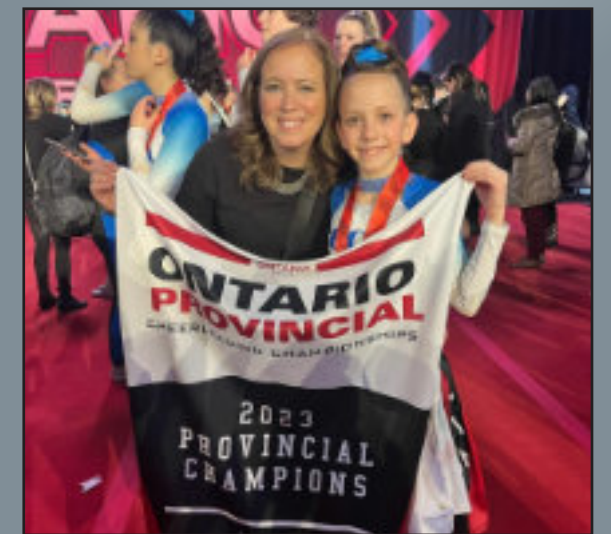
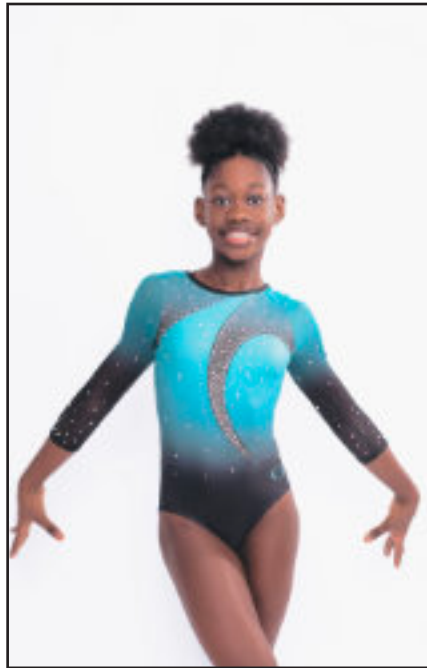
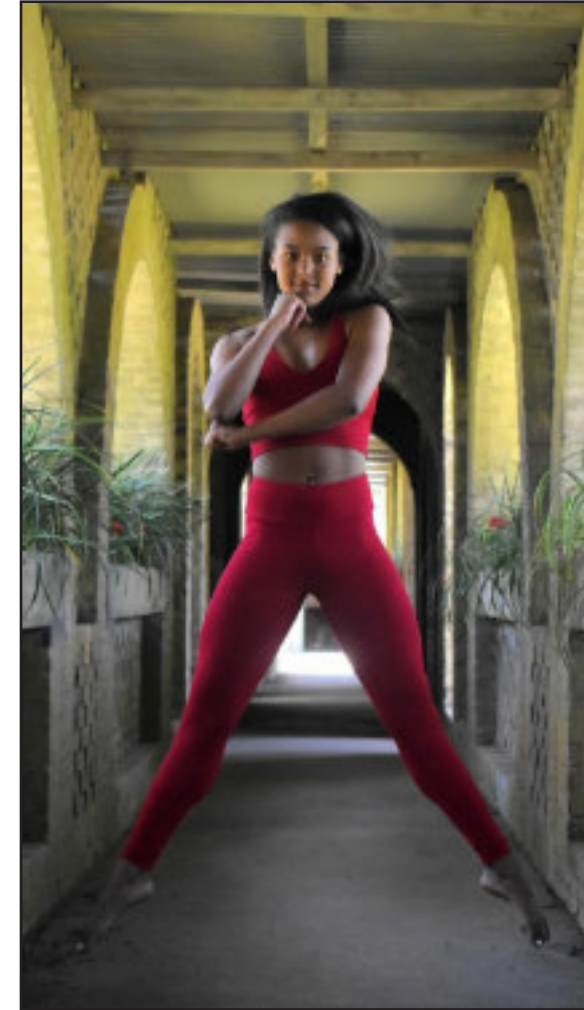

A'Nyiah Williams

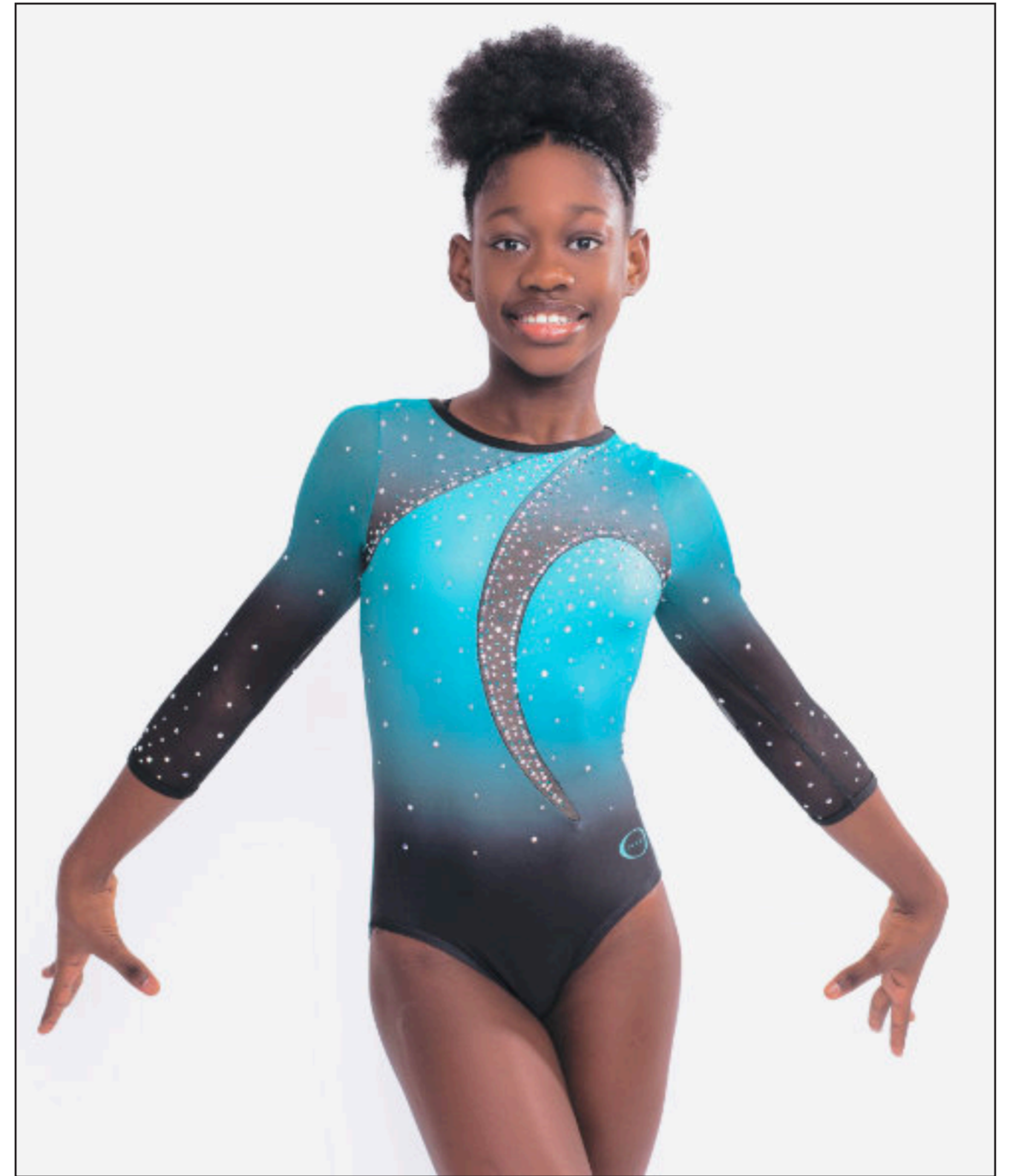
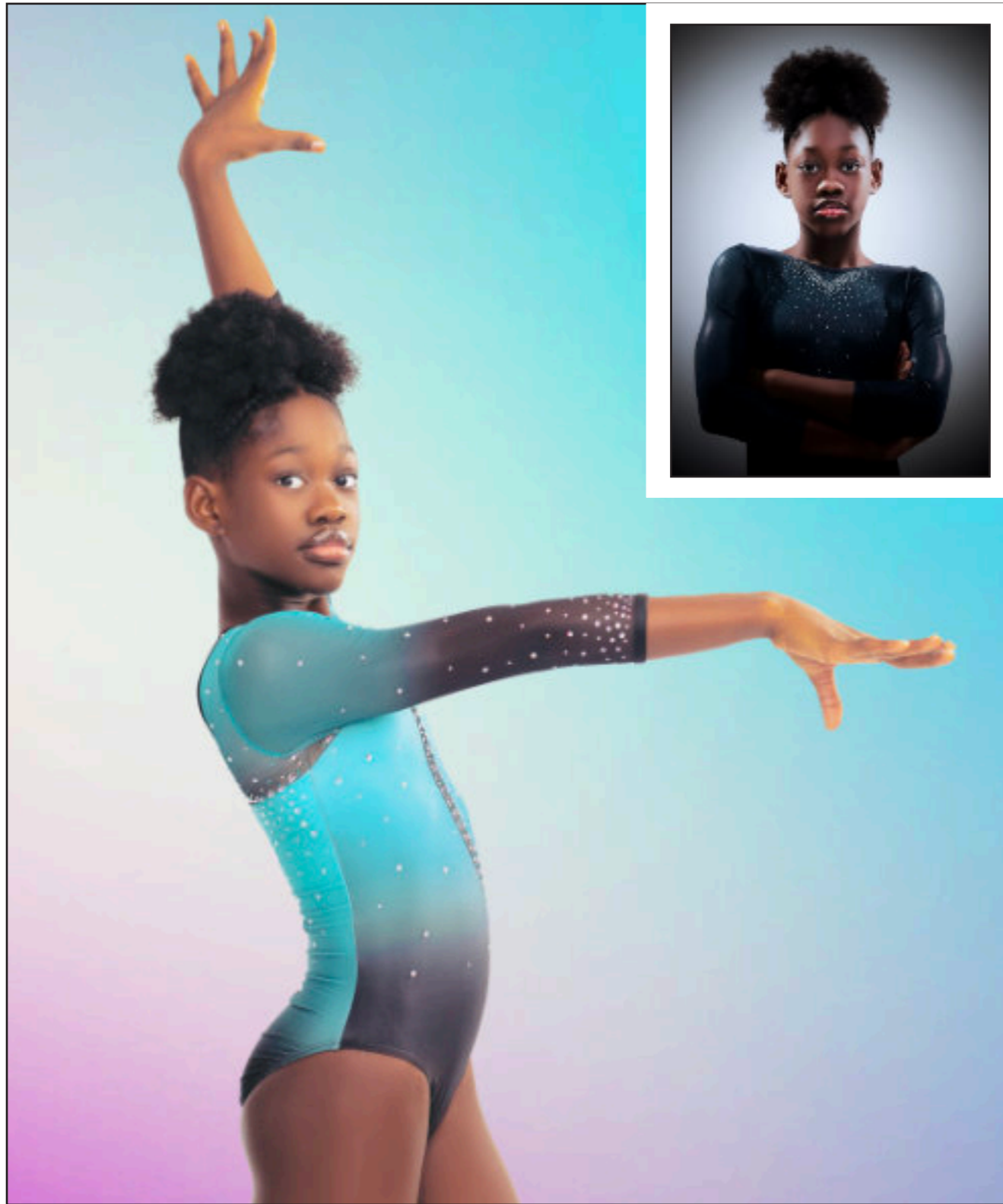

