


**Arielle


Gabriel's next battles will be at the Internacional kids Curitiba IBJJF and the Eurokids IBJJF, which will be held in November and December respectively.



fuel to win. I like to show my skills wherever I get an opportunity to do so. I am too seasoned in the matches but I hope to improve in near future.







My name is Olivia Rayne - Being a martial artist, I am always concerned about my weight and want to maintain it. I believe if I maintain a good posture and body positioning,


the sky is the limit. i am born to play and i am happy doing what I do. i like to train my mind for suffering and inflict suffer. There's a certain amount of resilience required


which i am building. I just believe in honesty and fighting with courage without thinking much about the results.

I am a jiu-jitsu and Taekwondo athlete. I am


interested in pursuing my career as an athlete and in the future becoming a great professional in the area of physical preparation for future athletes.




