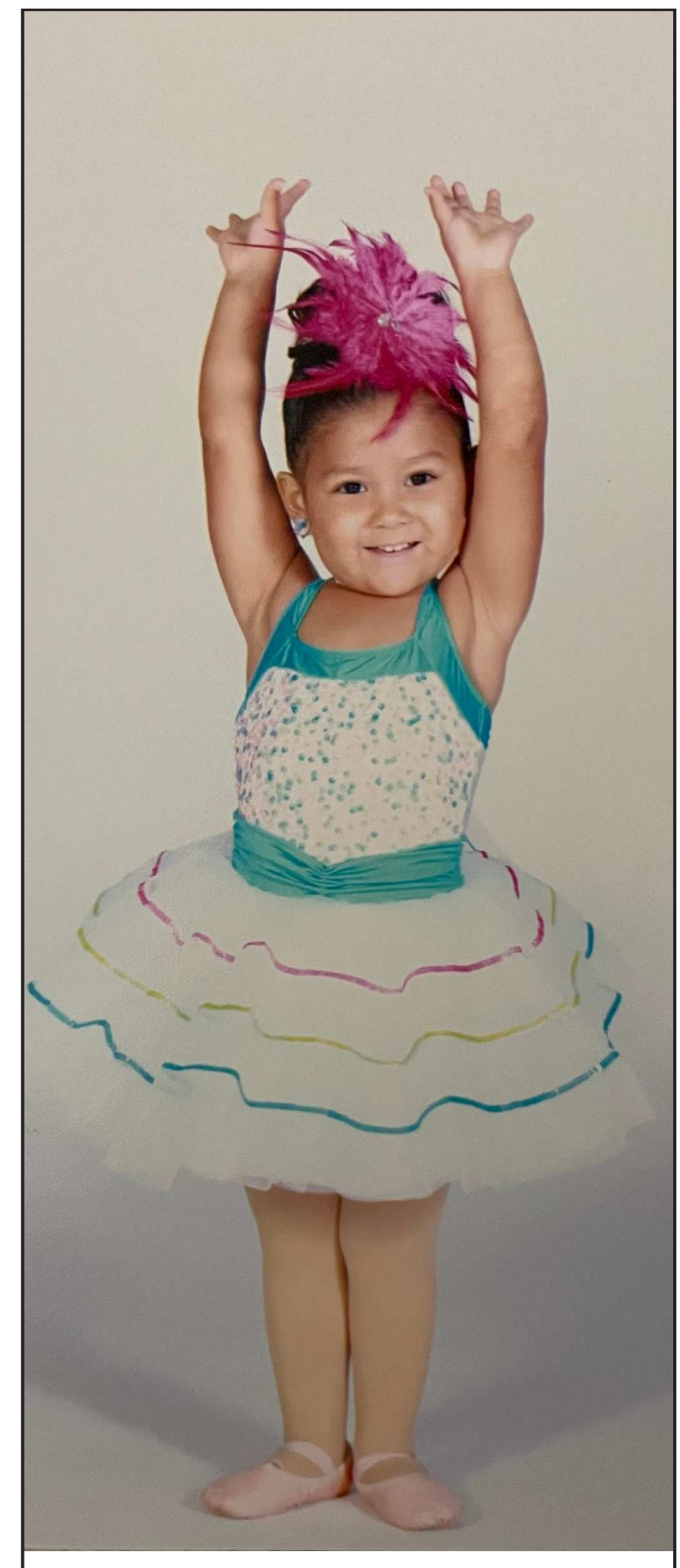
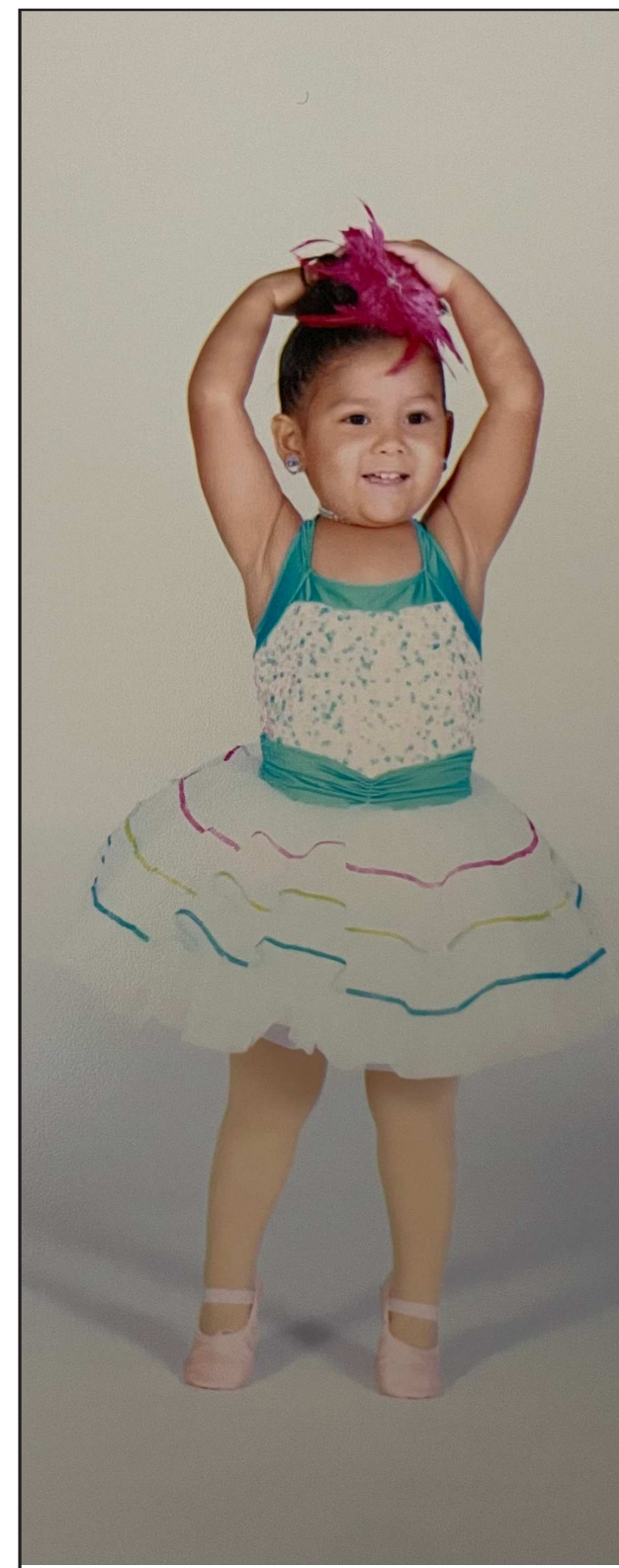
I have found great confidence! I am learning that hard work and dedication will continue to get me far in this journey! I look forward to growing and seeing what opportunities come my way.