The first time I had a mental block, I had difficulty with my back tuck dismount on beam. I would stand there for the whole beam rotation, frozen, unable to do any backward skills on beam. Above all, as gymnasts we must be patient with ourselves. We are teaching our bodies new moves, tricks and skills daily and that can be a lot of pressure on both you and your body. I love & dream gymnastics. I train like a champ to push myself past my comfort zone, accomplishing a new goal every single time. I am determined. This is my passion. And I will go hard every time I step foot on that mat!

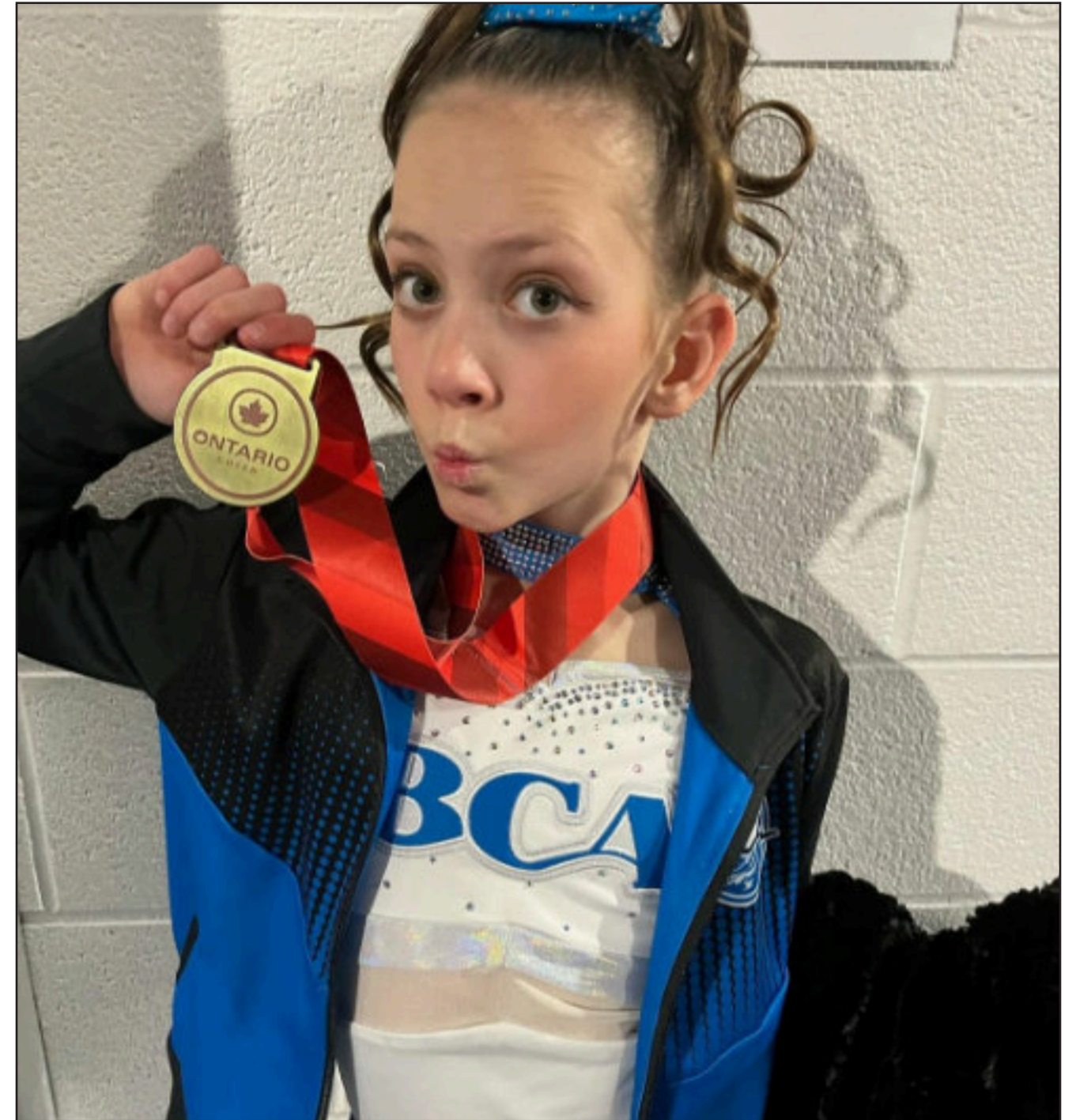

the Basque Country, where I was 1st overall, second on floor, second on bar and second on parallel bars. It was a great experience.

