I am currently a competitive teenage MMA and Jujitsu fighter from Victoria, BC, Canada.

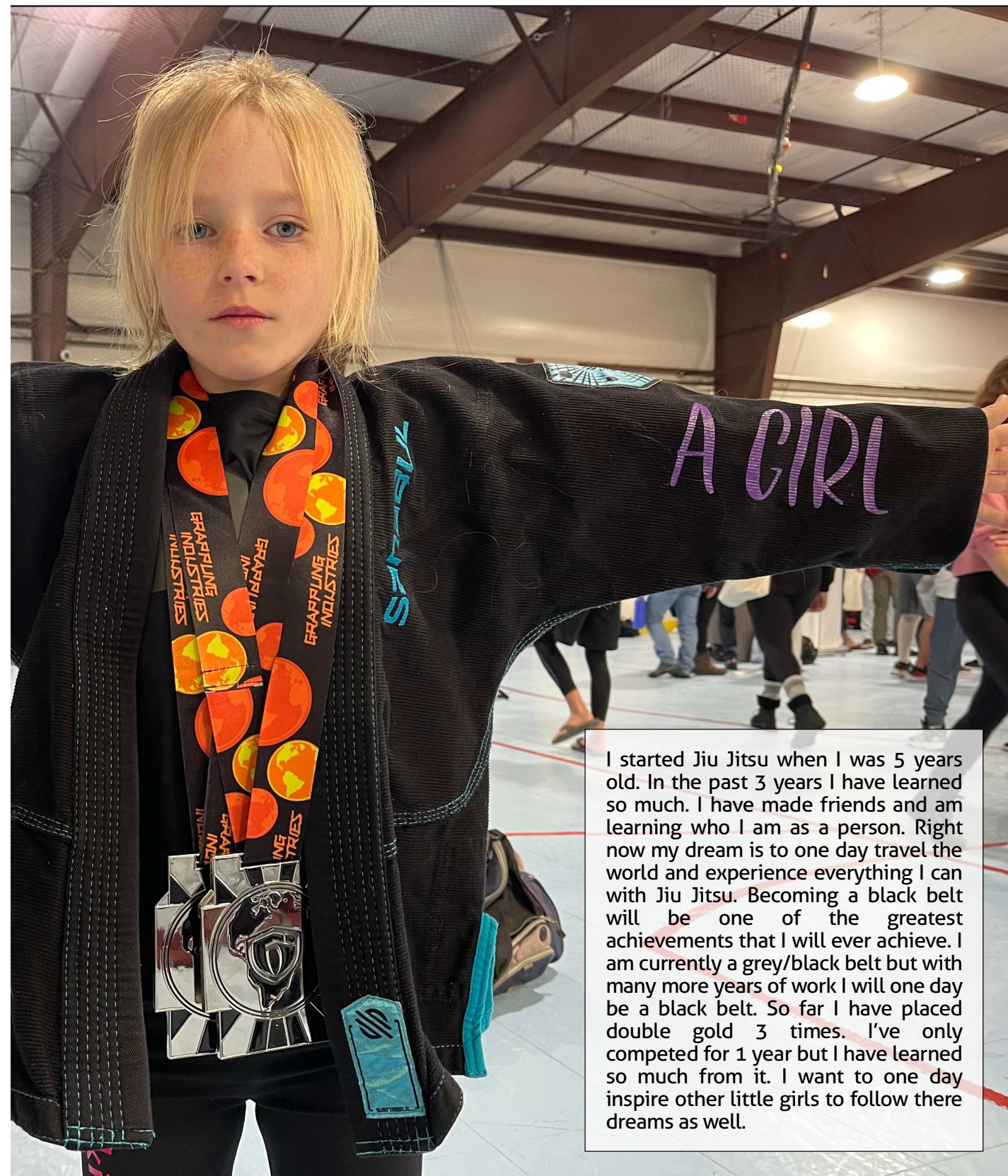

Typically, I train in the gym 4-6 hours a week, sometimes more in the off-season.

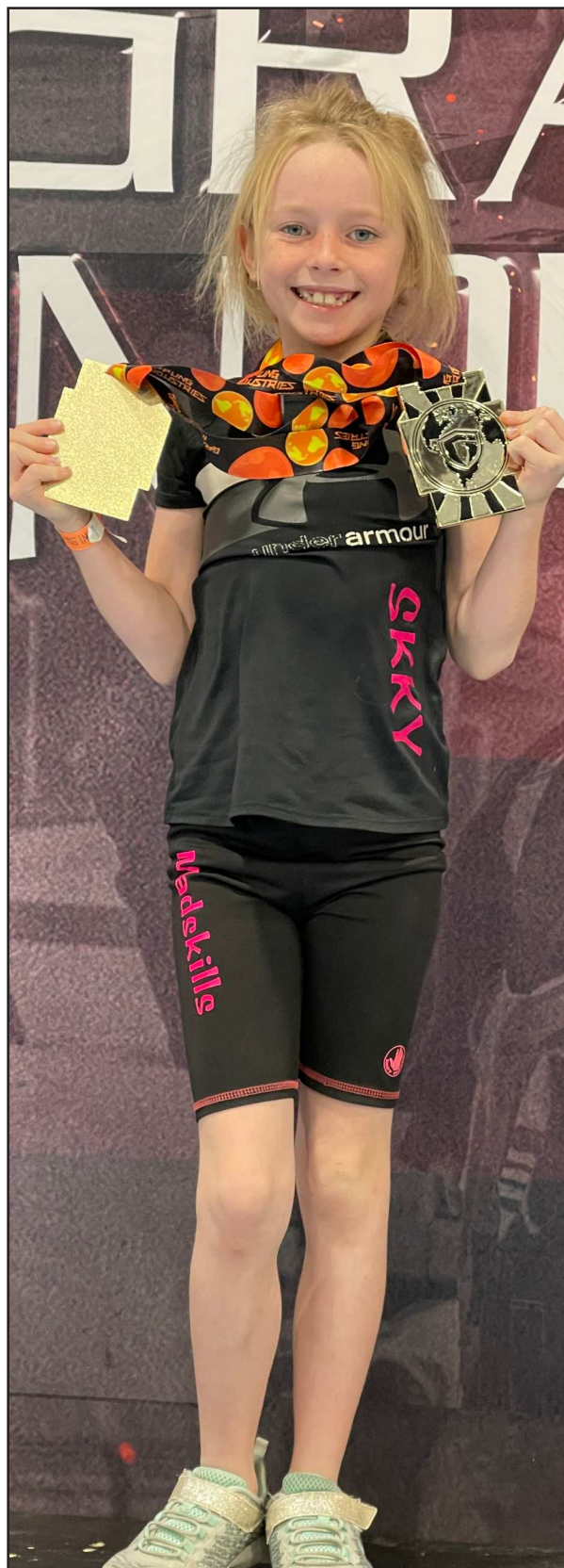
When I am not in a gym or working with an athletic trainer, I am chasing my other dream ..
