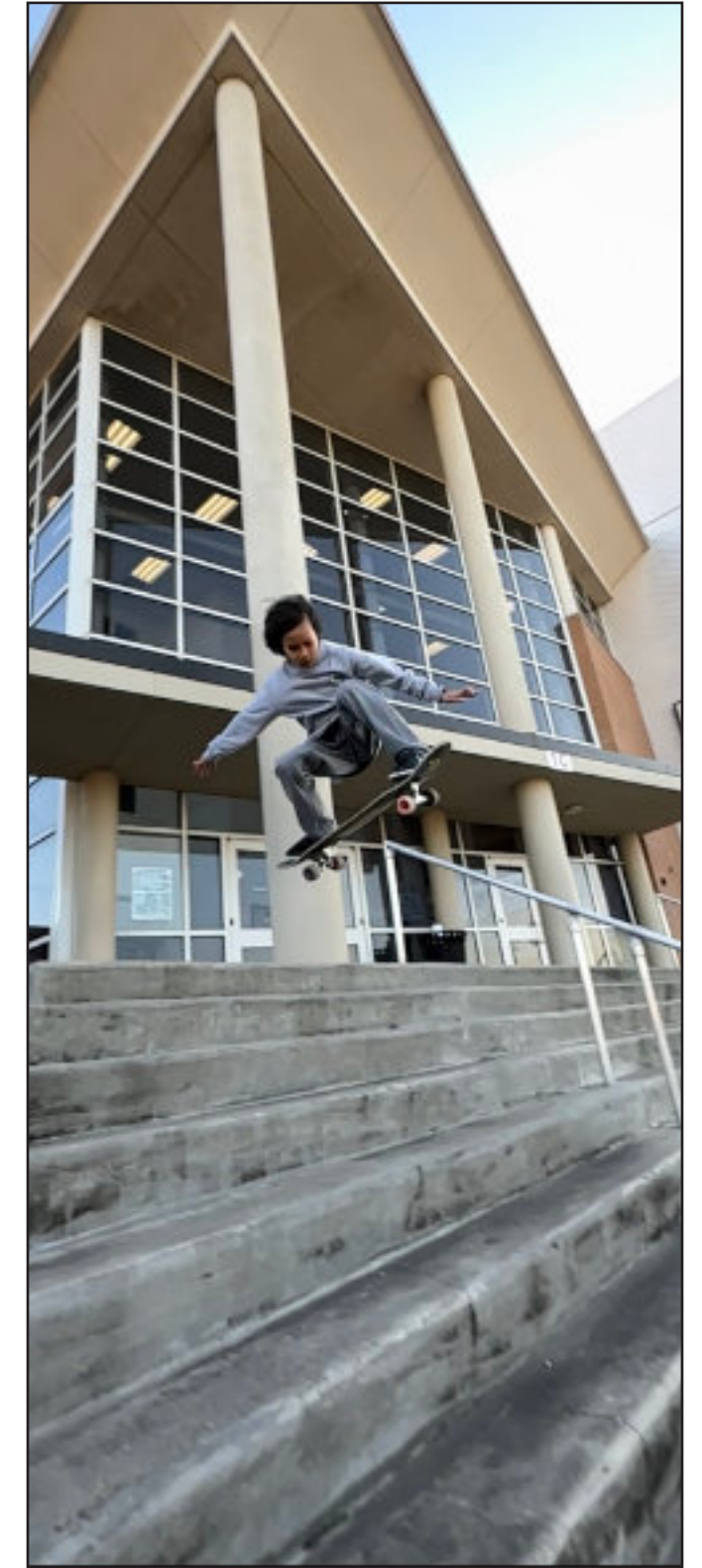
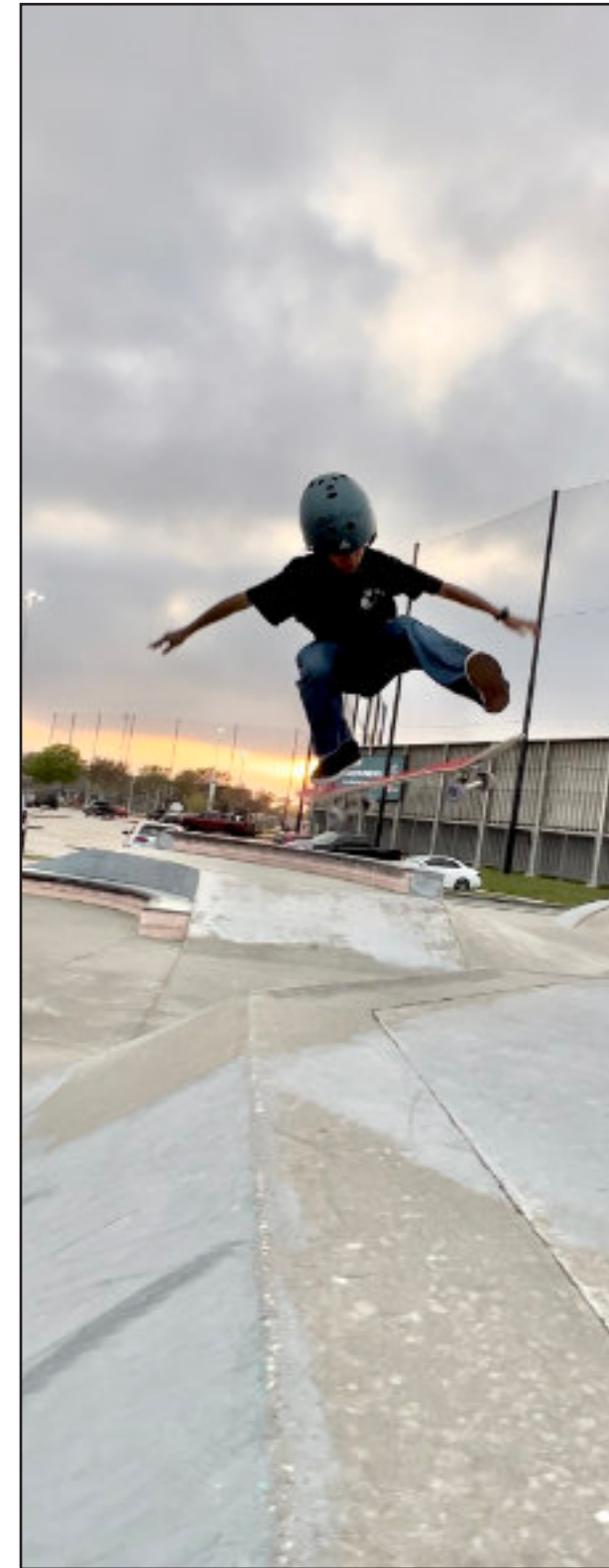


