





working extra hard this year and would love to



This year marked my last year as a competitive dancer and, as a graduating student I had big goals for my last season of dance. Beyond the obvious of taking it all in and working smart, I wanted to win 2 National Titles, one in Canada and one in the USA.

The travel plans alone were a logistical nightmare, as the competition dates were overlapping. My studio highly encouraged me to do both. It took a lot of planning for this to be successful, not to mention the hours it took to pack.

Keep in mind I was not going to be returning home for two weeks. I had to pack 18 costumes, hairpieces. accessories, and multiple Gala dresses.

Focused and determined to attain my goals, I can proudly say with the support of my incredible family, I did it!

I was crowned America's Senior Female Dancer of the Year at the American Dance (ADA) National Awards Championships, and then Miss View Dance, Senior Title Winner at The View Dance Challenge **National** Championships.

We drove overnight from Providence, Rhode Island, (almost forgetting

passports in the hotel room safe), but made it safely to Deerhurst Resort in Canada. without a minute to spare. I jumped out of my family vehicle when we arrived, and was immediately taken into my first judged title class. The rest of the week was jam packed with early mornings and late nights, with no time to


Looking back, it was pretty crazy, adventurous, and stressful, but it was definitely all worth it.
