

Skateboarding has become an exciting game for me, where it allows me to share experiences with other skaters, grow and be the best skater of my age, in my country.


Knowing other parks inside and outside Venezuela is one of my goals, so I can feel the magic of practicing vertical, and bowling.

My favourite tricks are all sorts of varial flips.


My speed in the bowl is really improving. I am beginning to get big airs and grinds.

My ambition is to be in the Olympics and SLS one day.


I have had some amazing instructors. I thank them all for what they are teaching me.


I really enjoy meeting so many people through skating. Many of my best friends are skaters.