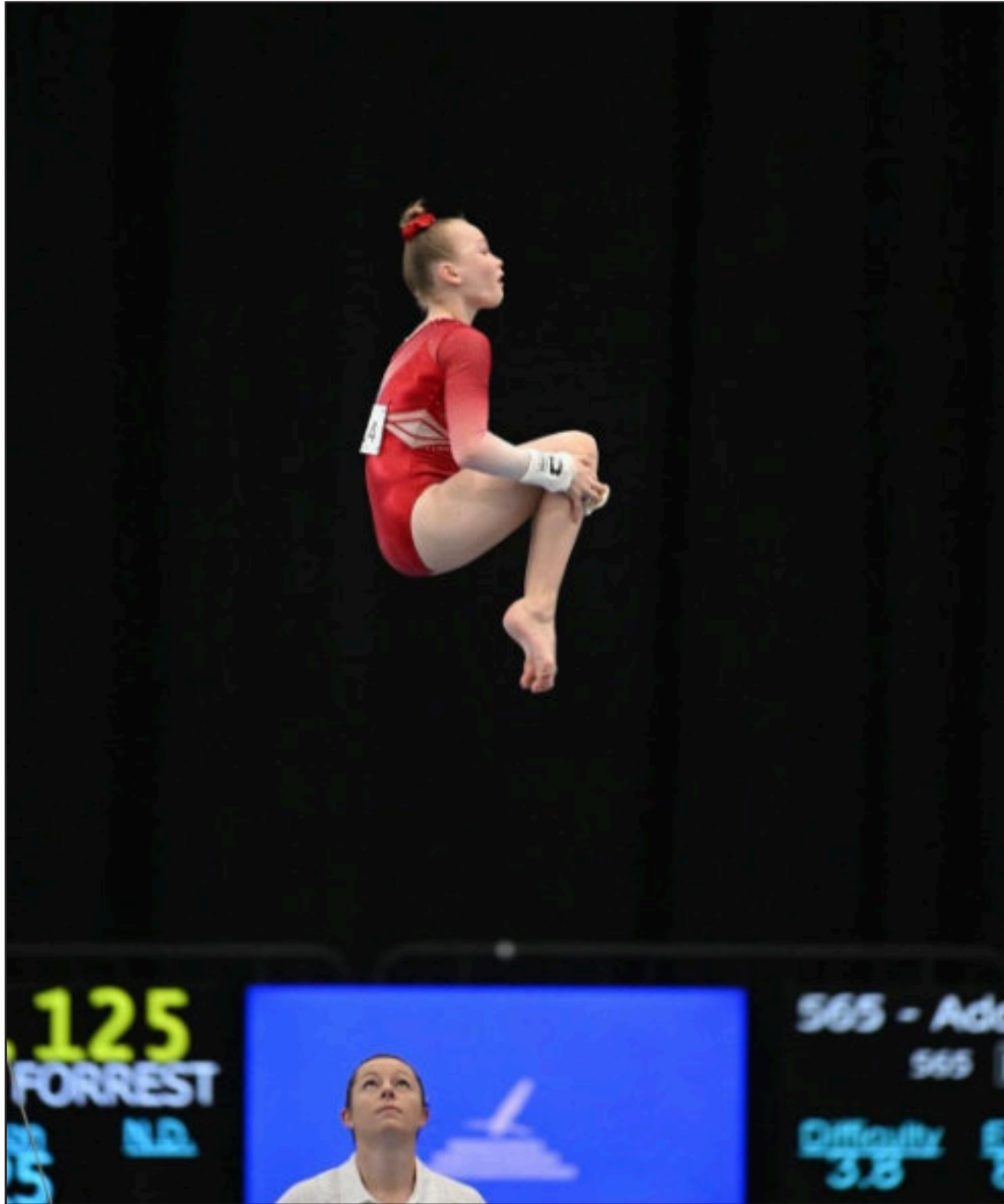

I really enjoy gymnastics, it's my life.

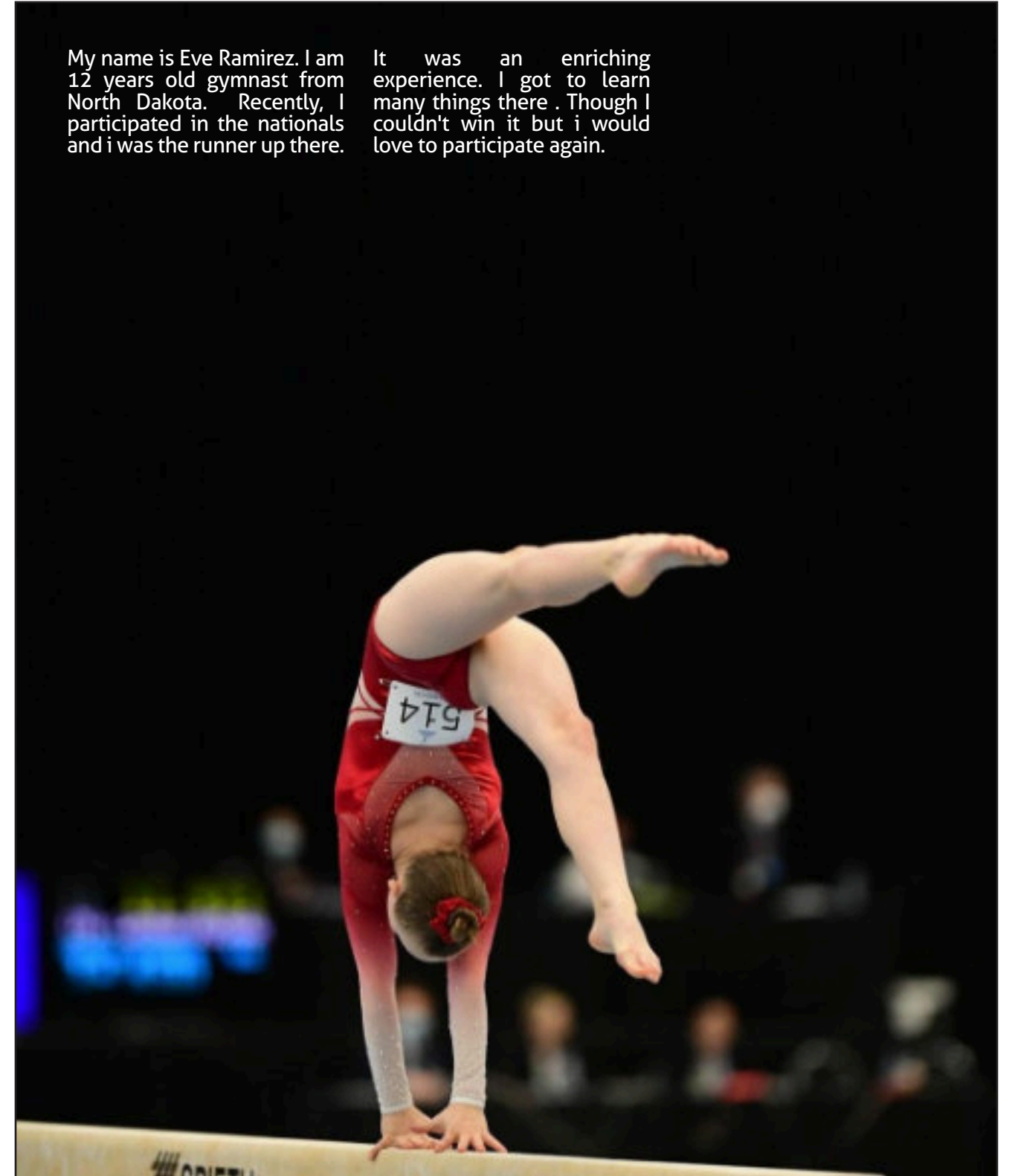


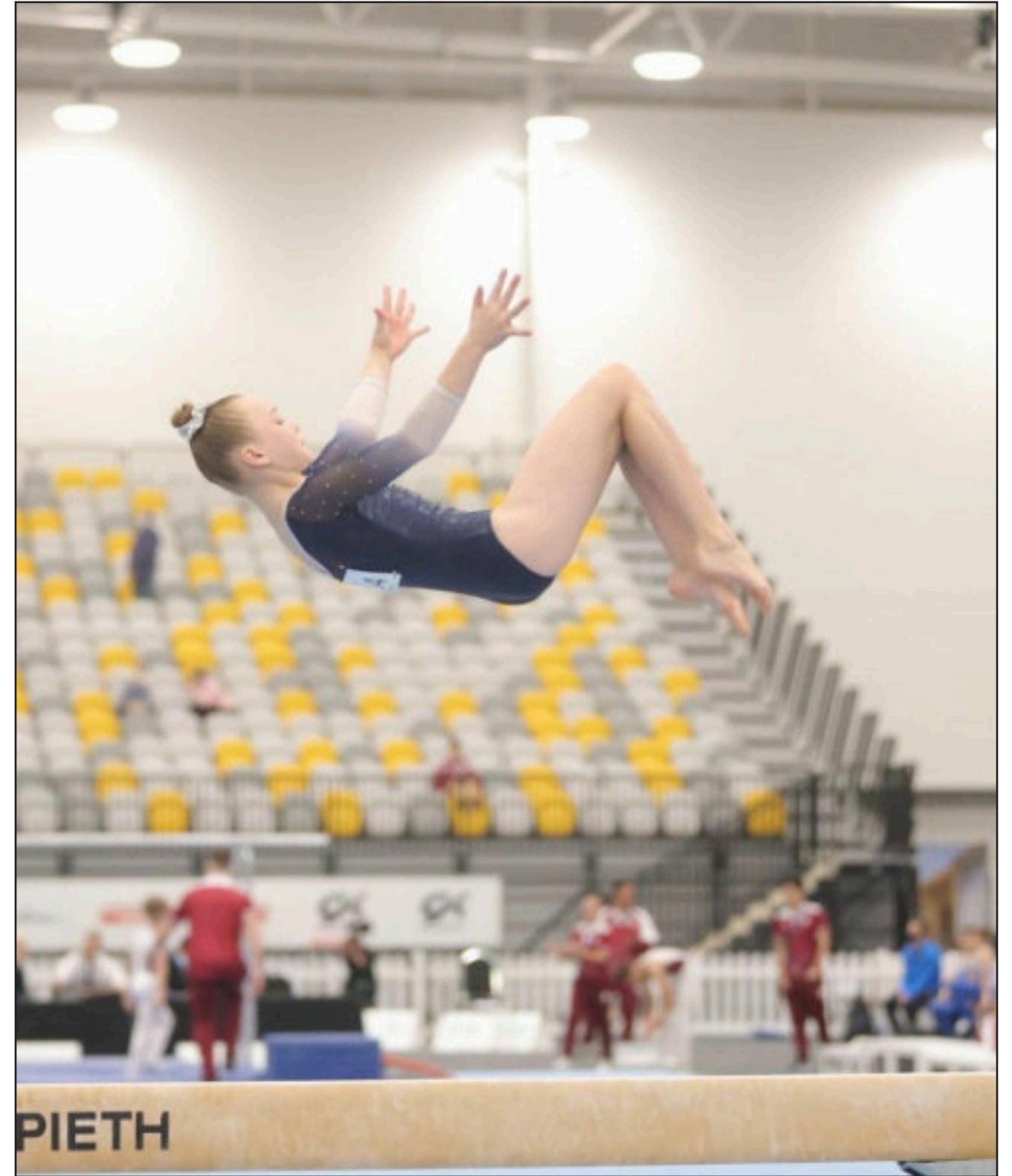




My name is Eve Ramirez. I am 12 years old gymnast from North Dakota. Recently, I participated in the nationals and i was the runner up there.

