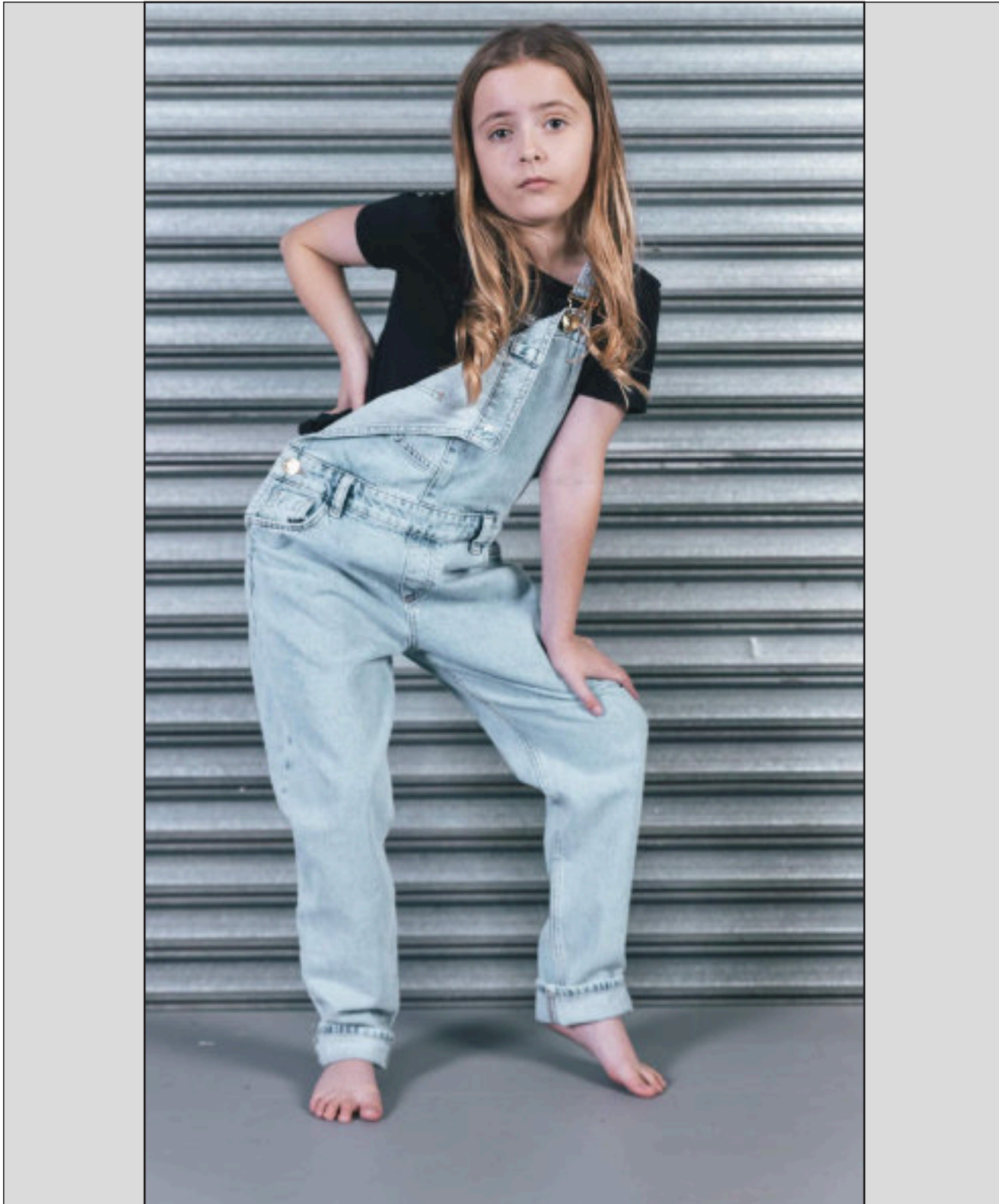

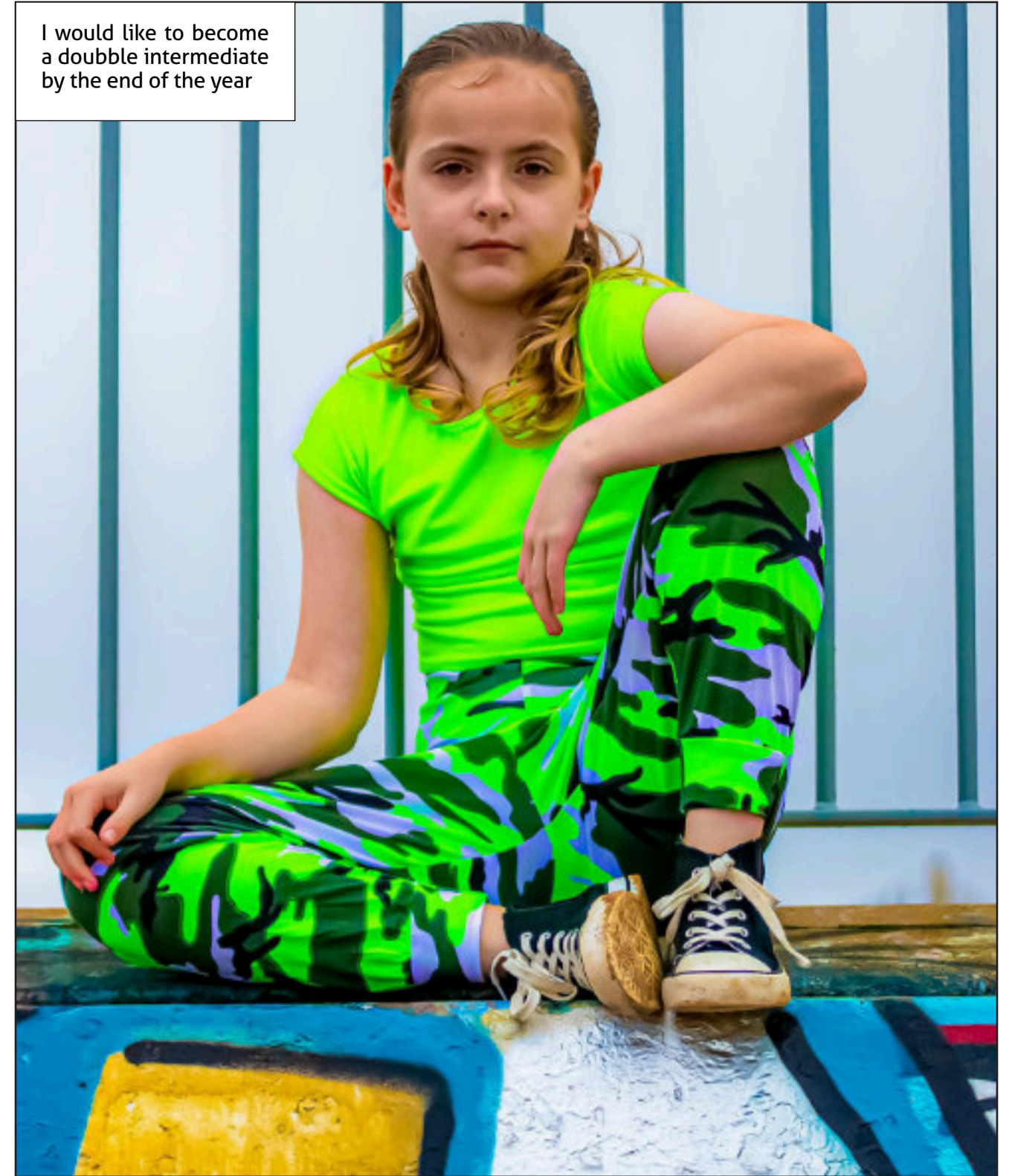

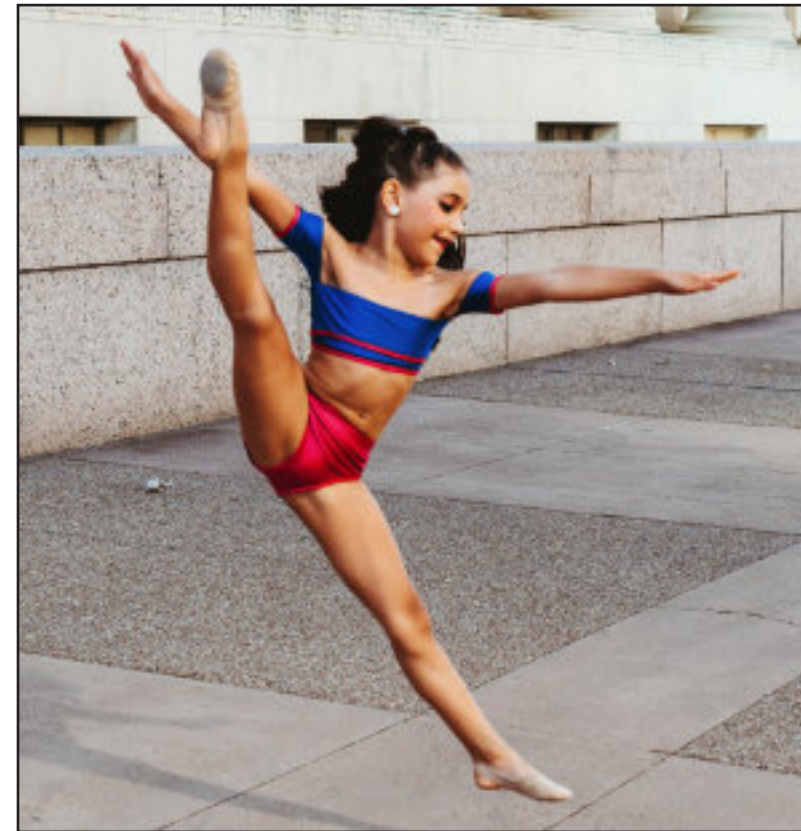