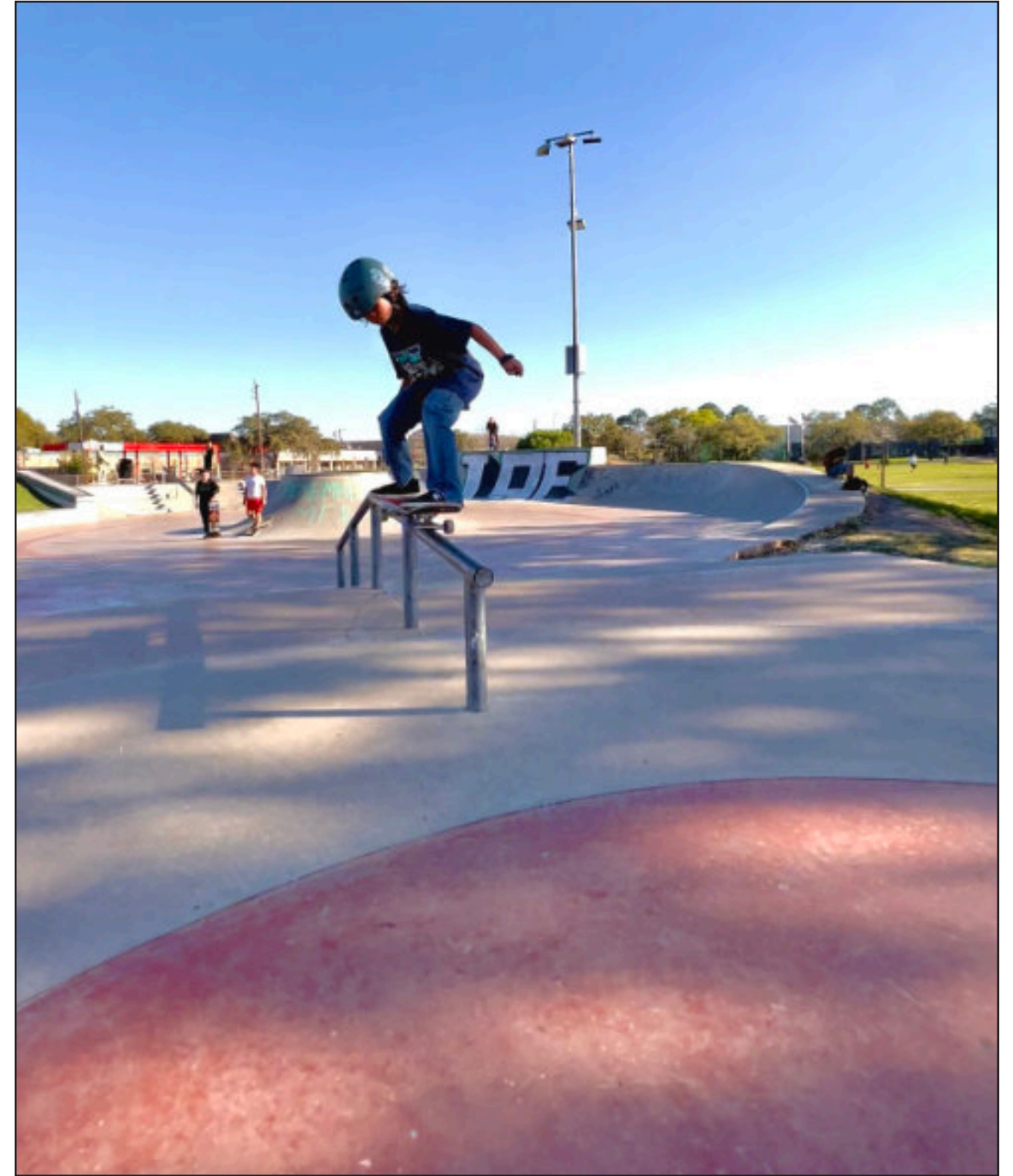
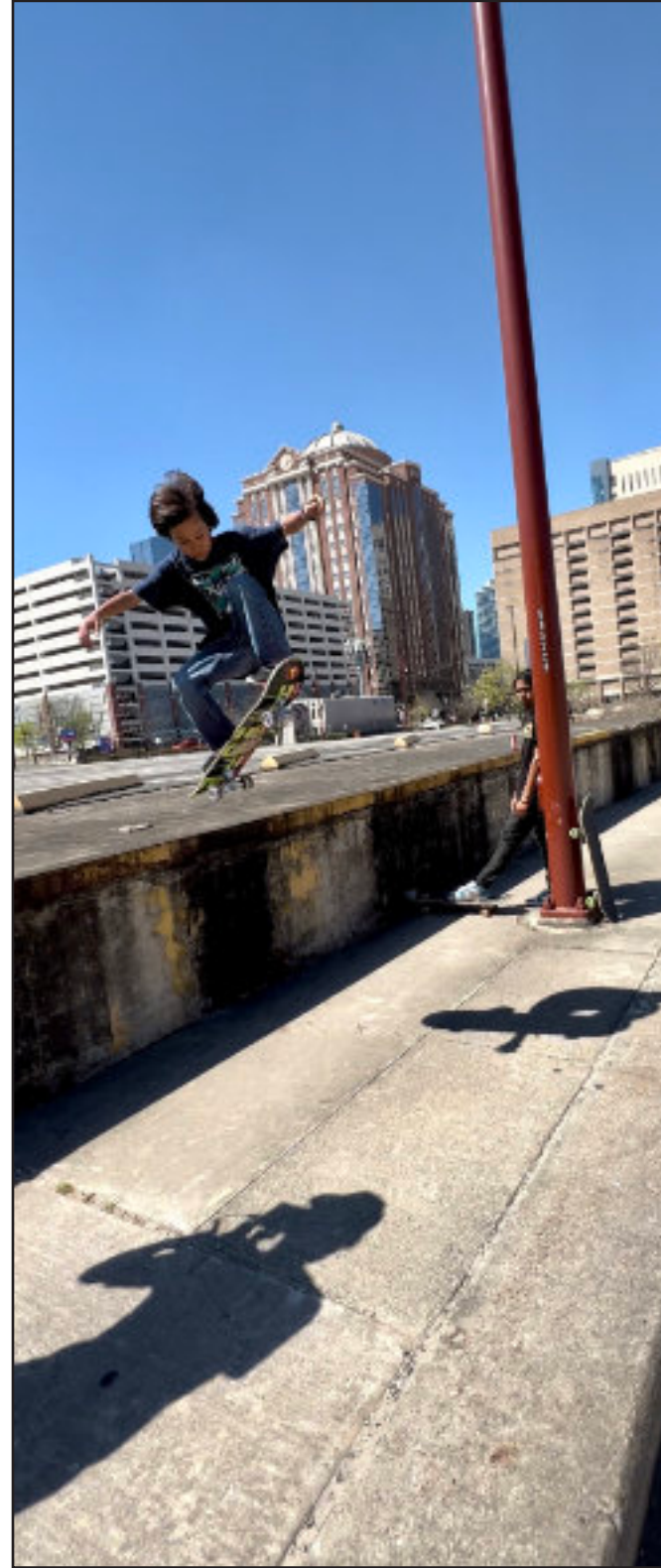
Evan Lancaster