She trains at home everyday and at her club Southport Gymnastics Club. She also practices her flexibility EVERYWHERE.

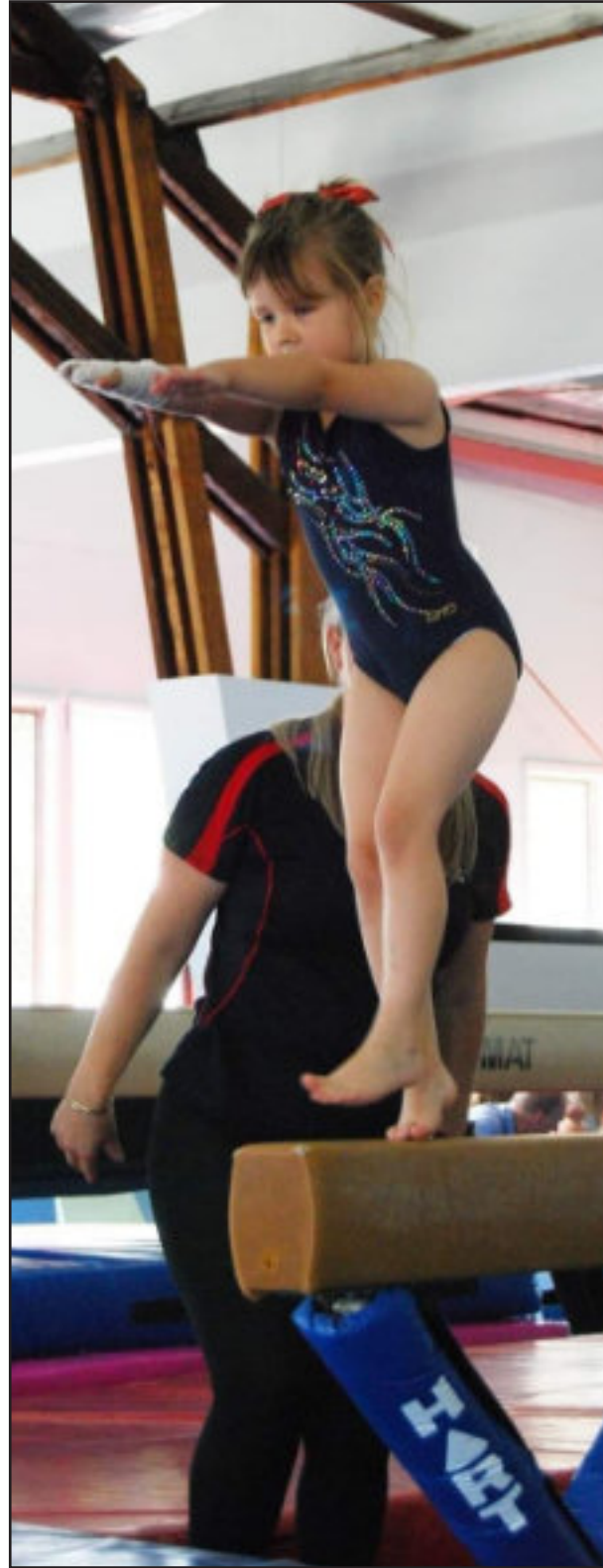
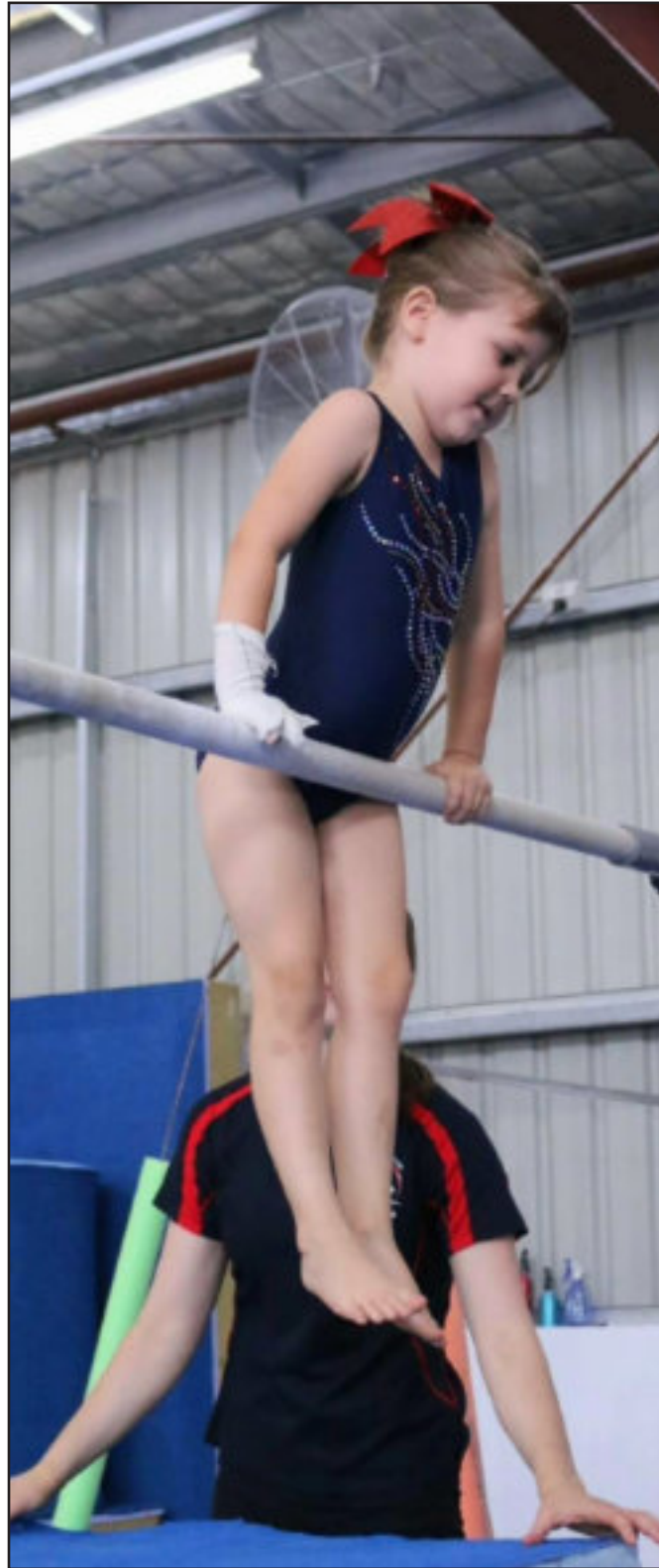

