


choreographers. I can't wait to continue my iournev!!







Cadence Oldham










Daniella Lampen




being an ambassador for Dance Advisor Photography. One challenge that I have had to face is not exactly having proper training. My city is very small and resources are very limited, however I have pushed through.

Hi! My name is Laura Brunelle. I am an upcoming artist based in Toronto, Ontario, Canada aspiring to make it in the industry. I started dancing in my hometown at the age of 3, however, growing up in a small town meant I had limited training and opportunities. This did not stop me from working hard to achieve my dreams. While I was taught the vital fundamentals of dance in my hometown, I trained independently to realize my personal goals. Furthermore, I had the privilege of growing up with a talented older sister whom I have always looked up to. With the same goals, she had been my greatest inspiration, paving the way for me to become the artist I am today.

I started competitive dance at the age of 8, and my love for performance grew strong. All my training paid off through my successes at several competitions across North America, where I earned recognition from top industry performers. My passion for dance grew with me through the years, and from that point on, I knew I wanted to be a professional dancer.

In 2020, like every other, the dance community was hit by the global pandemic. Performances and competitions were canceled, my dance classes and schooling became strictly virtual and worst of all, I was confined to my thoughts and social media. Quarantine called for a new era of trending diets and workout plans, which is dangerous for young, impressionable dancers growing up in an industry that has a history of strict body ideals and aesthetics. Unfortunately, being a 14-year-old impressionable young girl with only social media as a connection to the outside world, I fell victim to these harmful trends... and my training came altogether to a screeching halt.

In April of 2021, I was suddenly admitted to the Eating Disorder Program at Soldiers' Memorial Hospital in Orillia, ON where I was diagnosed with anorexia nervosa. After over a year of denial and damaging my body for the euphoric feeling of control and pressure to change the way I look, reality hit and I was given a week to live before my heart would ultimately fail me.

Though it was hard to escape the mental prison that is an eating disorder, I knew I had to recover, not only for my life but for the dreams of a younger Laura. It was in those 4 walls of my





hospital room where I had the epiphany that while I found comfort in the "control" my eating disorder gave me, it was actually taking control of me. As a dancer, having control over your own body is essential for your craft, but as you lose yourself to an illness such as an eating disorder, there is no way to authentically pursue your art. It not only took away my ability to dance, but my ability to walk. This was heartbreaking to someone who had once dedicated her entire life to the art of dance. When my only means of transportation was a wheelchair as I was too weak, I knew I had to change.

Therefore, with the immense help and support from my eating disorder team, family, and

friends, I was able to slowly take back my life, and, while it was initially advised against, I took back dance as well.

Today, after a long road to recovery, I beat the odds and am now the strongest dancer I have ever been. I pursued my training in Orillia at Titanium Arts Lab which offered me a new, positive start. This is where I found new supportive friends, and supportive teachers, made new connections, and flourished as an artist. Today, I am slowly breaking out into the industry having mentorship from Isenberg Entertainment, appearing in the opening show cast of the Universal Women's Network's 2024 Women of Inspiration Awards as well as the