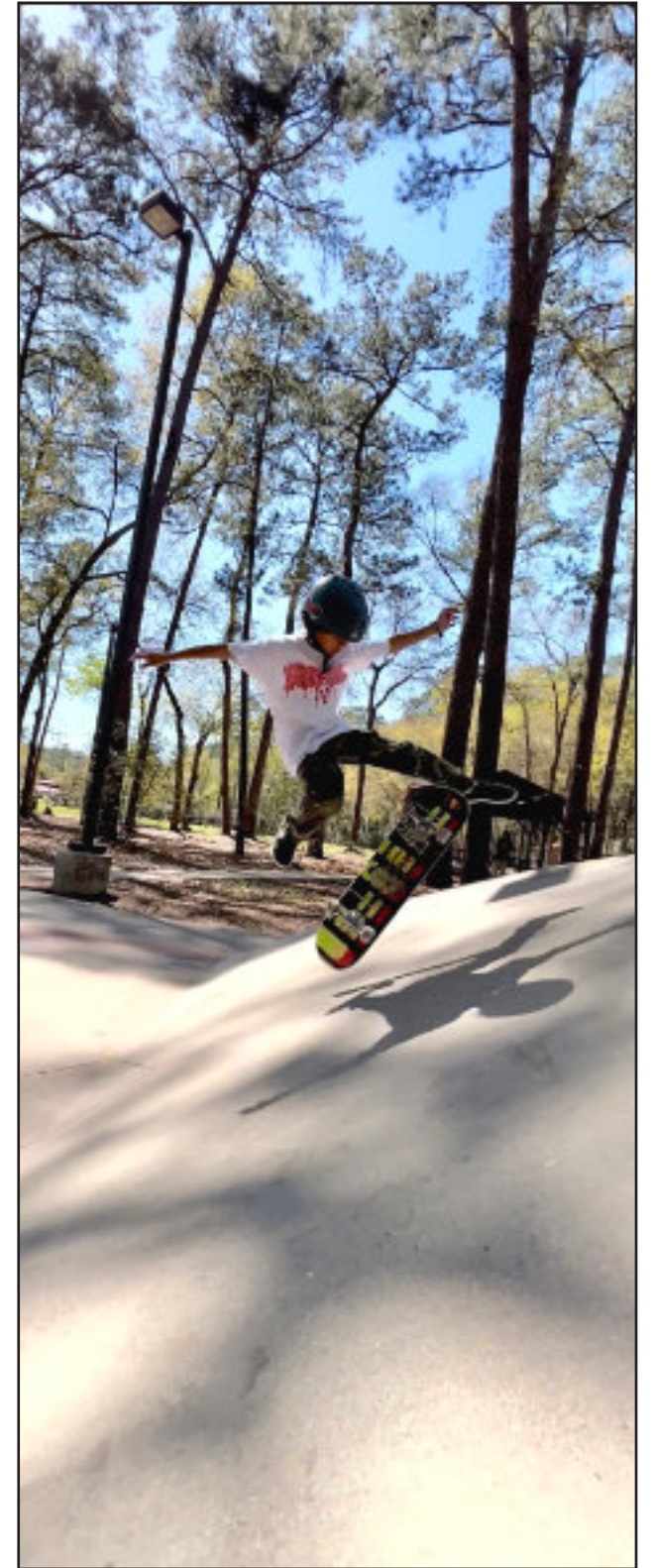

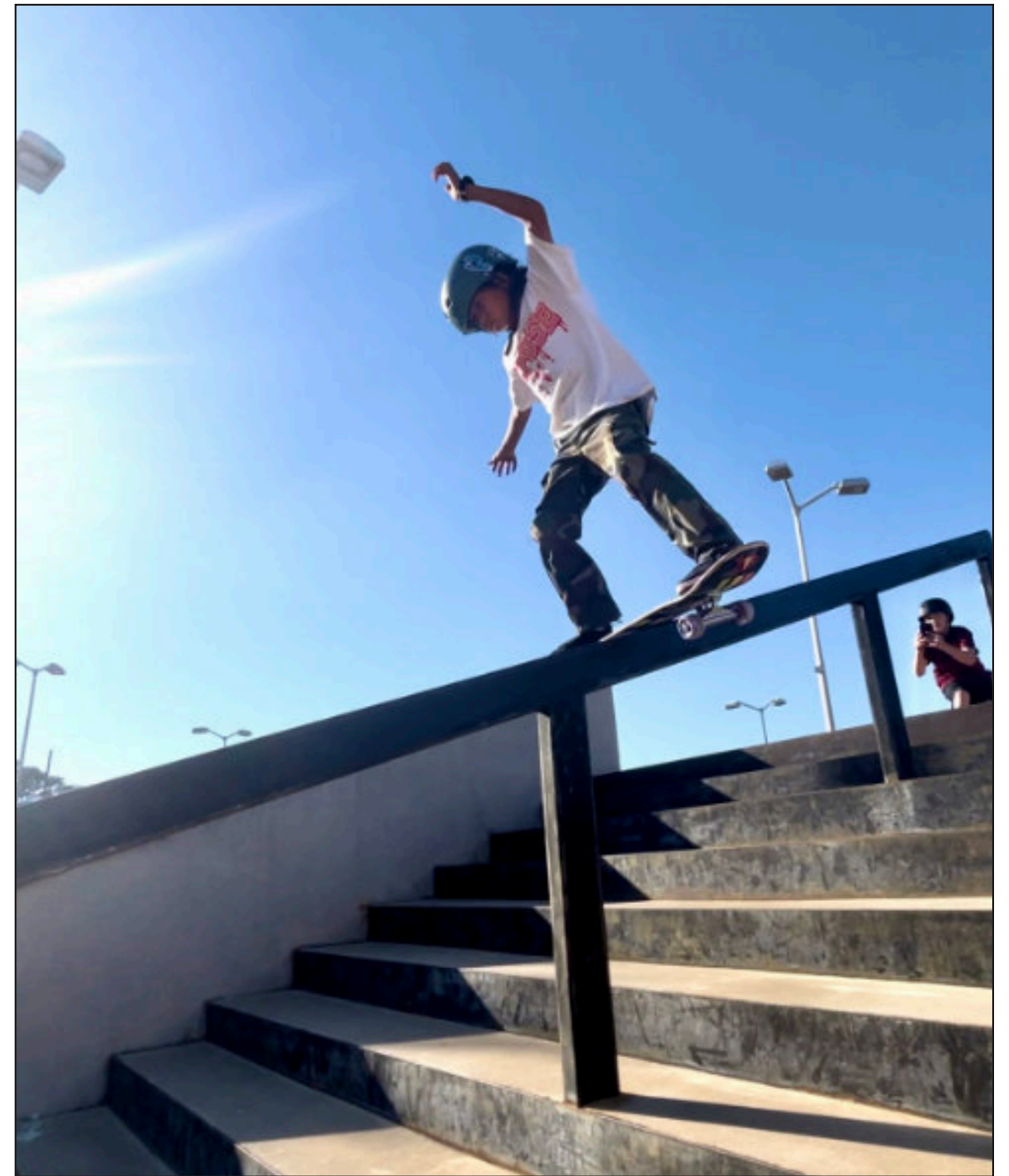
supportive of each other. It has also been rewarding to win a few local competitions. My ultimate goal would be to become pro one day and start my own skateboard company.