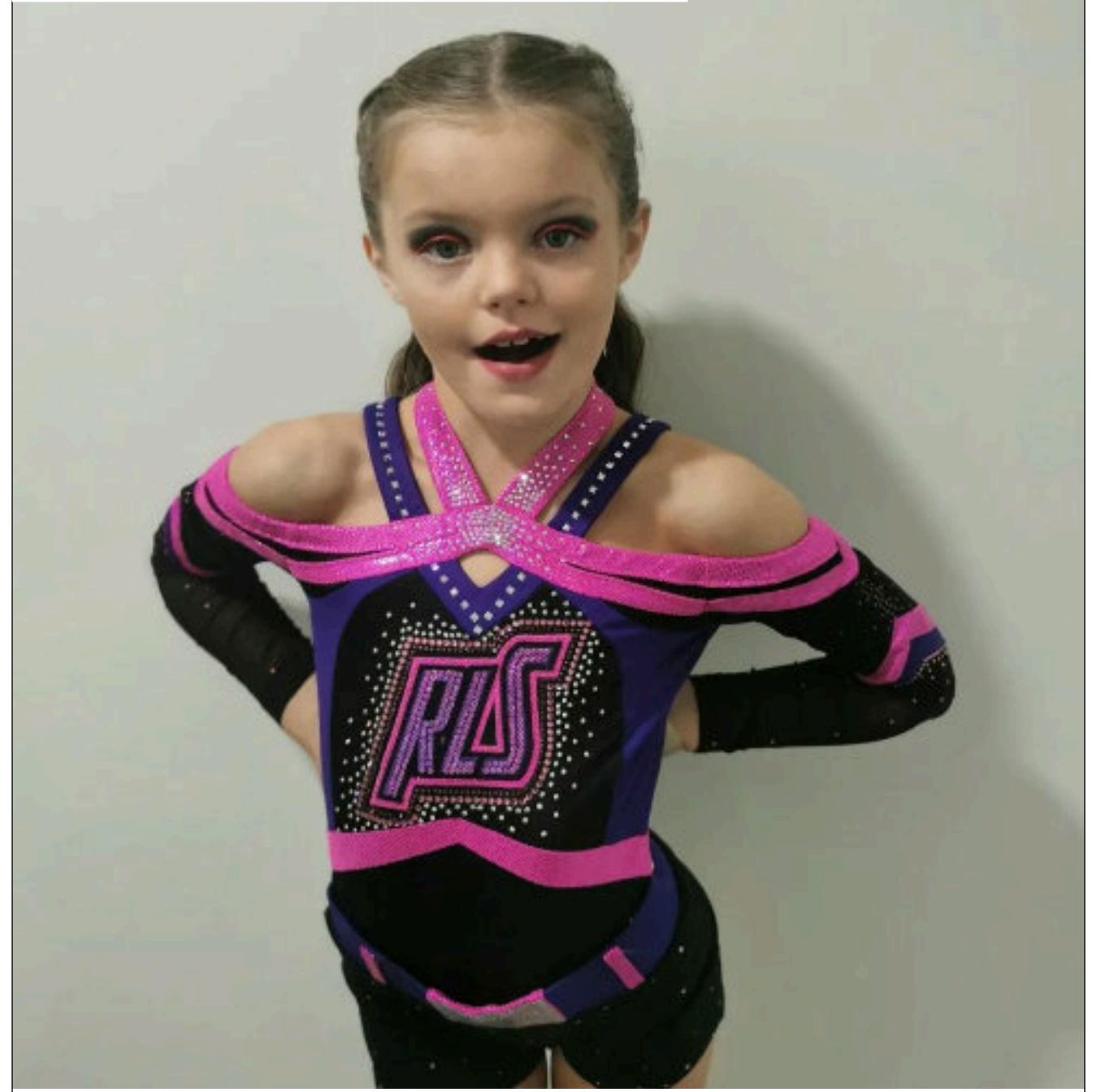






My name is Jordyn. My biggest dream is to represent my country. I always work in that direction. I know this takes a lot of perseverance and dedication. Few days

back, I was very excited for my FC winter wonderland but unfortunately I lost. I know this is not ideal but it's good to lose as you get to know your weaknesses.



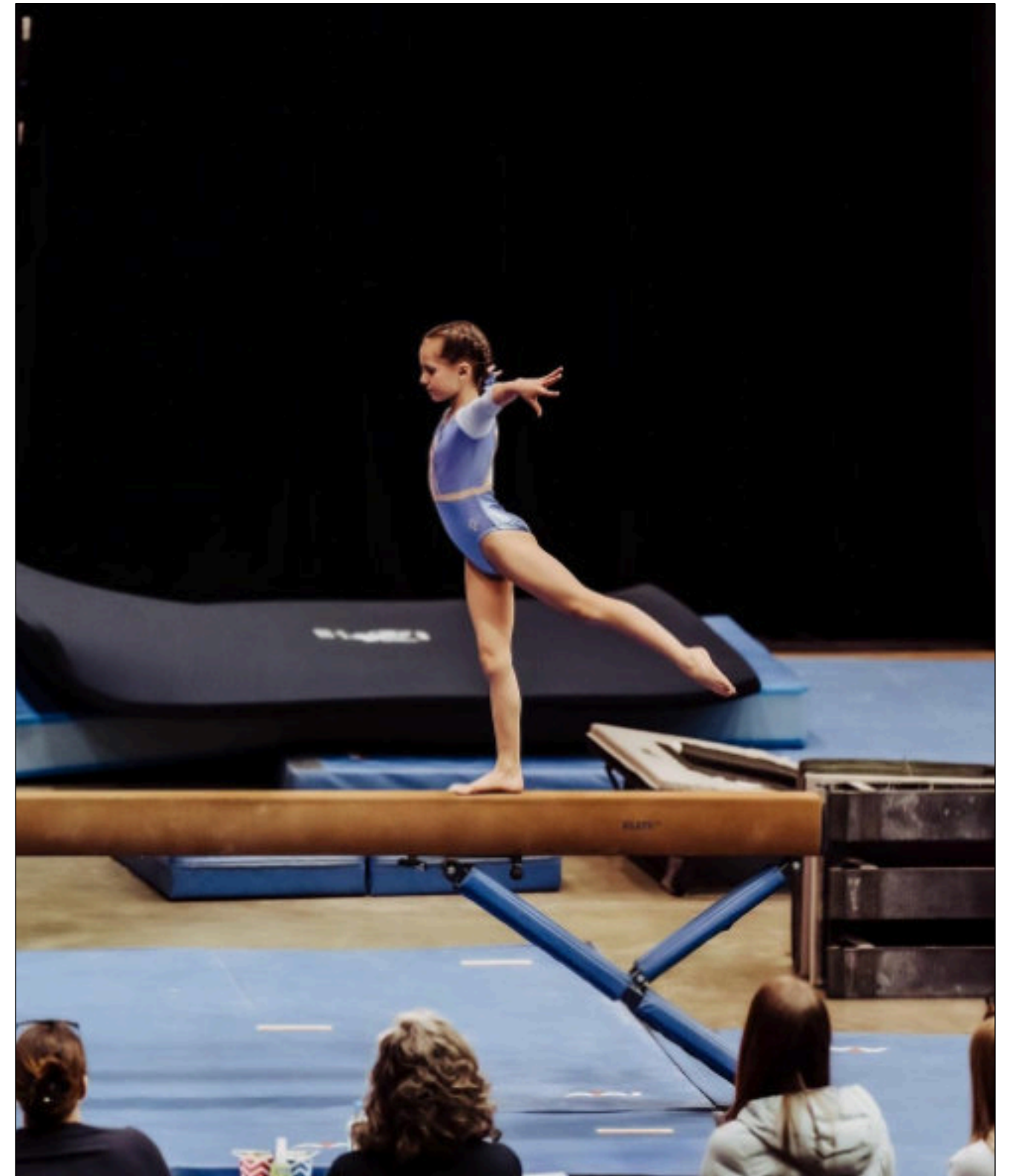




Katya Starovoit

form into birdie position. I am learning that it is not possible to jump high if I am constantly falling from the high bar. So i working hard to regain my form.