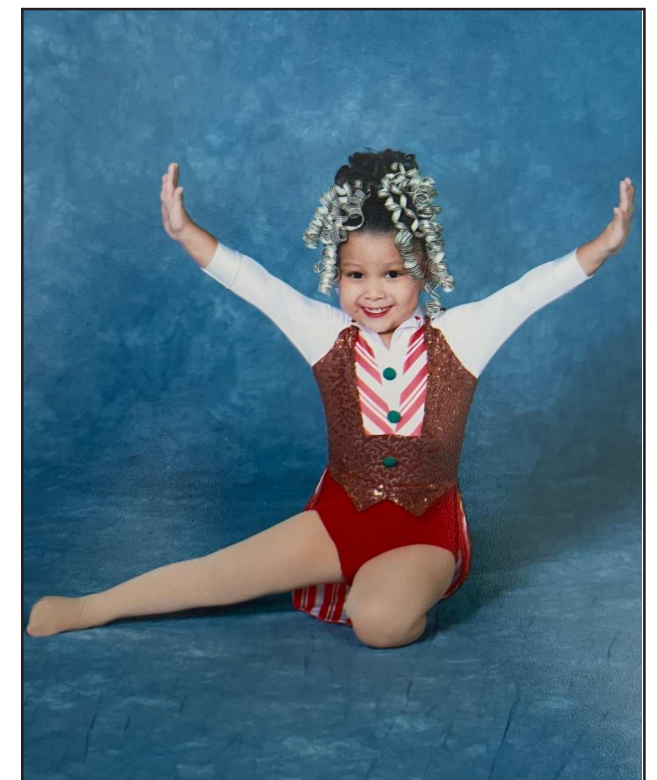