# Autumn Grace

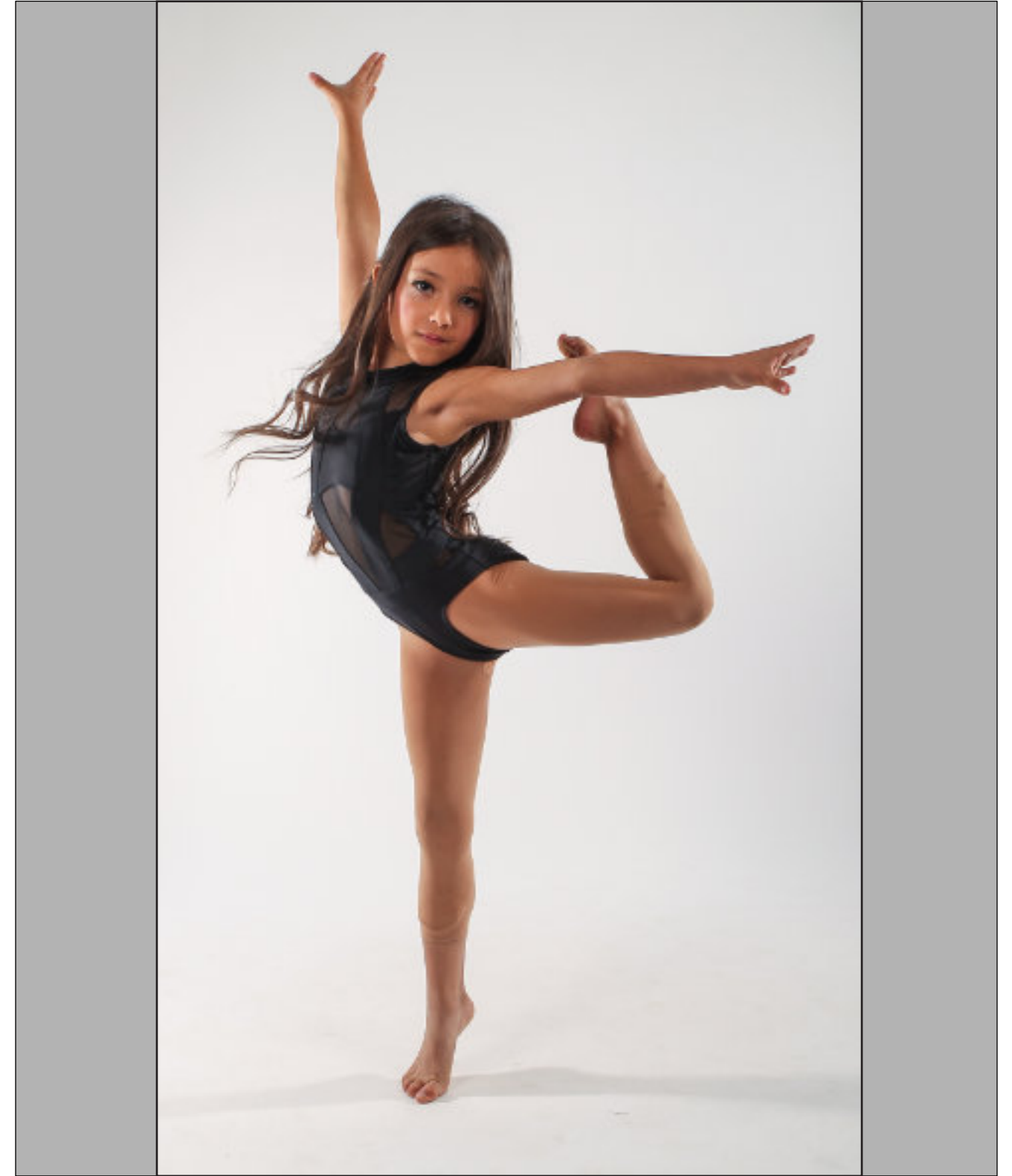

I think it's amazing how two tiny feet