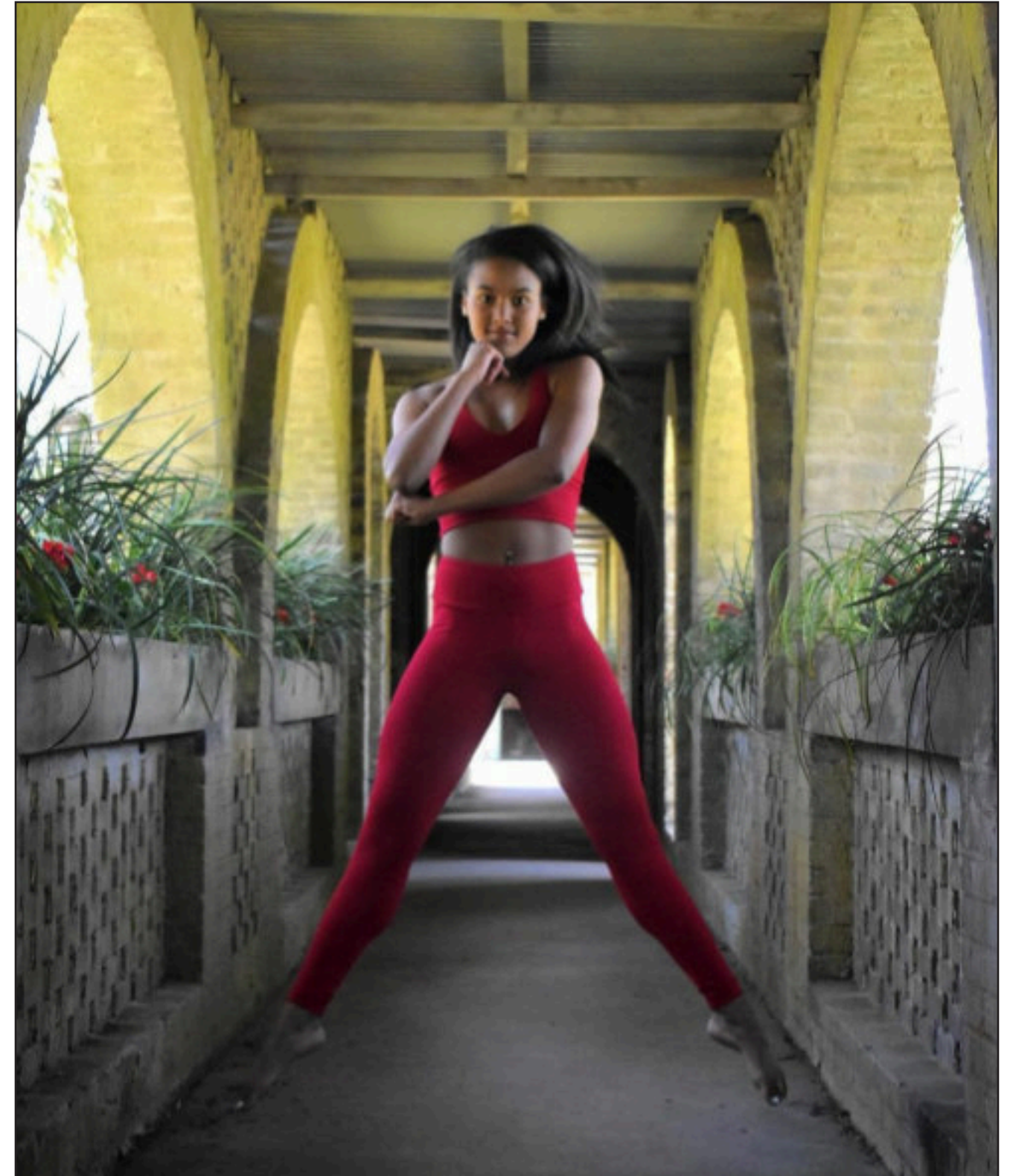




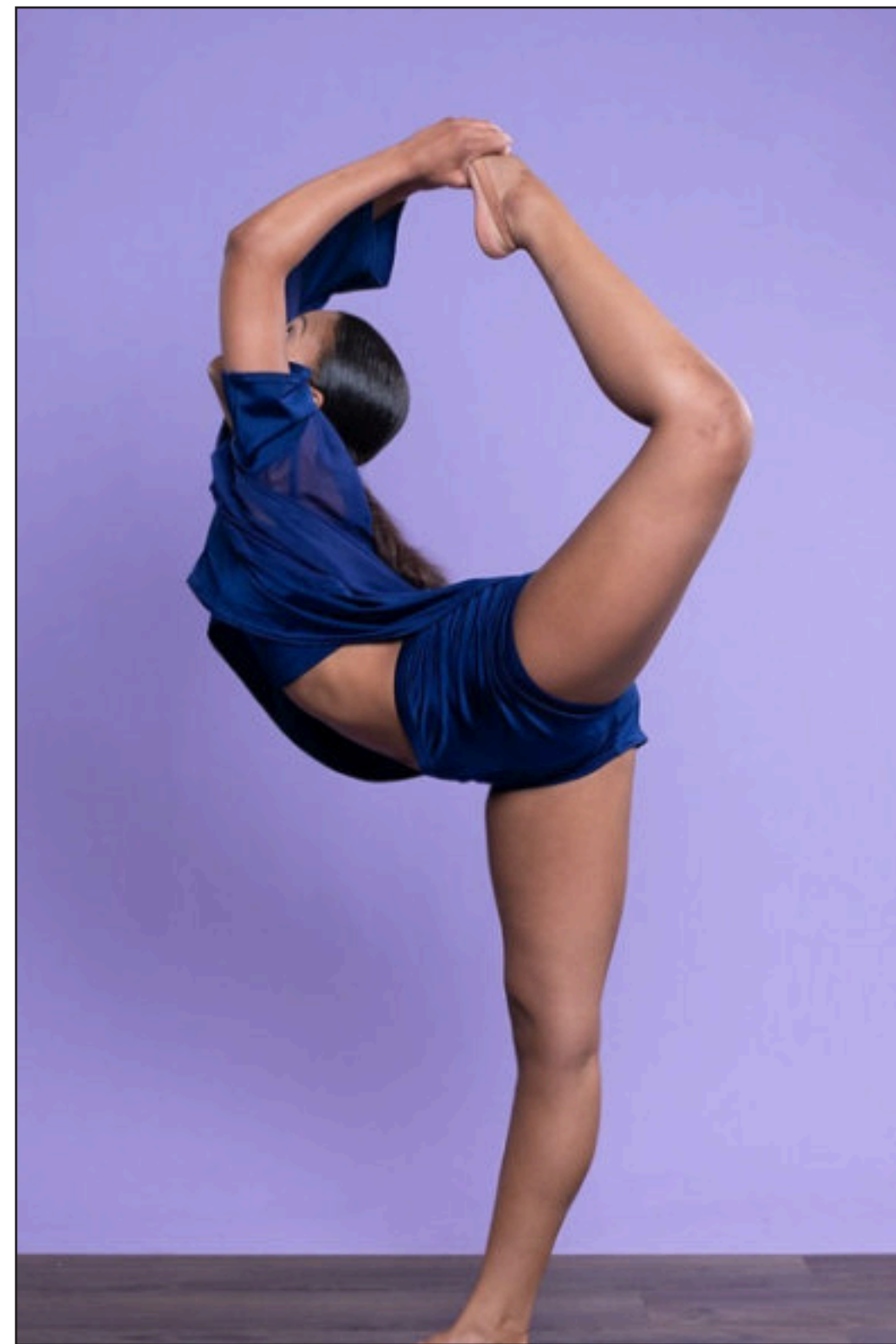


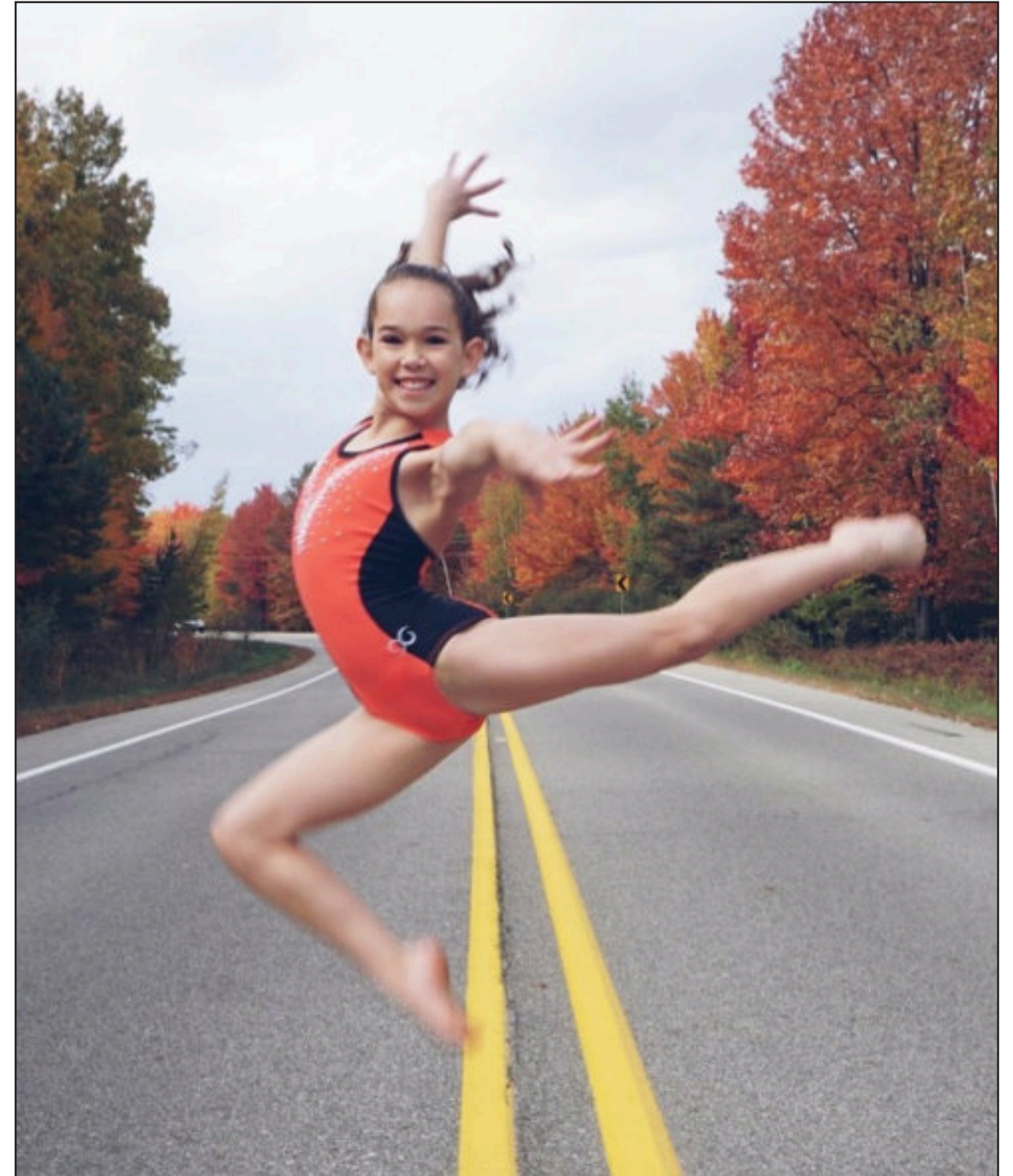