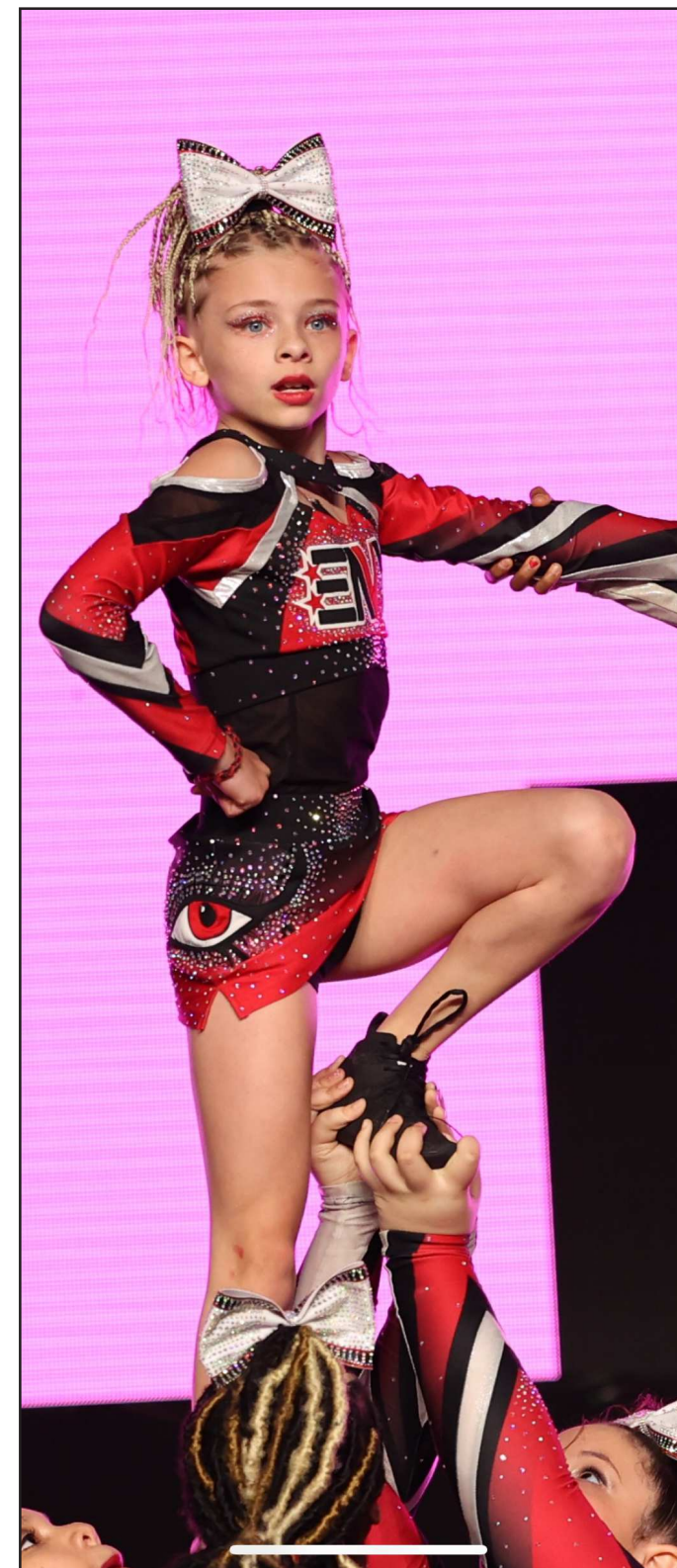

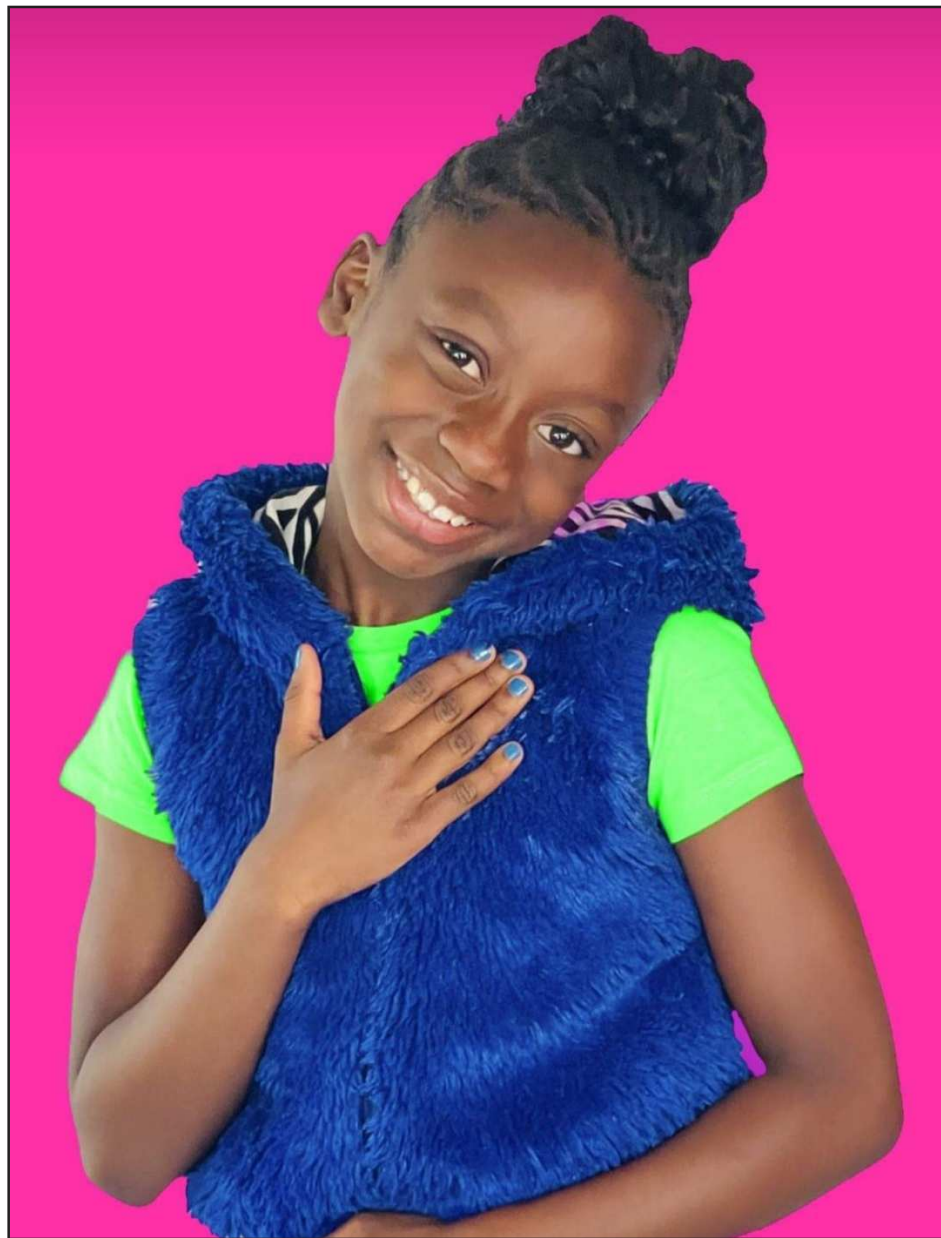