can tell such an amazing story! I hope everyone dances, because the time is now!





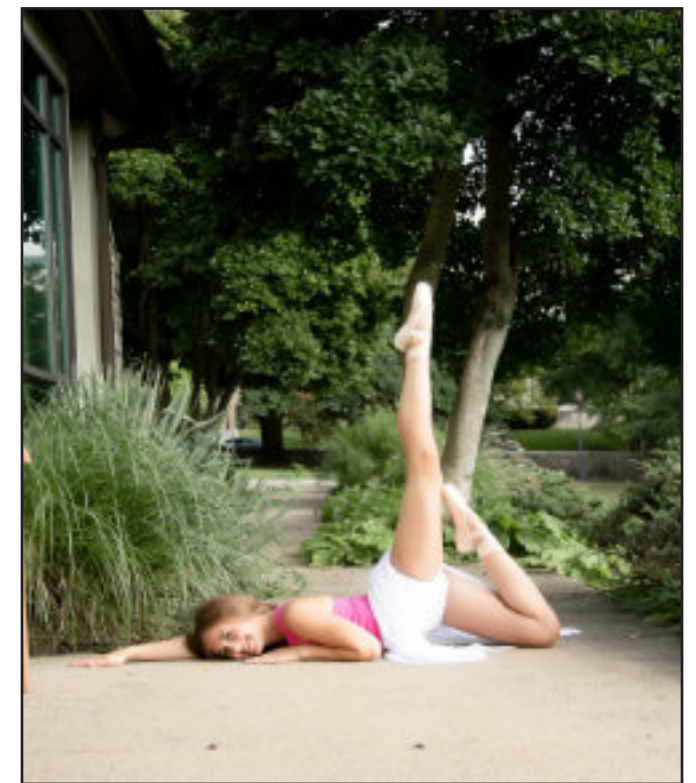
