My name Issy. I'm known as ISSYBJJ. I started my Jiu-Jitsu journey in May of 2021, when I was 8 years old. My dad put me into Jiu-Jitsu because l was bullied by bigger kids and he wanted me to gain confidence in my self. I was always into combat sports. When I was four years old, I would go with my dad to the boxing gym and watch him train. I always asked him to train me and once in a while he would hold the pads for me and I would hit them for a few rounds. I always sat next to my dad during boxing and MMA fights and we would bet snacks on who was going to win the fights. I won a lot of snacks. One day while watching fights, my dad asked me if I wanted to try Jiu-Jitsu. He explained to me what Jiu-Jitsu was and I said I wanted to try it. My first day of Jiu-Jitsu at Mako Brazilian Jiu-Jitsu in Tucson Arizona, I was nervous but the coaches were great with me and the teammates helped me learn the techniques. I fell in love with Jiu-Jitsu and I never stopped going. I started competing after training for four months. Competition makes me nervous but also makes me feel accomplished. I have had great wins and tough losses but I have grown a lot in the sport. 


