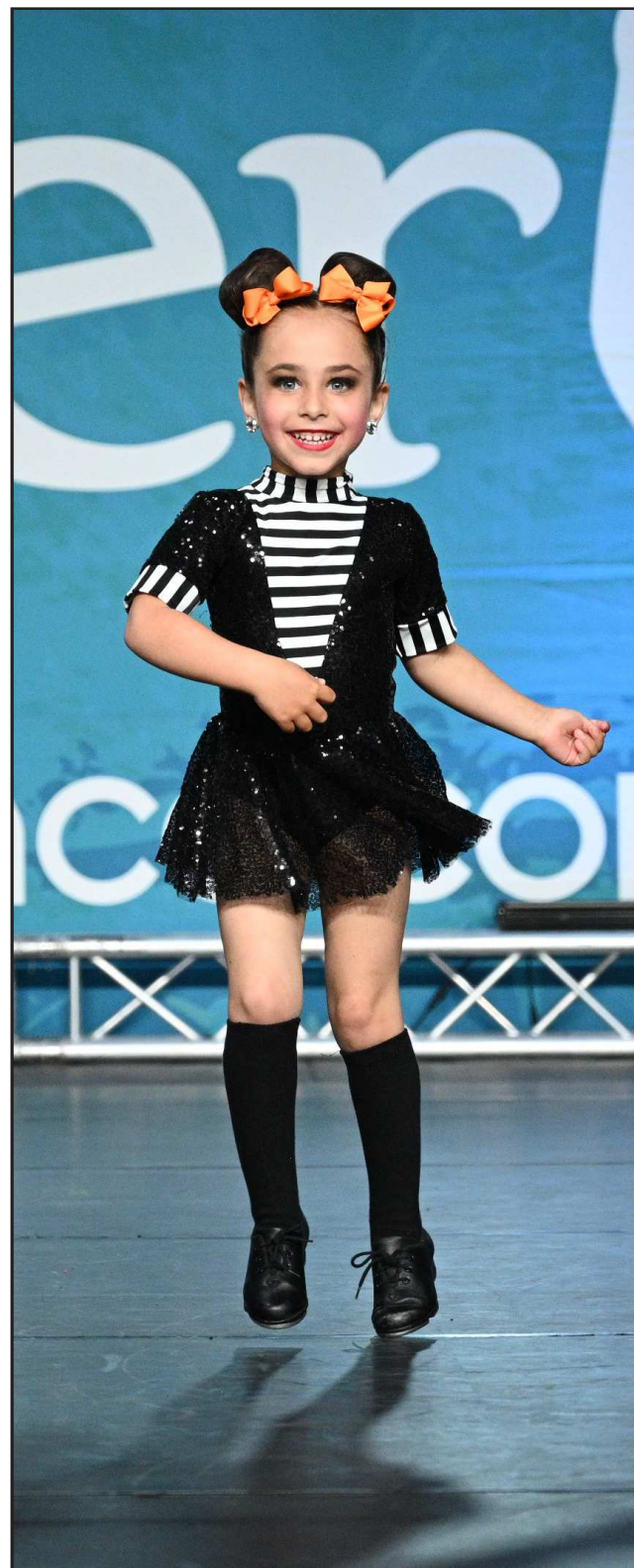

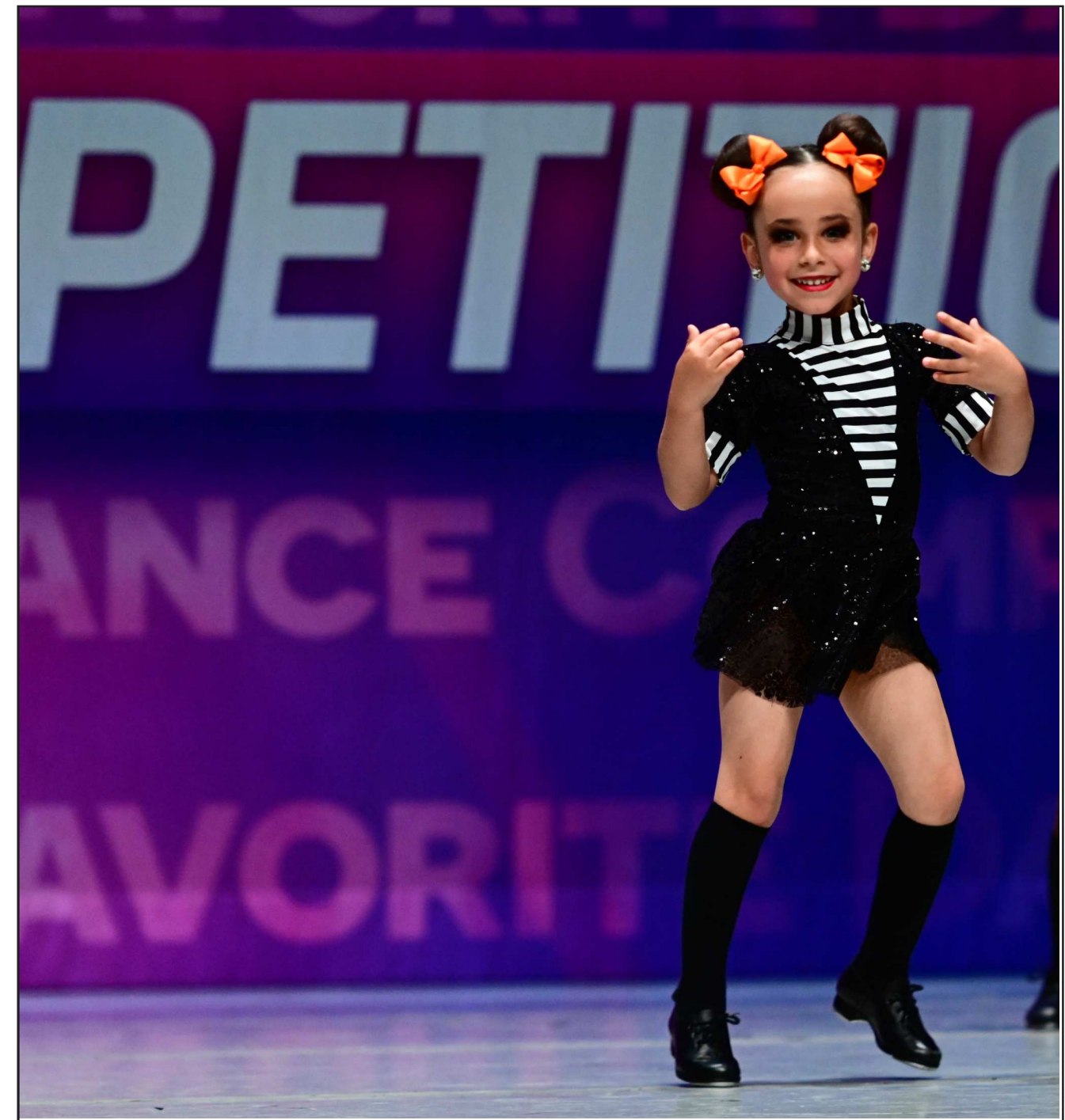

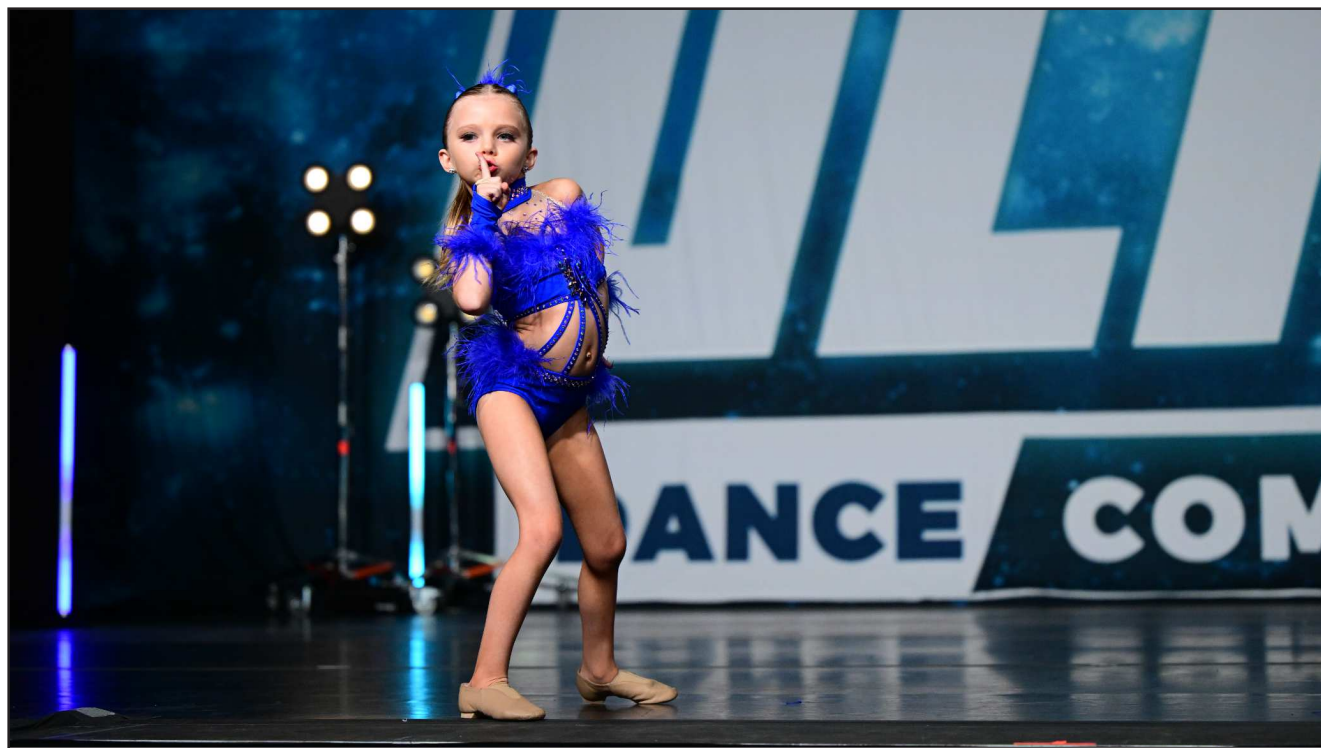
When I grow up, I want to be a dancer and veterinarian. This year I want to continue learning and improving my technique. I can't wait to see what this season brings!