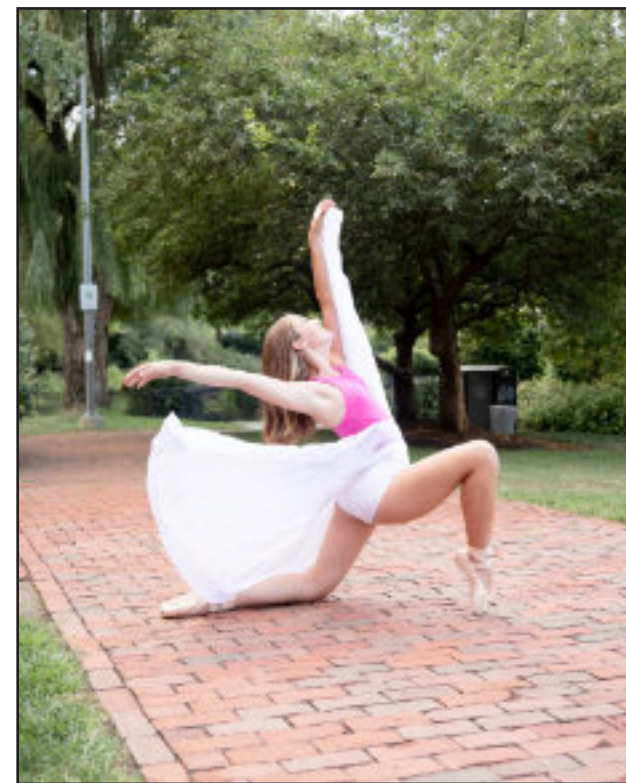
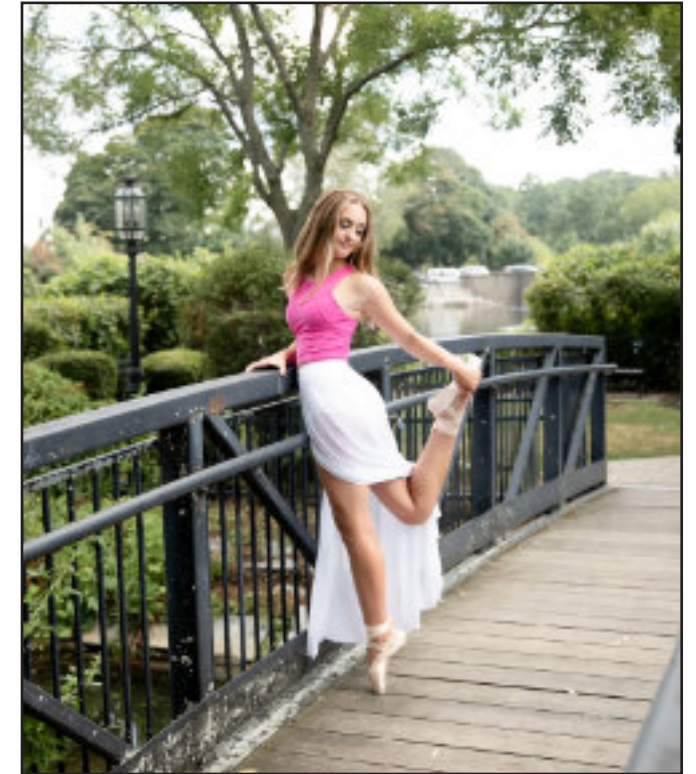
