



I believe it's my destiny to be a champion world boxer along with many other talents. I would love to be an actor in big movies or shows, I aspire to model for a huge company one day as well. I believe these goals and dreams are at the tips of my fingers as long as I don't quit. I have already started my journey by getting on the cover of my hometown's magazine back in 2022. It is also my goal to get on this magazine cover (GLITZ) and the others (ATHLETES) as well as (MARTIAL SPORTS). But getting into my life story... I have achieved and overcame many insane obstacles. I'll start off strong and tell you about the one I'm most known for. My open heart surgery that I had back in 2022. Now you might think open heart surgery is a big but deal also somewhat common,




but the thing is.. my story is not about the surgery itself. My story sparked from the events prior to surgery and how I came back afterwards. Growing up, I could not keep up with my friends in sports. I would get very light headed and out of breathe very fast due to my

heart. I was too young to realize half of it was a mental battle. A couple months prior to my surgery that I didn't even know I needed, I did a challenge that was deemed impossible, but that was until I attempted it. I created this physical tribute challenge in honor of all the






ones that passed away in the 9/11 tragedy. I went to my local highschool track and I gave myself 12 hours to complete it. The challenge consisted of 911 push-ups, rope, 911 body squats, 911 jumping jacks, 119 burpees, 119 box jumps, 119 leg lunges, climbed 119 flights of bleachers, and I ran 119 laps around the track which equals 29.75 miles! I went without stopping and it took me from 3:00pm-3:22am. 12 hours and 22 minutes. My body was destroyed for weeks, but the impact I had on everyone will never be forgotten. This wasn't about me, it was to show everyone no matter how you were born and what hurdles you face in life... Anything is possible. A month later I decided to run 100 miles in 24 hours for Breast Cancer. I raised over \$1,000 for a charity in the midst of running. I ran 33 miles without stopping and I pulled every muscle and I had to go home. A few days later I came back and got up to mile 75. I failed but had pushed past my limit. I got news I needed surgery that December and I got it done in February. For weeks it was hard to get out of bed, but everyday I pushed harder and harder and next thing you know I'm back in the gym going hard. That October I got in the boxing ring and fought again and went the distance but unfortunately I did lose. This is just the beginning of my story with no end. 

















My name is Izzy Pereira and I'm a professional dancer in New York City. Growing up in Toronto Canada, I always dreamed of making it to the big apple one day and now my dreams have become my reality.

Growing up I trained at a competitive dance studio in Vaughan, Ontario. The studio I attended was extremely high caliber, we trained for over 20 hours a week every week in multiple genres of dance including ballet, jazz, tap, hip hop, acrobatics, musical theatre and contemporary . I also attended a specialized arts program in elementary and high school. All these fostered my training and artistic abilities from a young age. I was exposed to many different learning and performance opportunities that continued to hone my talent. My most notable achievements from this time of my life include; winning The One Dance Championships as a soloist in 2020, Senior Solo champion at Terpsichore National Dance Celebrations Dance Competition, winning Studio of the Year with my Performing Dance Arts team at The Dance Awards International Dance Competition, placing top 20 at The Dance Awards best dancer competition, placing 7th overall soloist at The Dance Awards, 2nd overall solo at Nuvo Dance Competition, and many more scholarship and overall wins throughout the years. I was also selected as the Face of Fever for Fever Dance Championships in 2019, where I represented the competition in their promotional materials for their national and regional competitions for the following couple seasons.

As my time in high school was coming to a close, I auditioned for four highly competitive college dance programs in the U.S.A and was accepted into each one, including my dream school Pace University. In May of 2024, I graduated Summa Cum Laude from Pace University with a BFA in commercial dance. During my time at Pace, I was given incredible opportunities to work with industry professionals for live performance shows, videos and more and I spent my days dancing alongside some of the most talented dancers in the country. I was made Dance Captain to 4 different works by 4 different choreographers during this time. I had the opportunity to work with Emmy award winning Tyce Diorio

on my senior solo piece, lived in LA and learned about on-camera work, presented my own choreographic work industry professionals and so much more. While attending school I still continued to work and perform. I was a lead dancer in the full-length contemporary production Whole New World at Winchester Street Theatre in Toronto and was a part of Andy Blankenbuler's skeleton crew for Nine on Broadway, I also performed at Fever After Dark in Toronto, and multiple other choreographic events in NYC.

Since graduating, I have already achieved some great career goals of mine. I was recently the rehearsal director and assistant to the choreographer for dance pop artist's Blakes's Tash European tour. It has always been my biggest aspiration to work with pop artists so achieving this milestone at this age was such a big win and I am so grateful for it. I have been in a national commercial Snapchat, danced in a short film with




NYC's Wolf and Swan Company, and was a part of the Broadway Votes PSA directed by Kenny Ortega. I danced in the music video 'SHE' by Canadian music artist Sayana and was a summer intern for Blake McGrath's mentorship program where I assisted many world renowned choreographers/teachers. I was selected as a young emerging choreographer in 2024 and had my work presented at the Young prestigious Choreographer's Festival NYC. I also danced in other works at same event, two consecutive years in a row. I joined the faculty at Downtown Dance Factory, one of the best studios in NYC located in Tribeca. Additionally, I am on faculty at Terpsichore Dance Celebration, an all canadian competition dance convention. Other performances I have had the honor of being selected to dance in include Choreographer's Carnival LA/ NYC, Sybarite, NYCDA'S Destiny Rising, and Solar Fusion showcase.