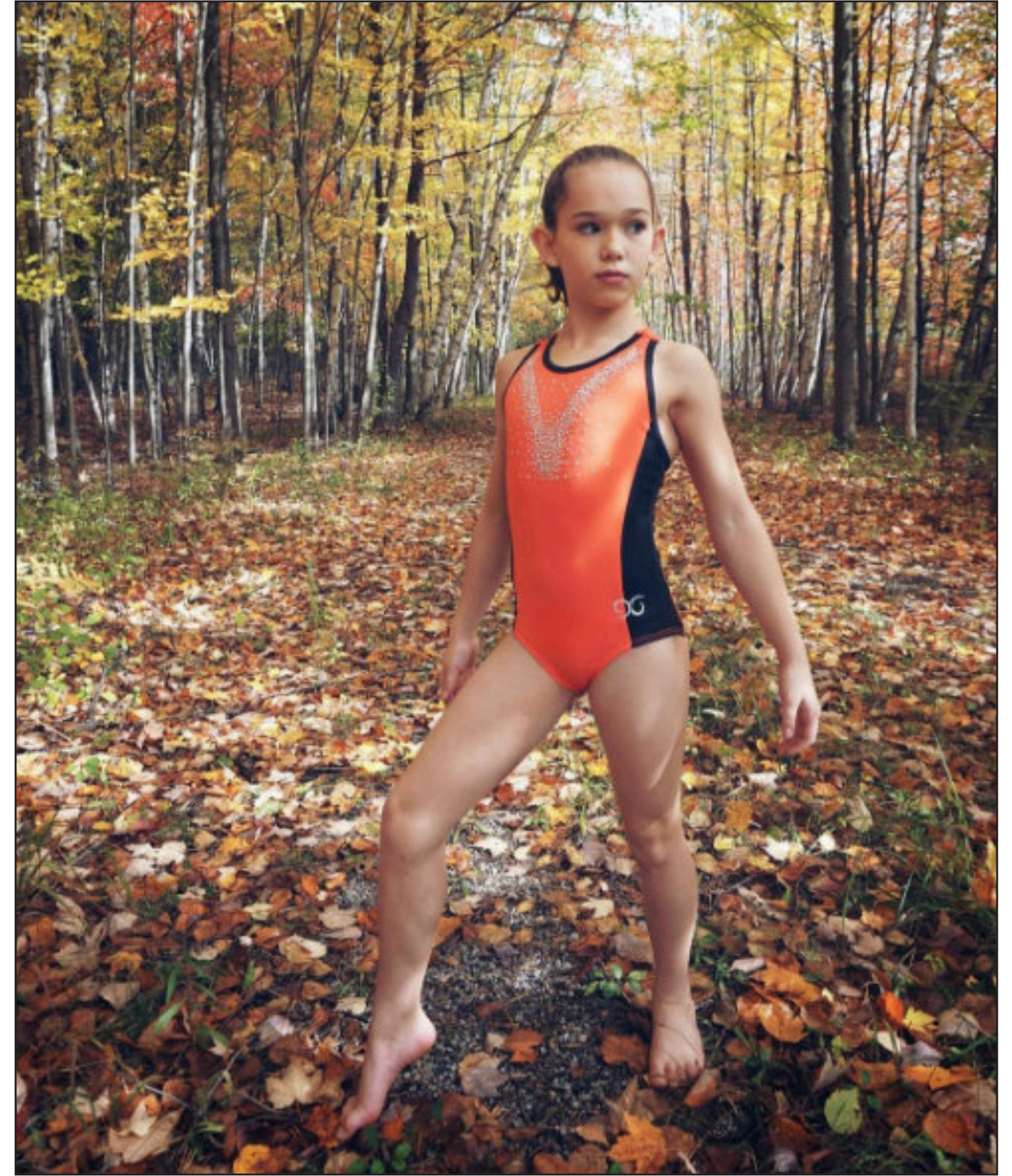

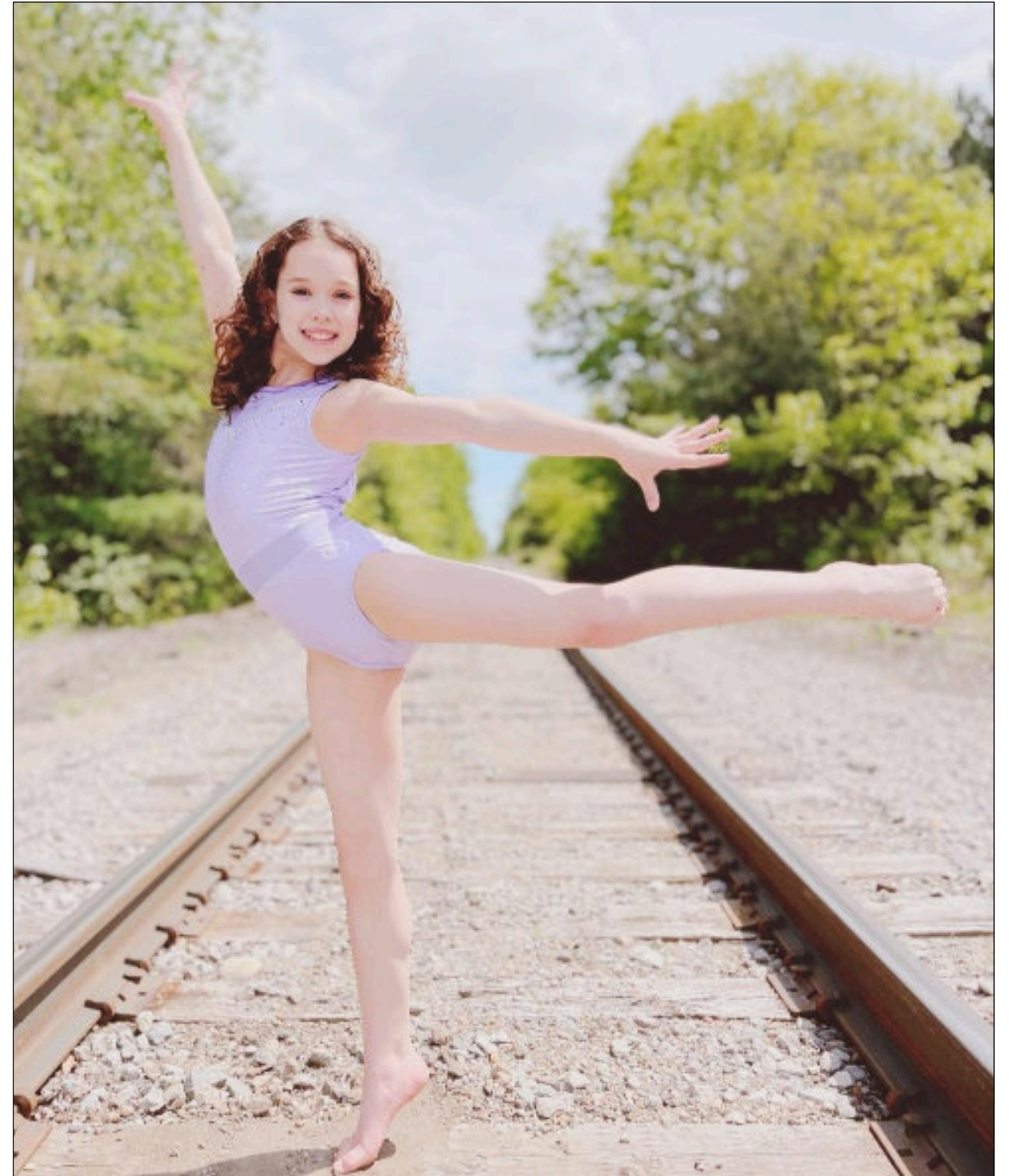