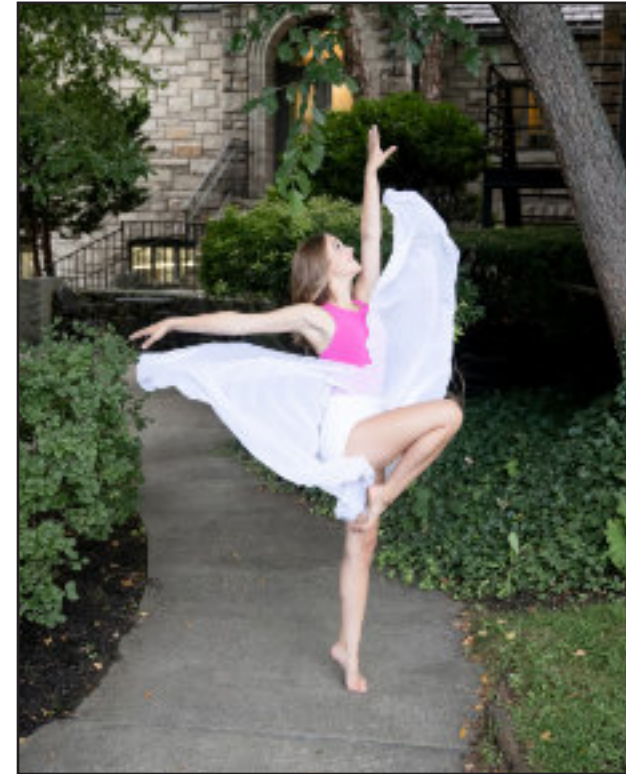


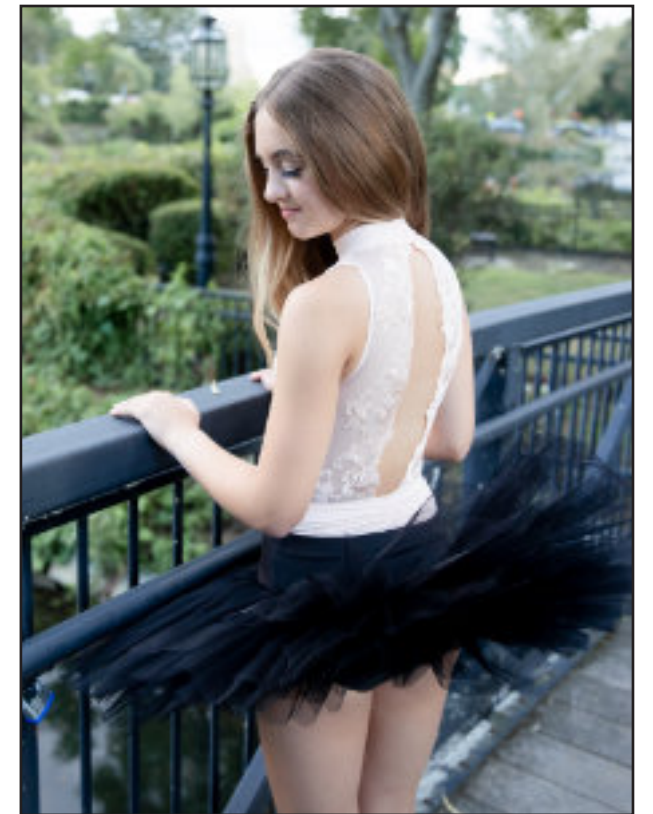
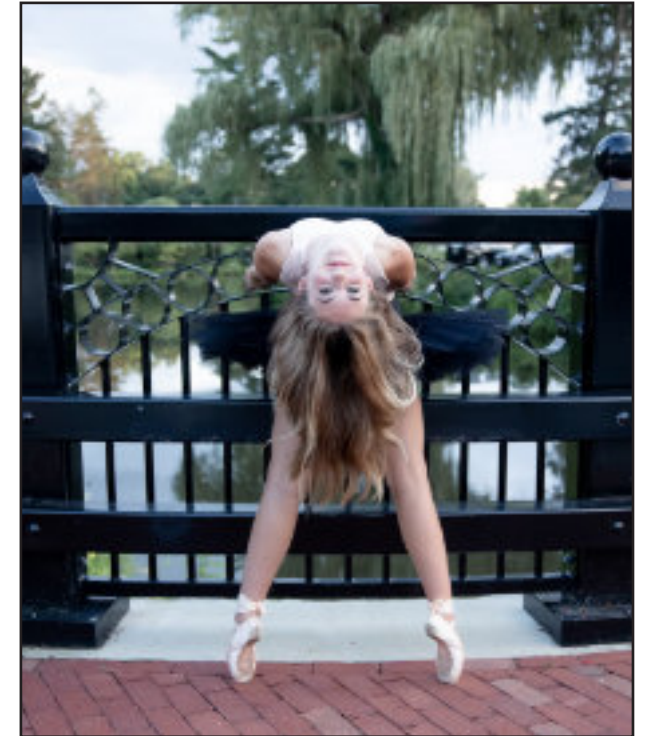