Brook Skyliie

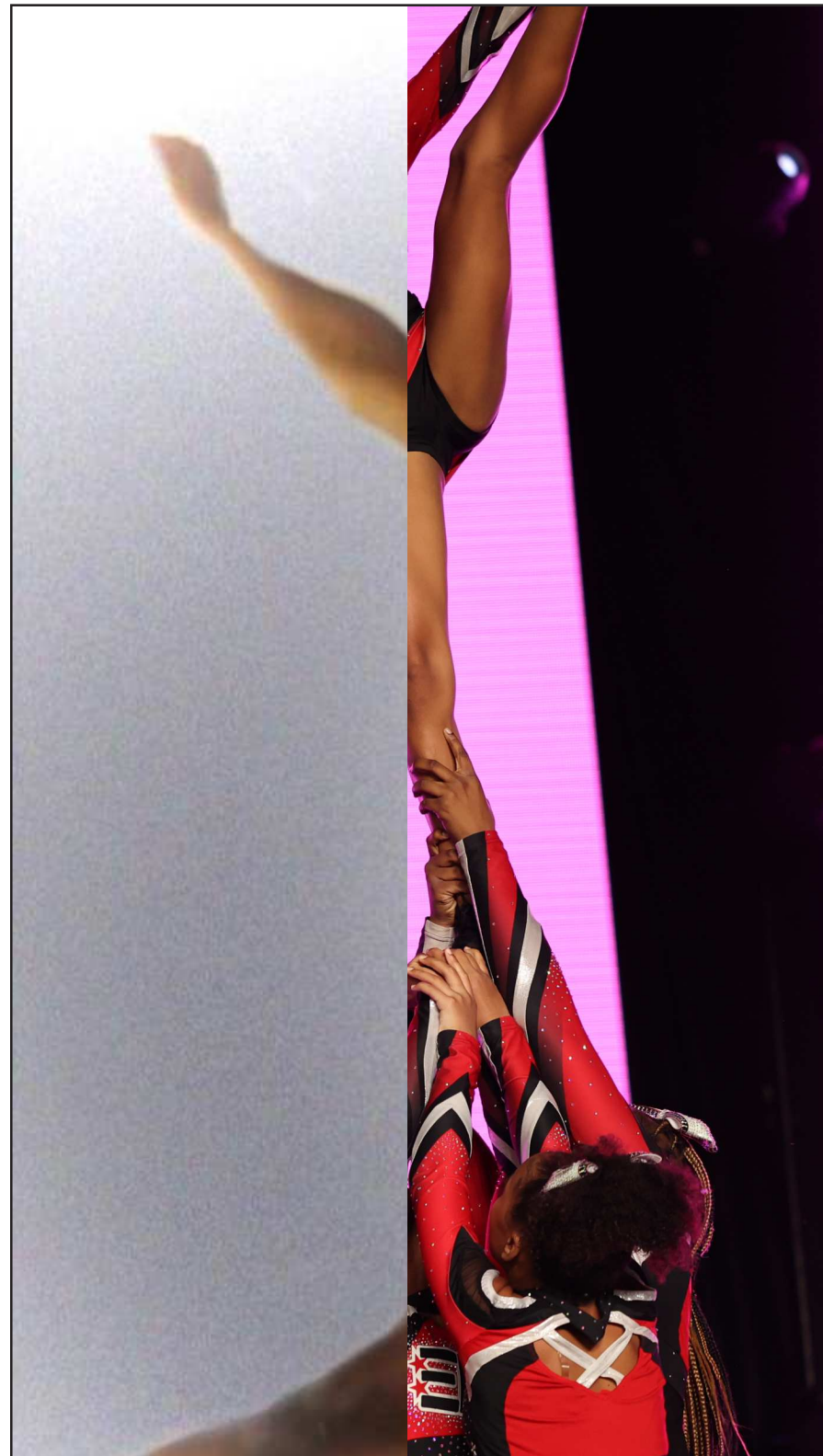

