I (Tom - 9 years) want to be a professional skater and a soccer player. I love skateboarding -

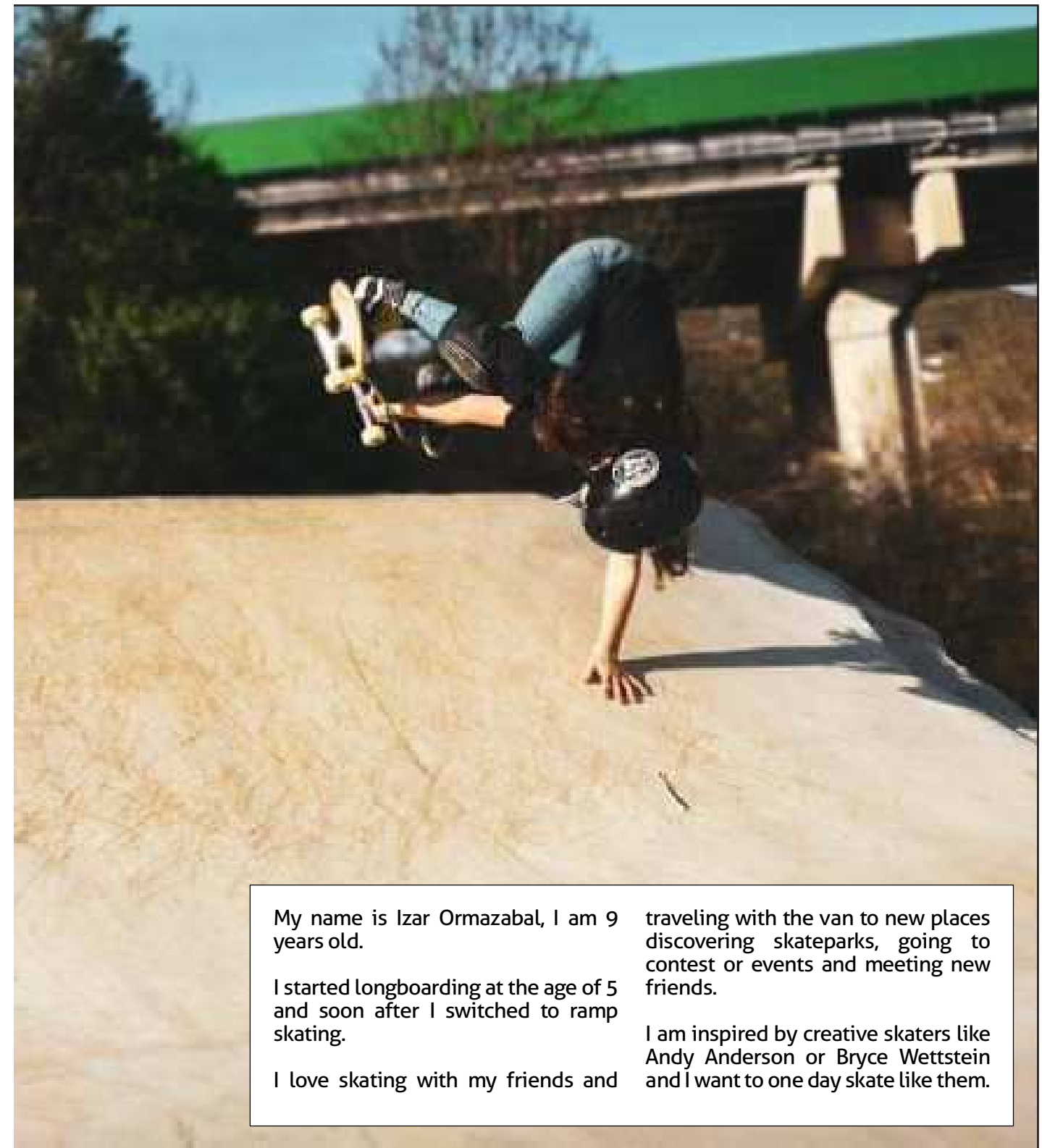
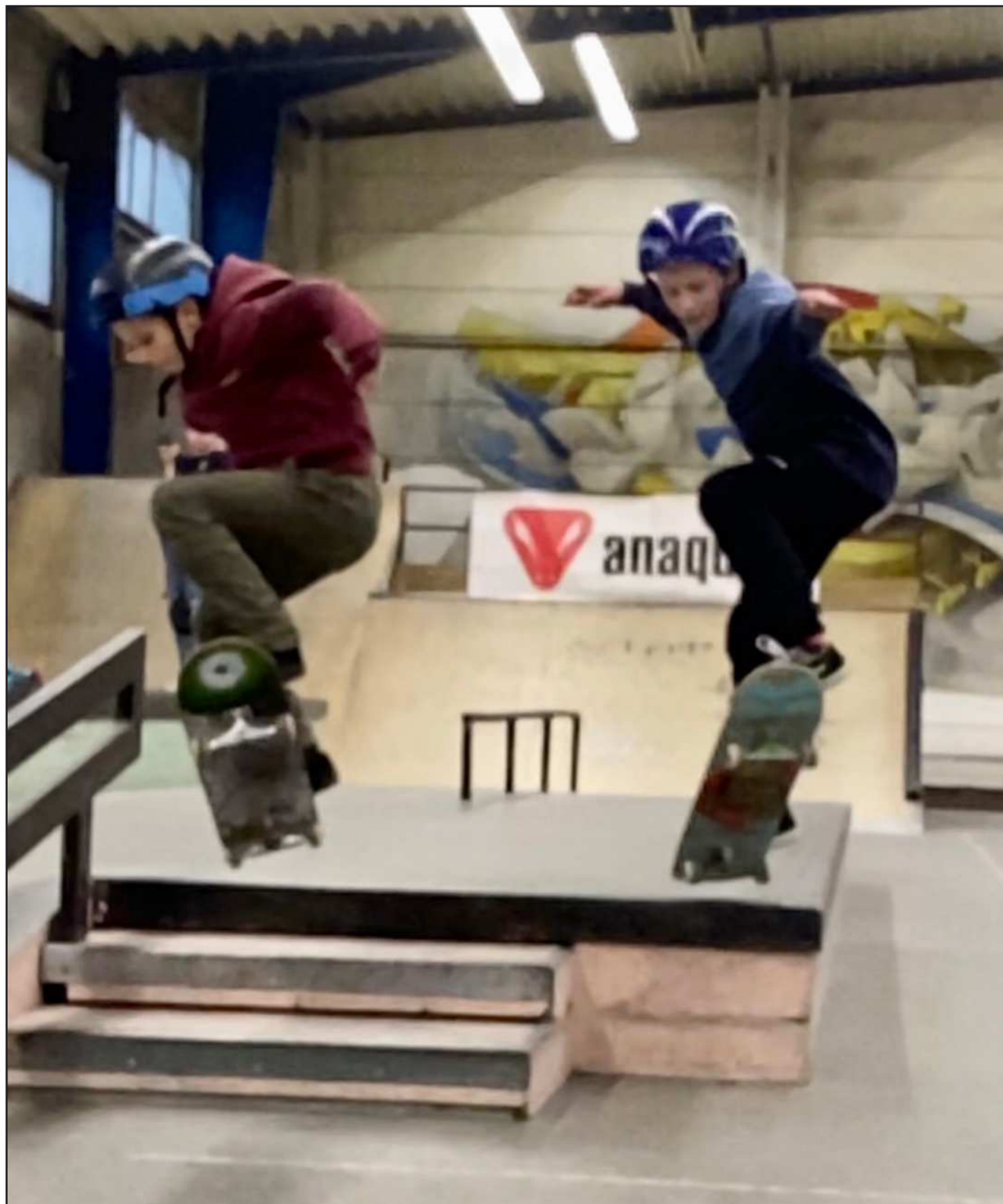

I love skating with my friends and traveling with the van to new places discovering skateparks, going to contest or events and meeting new friends.