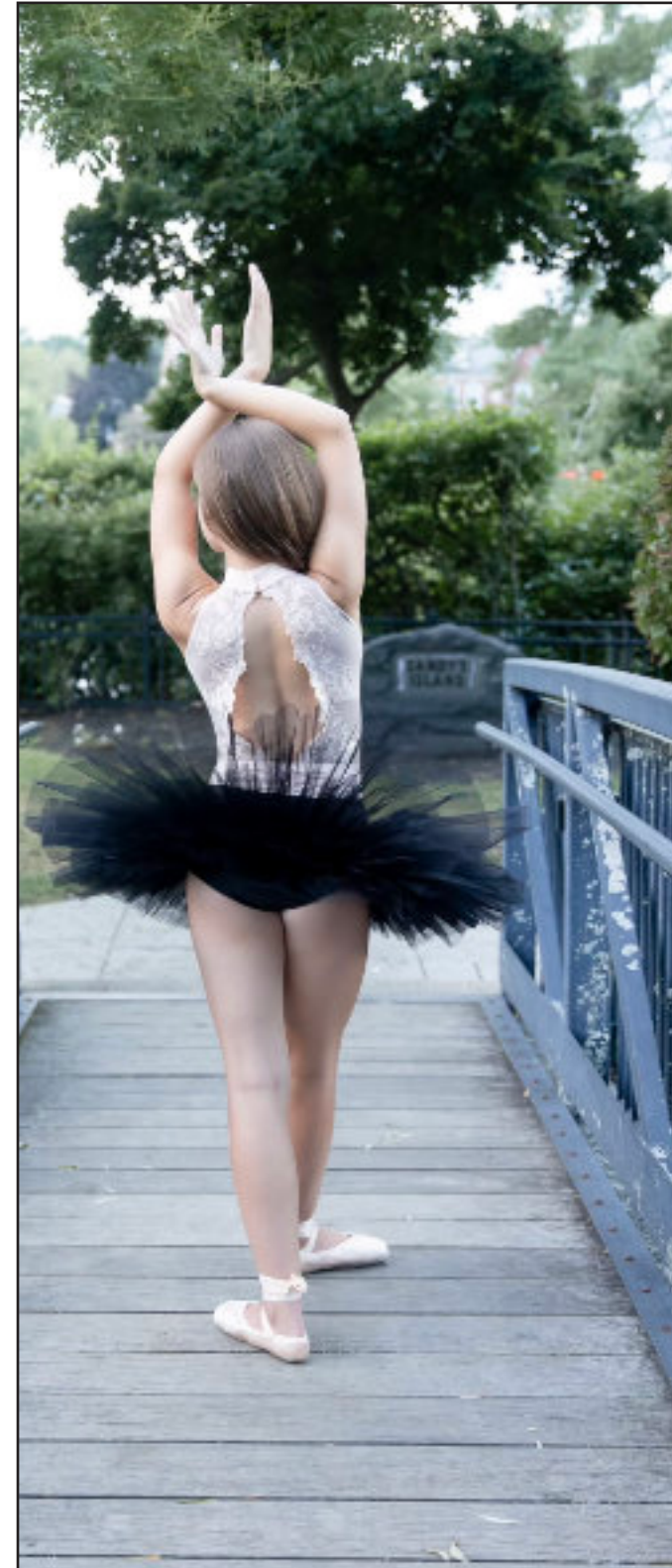

# Emmalyn Kielb

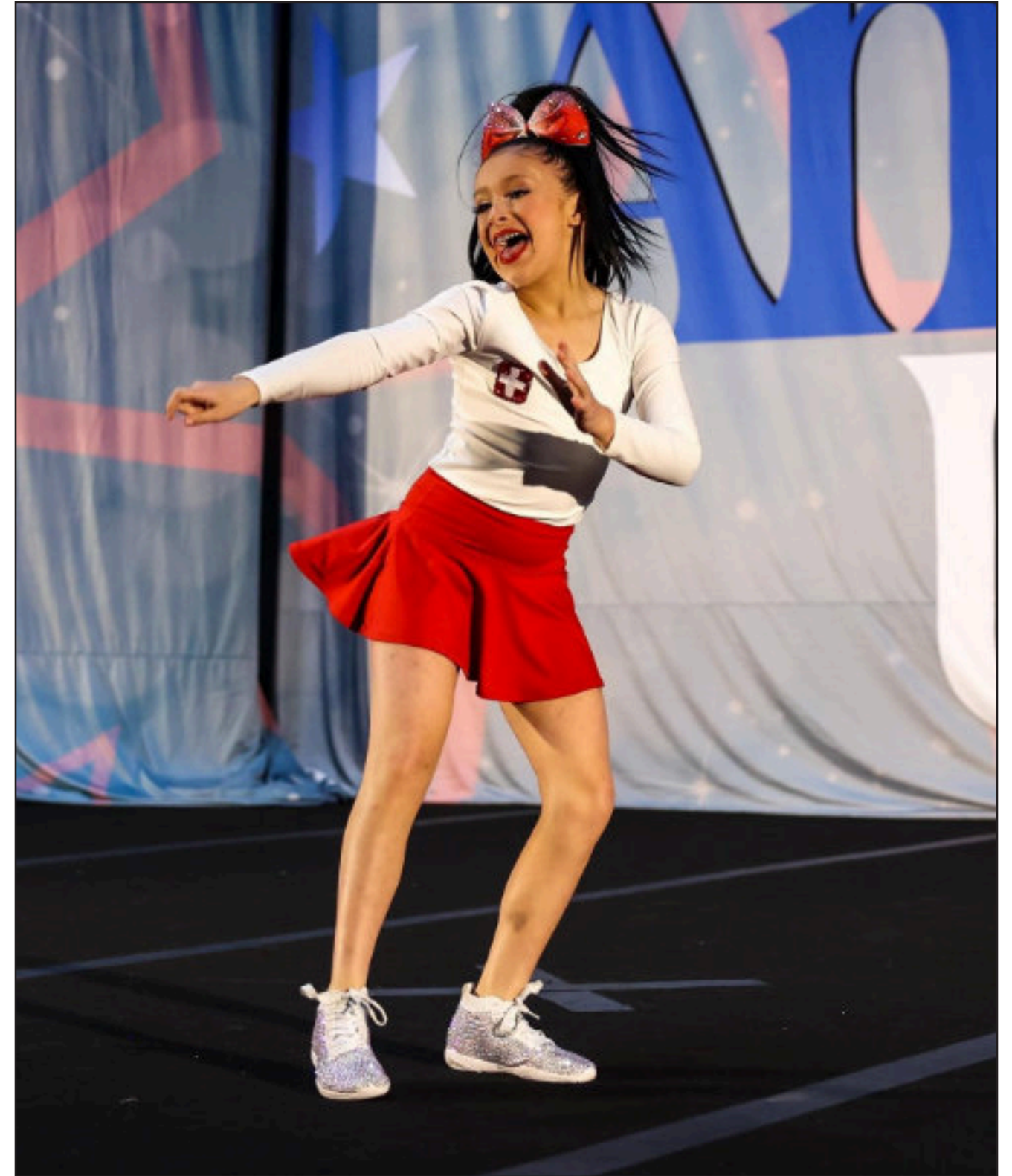