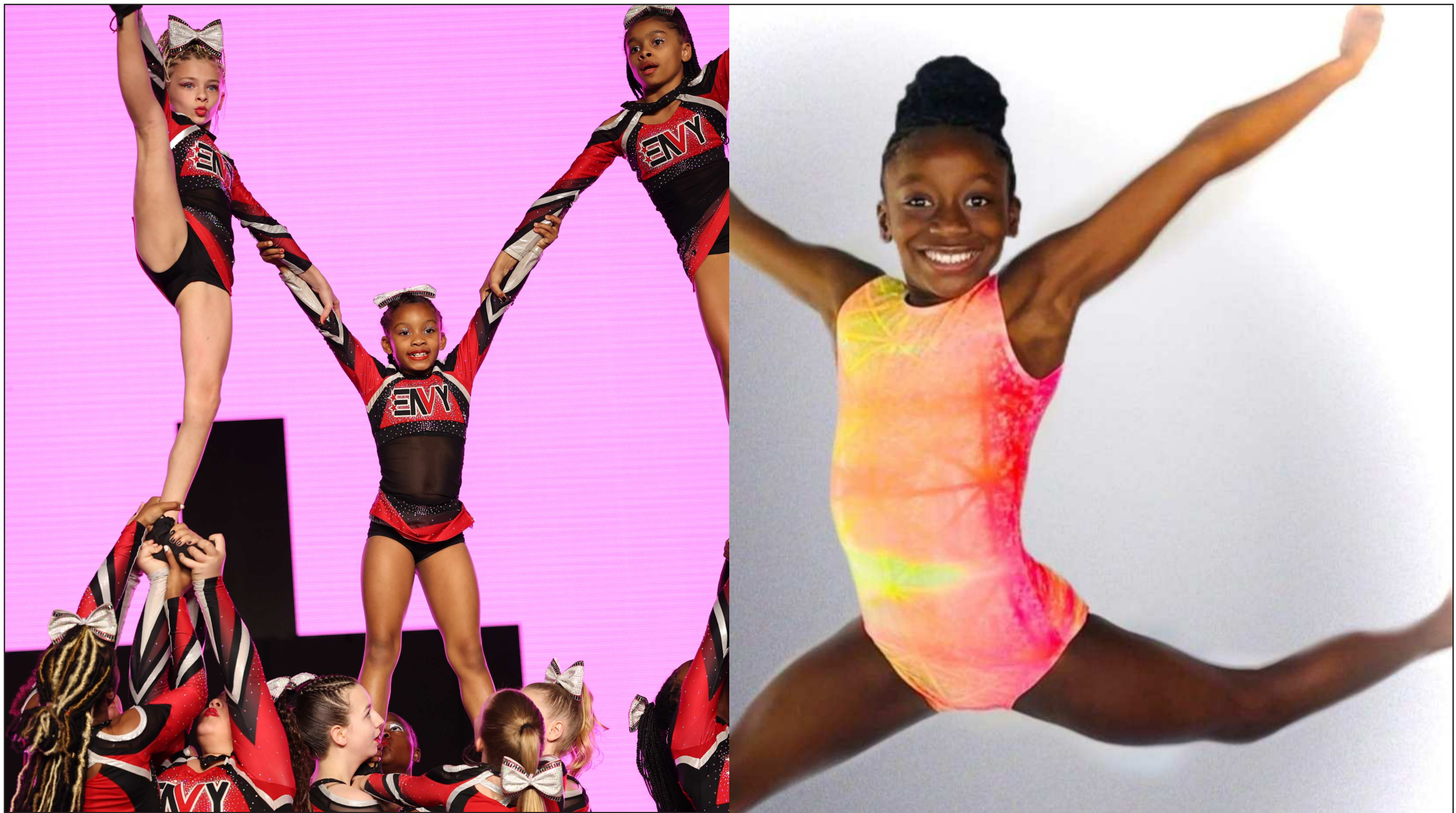
Brook'skyliie is a kind