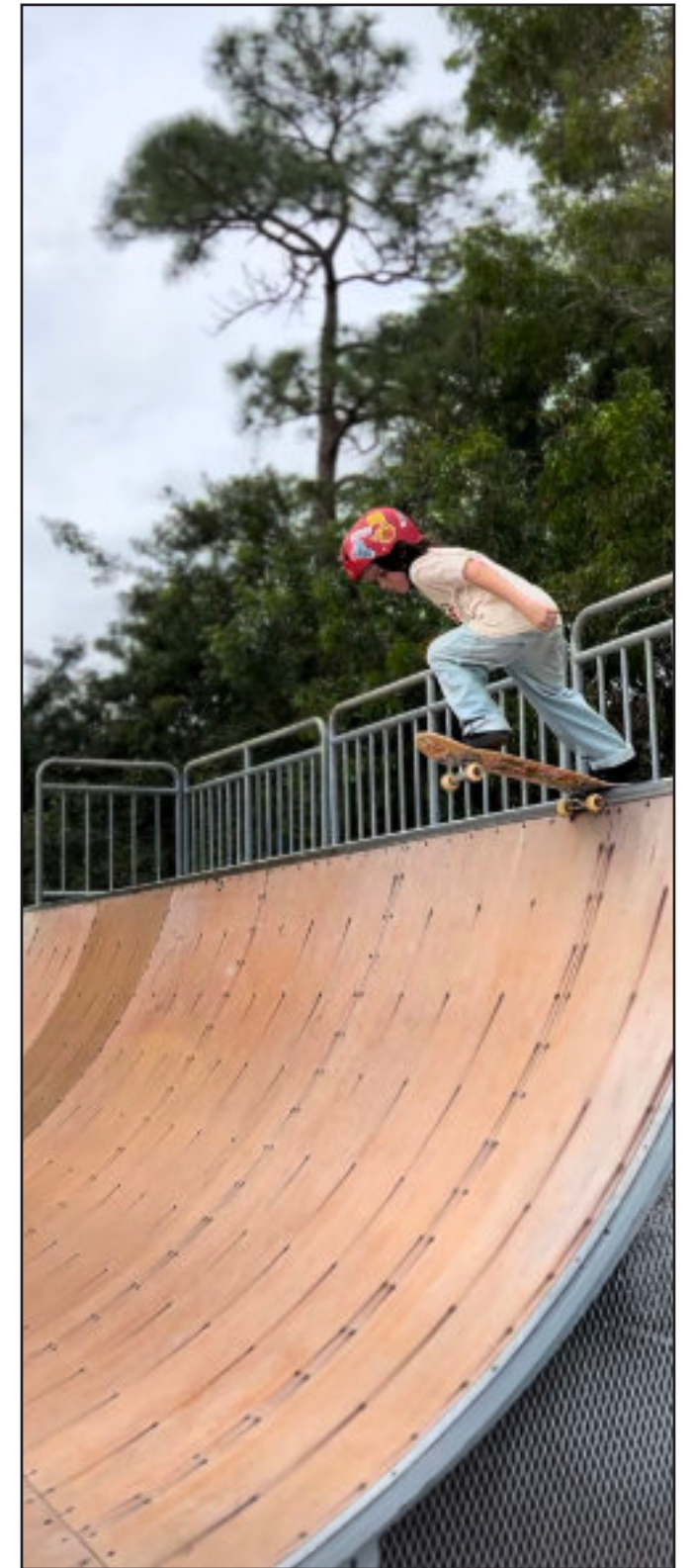

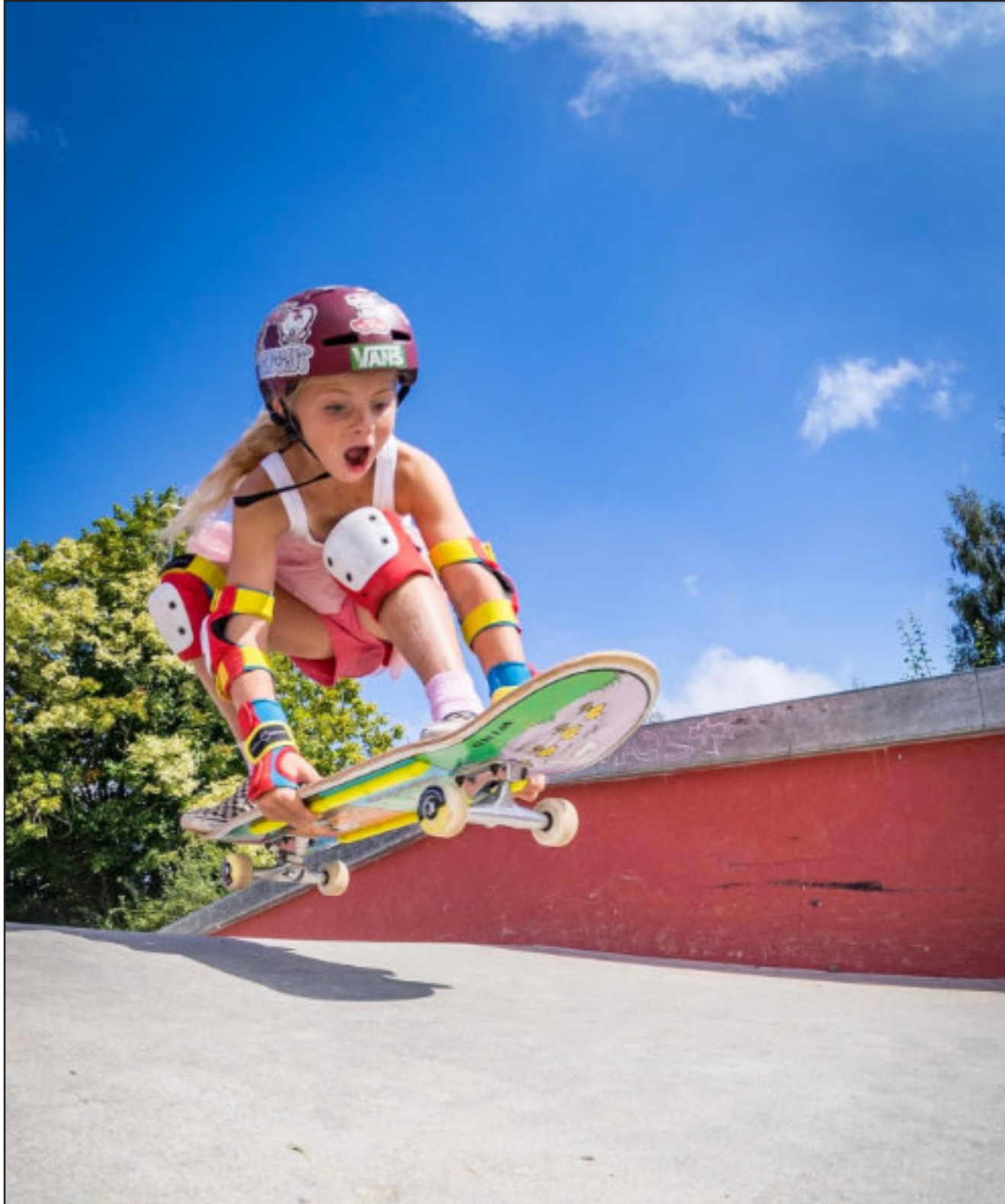

different states and regions get to compete for the title of Amateur Skate League National Champion.

When I am not skating, I love building with my Legos and watching skate videos. Currently, my favorite skaters to watch are Jamie Griffin, Jamie Foy and Louie Lopez. Ever since I started, one of my all time favorites has always been Daewon Song.