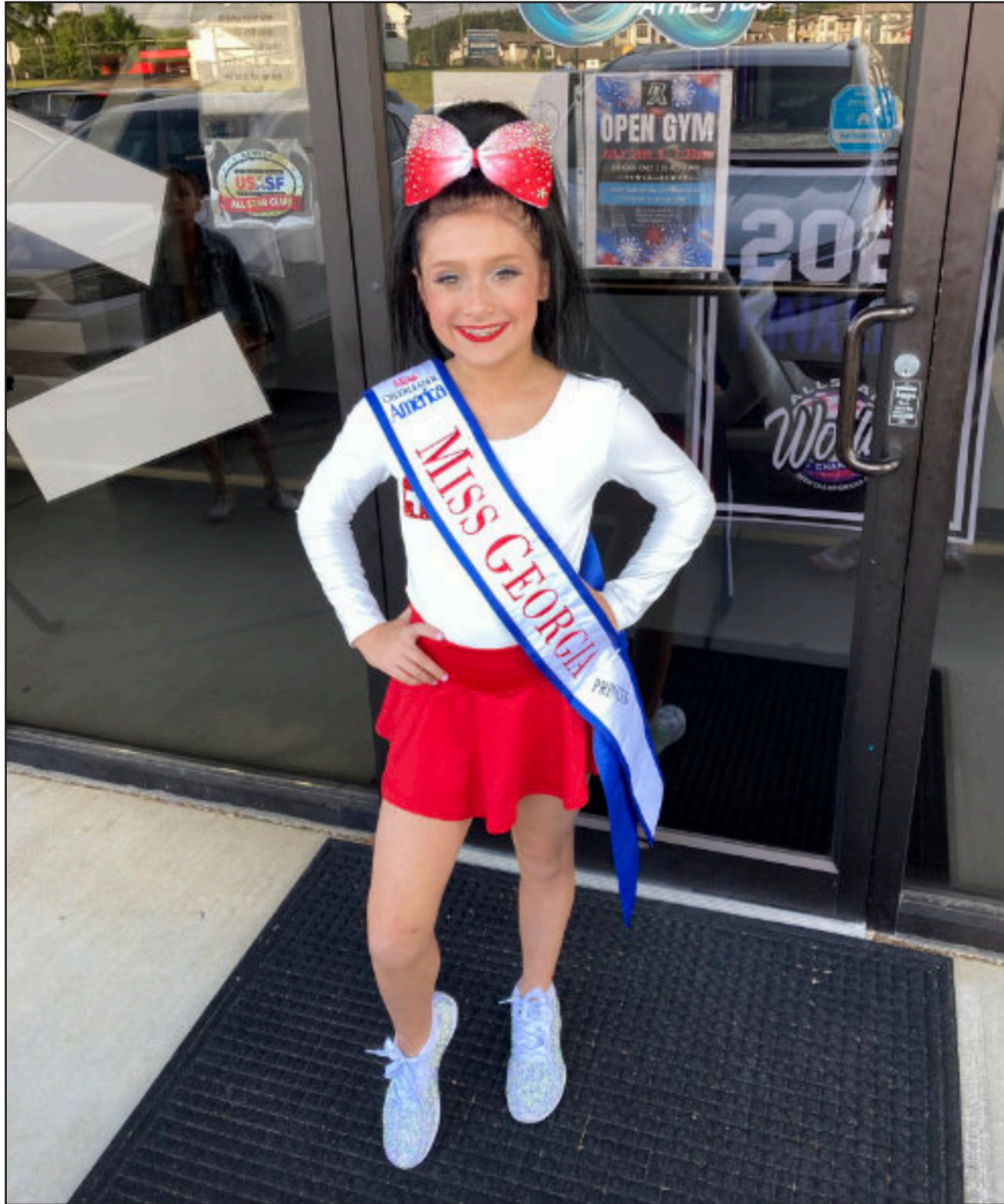

# Olivia Cumming

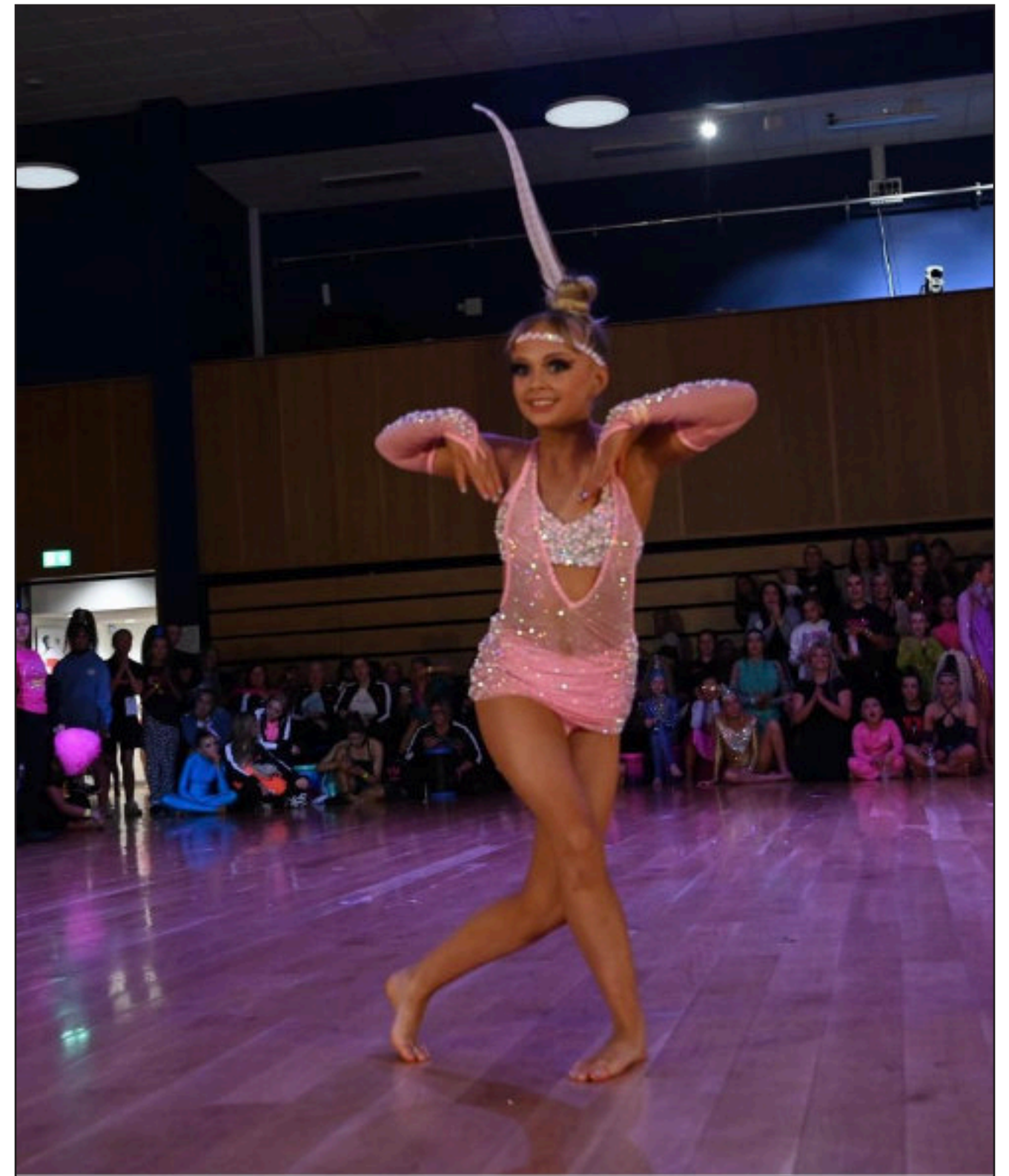

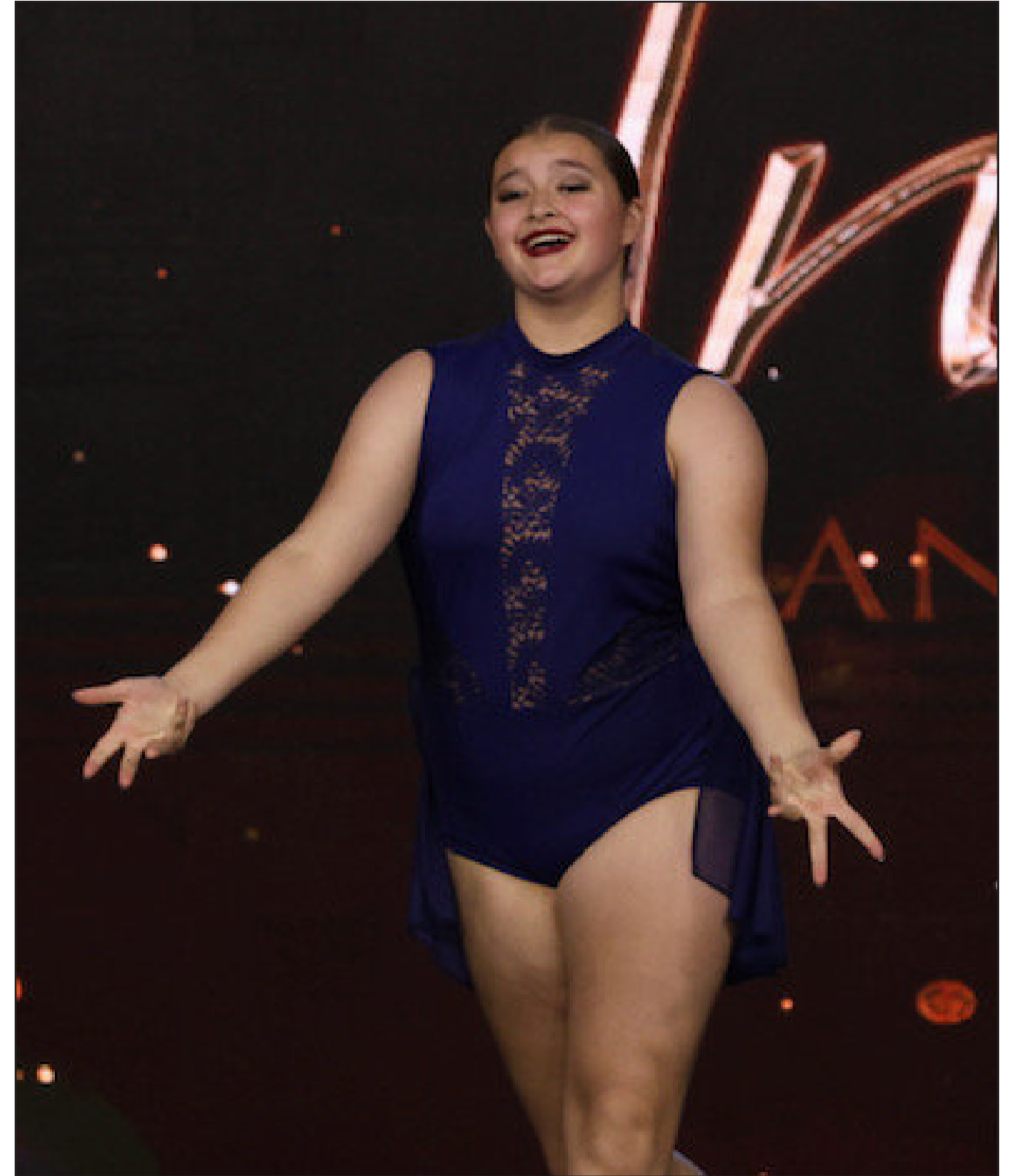