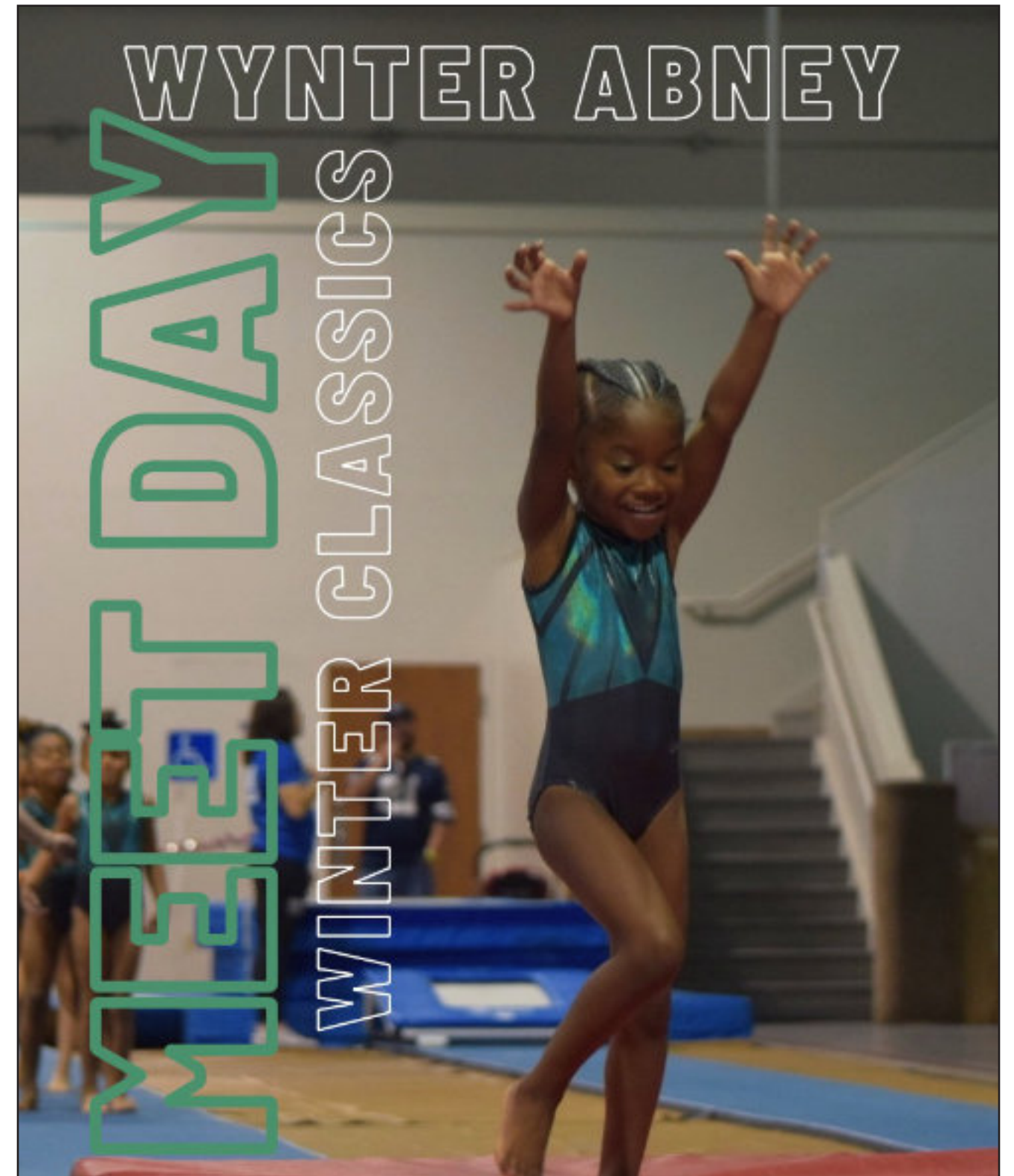


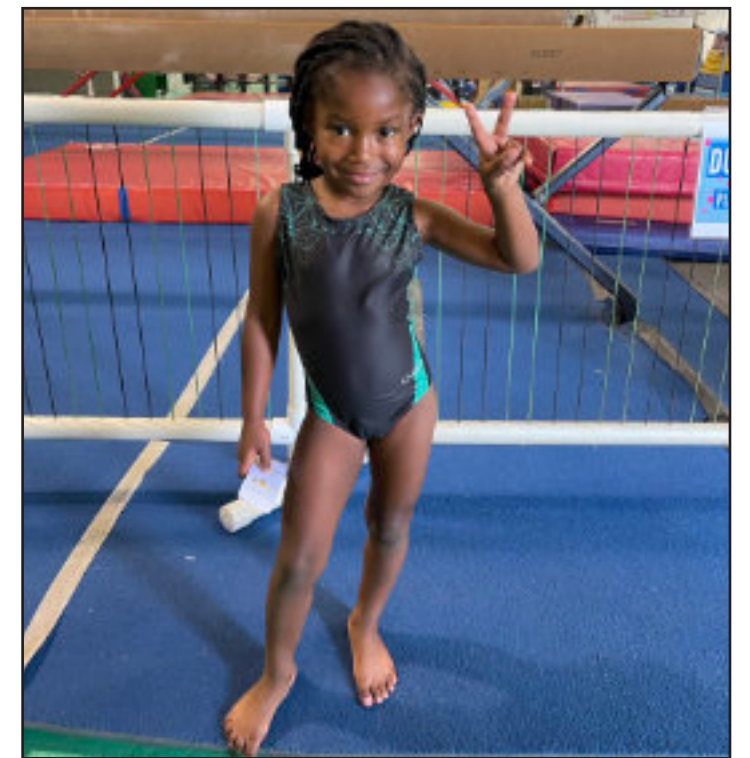
Wynter Abney

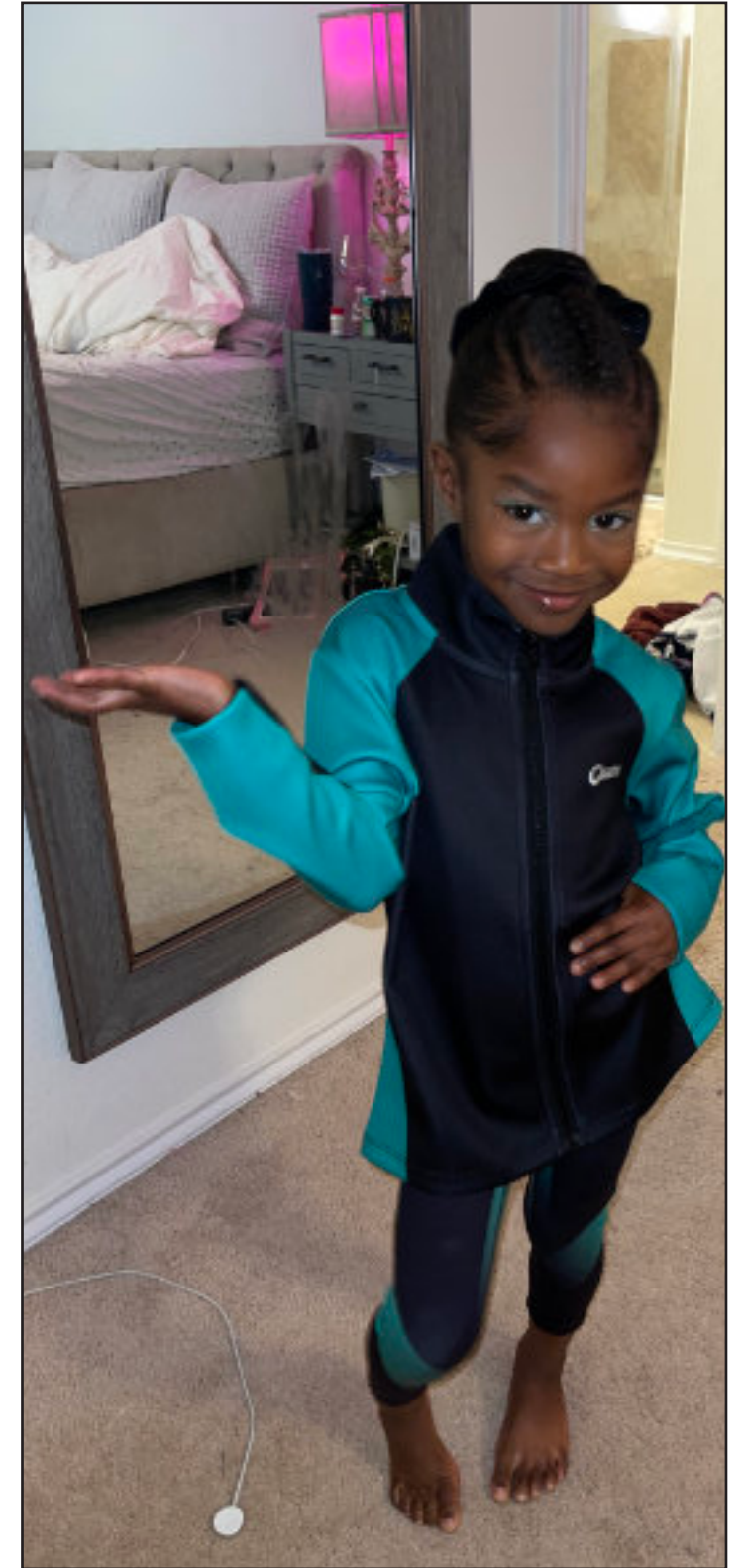