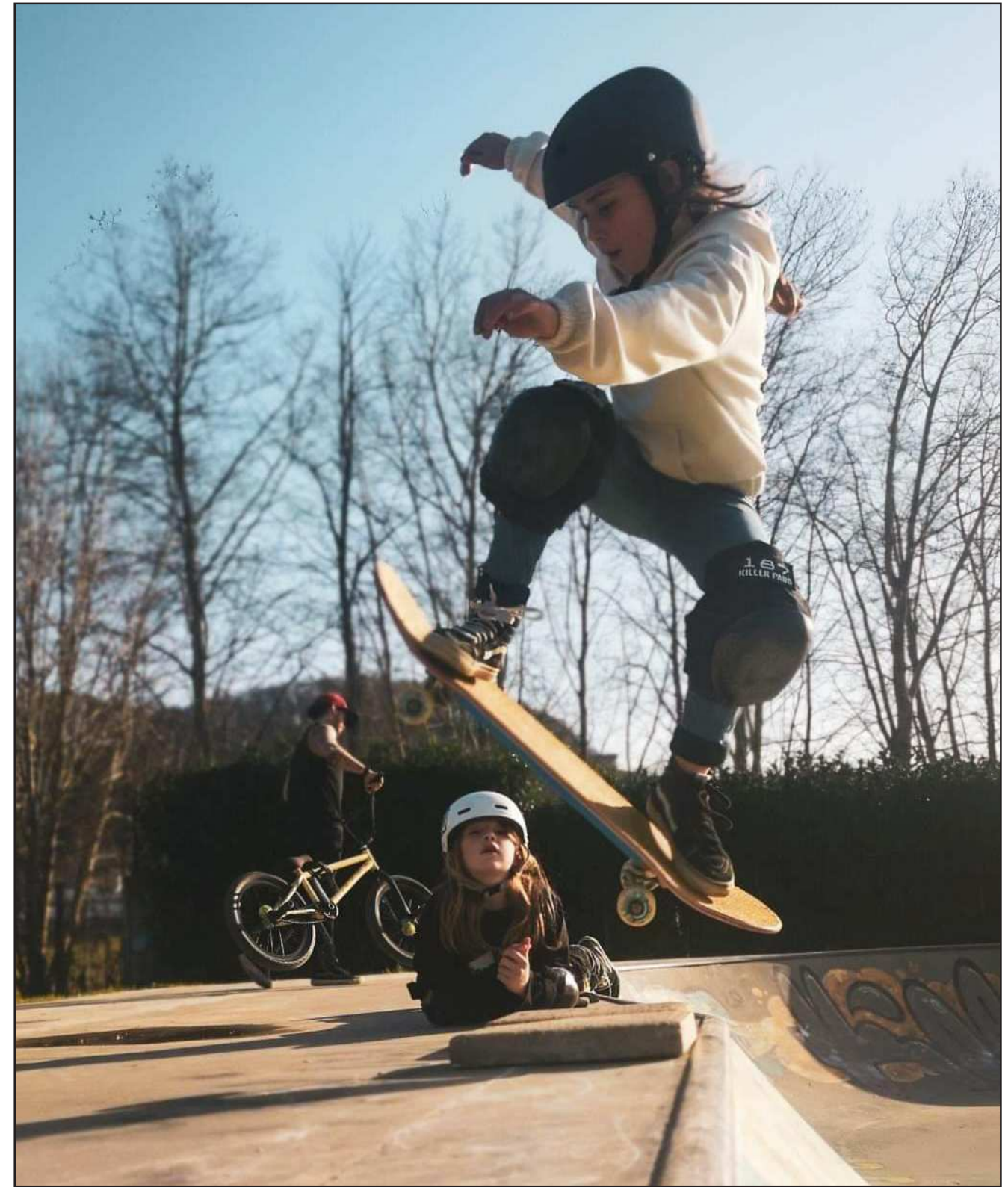
I am inspired by creative skaters like Andy Anderson or Bryce Wettstein and I want to one day skate like them.