# Tanys Syrjanen

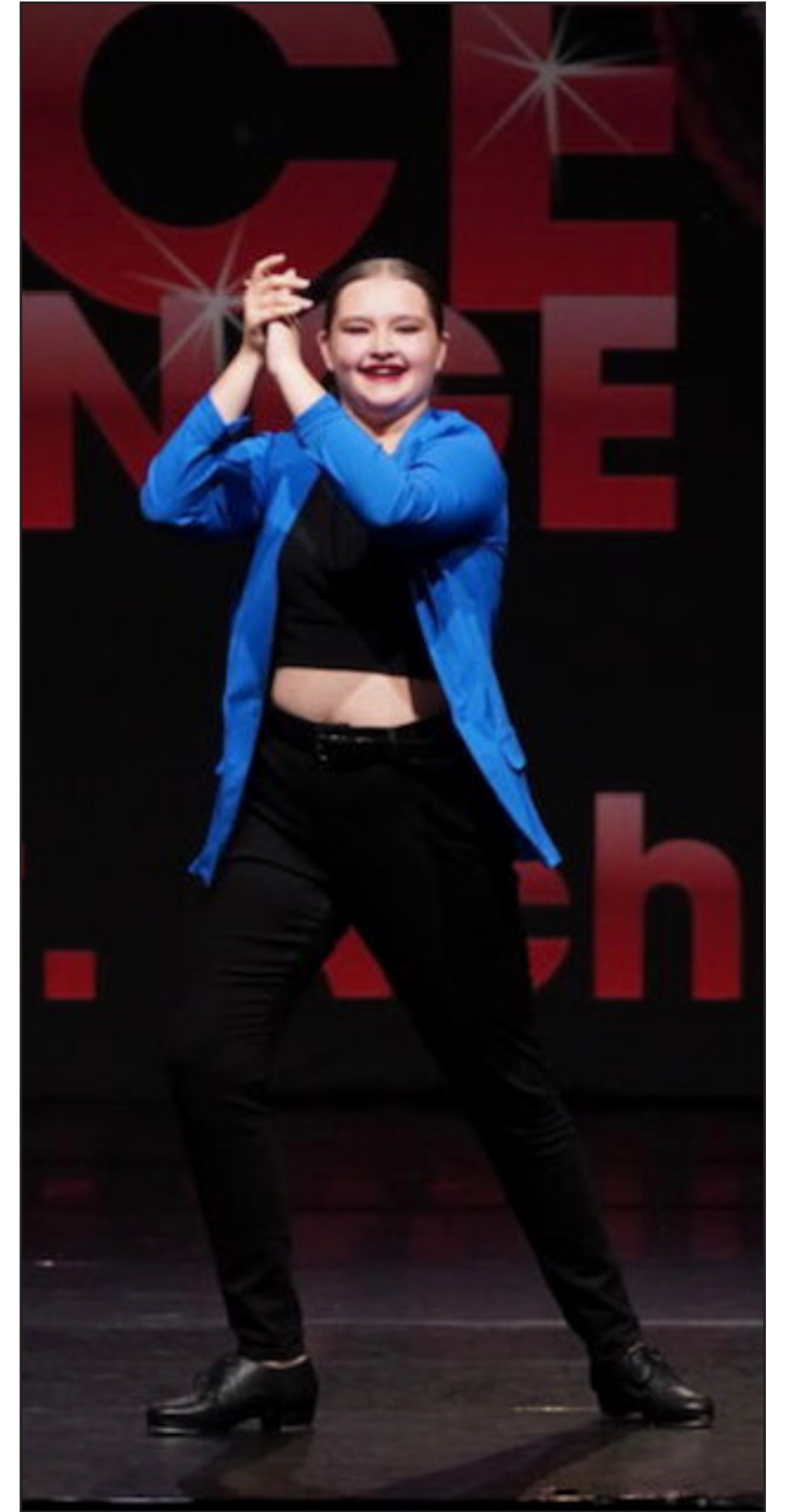
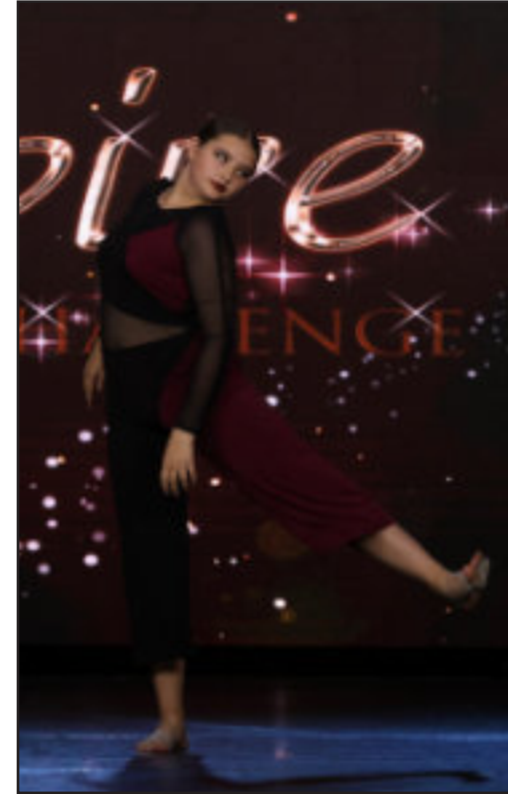
